FADE IN:

1 INT. GRACE & NICK'S - LIVING ROOM - DUSK (D1)

FRANKIE and GRACE are "pitching" to a whiteboard with headshots of all the Sharks from "Shark Tank" pasted on top of Frankie-drawn bodies. All around them is Rise Up work paraphernalia. Grace is mid-pitch:

GRACE

... So, I realized, there must be a lot of people in the same exact situation as I was--

FRANKIE

Really make eye contact with Mr. Wonderful.

GRACE Can I get through this just once without you interrupting?

FRANKIE Oh, yes, of course, I'm sorry. Go.

GRACE (back to the whiteboard) So then we started talking to other people, and it turns out--

FRANKIE I need you to make love to Mark Cuban.

GRACE I'm gonna throttle you!

FRANKIE

(re: Cuban) With your eyes!

GRACE With my hands!

FRANKIE You're just hangry. Nick should be here with Indian food any minute.

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1 CONTINUED:

GRACE How do you know that?

FRANKIE He texted your phone asking what you want for dinner. So I texted back "Indian". You call him Honeybear, right?

GRACE

No...

FRANKIE It might be a thing you do now.

NICK enters carrying bags of Indian takeout.

NICK (to Grace) Hey, Honeybear.

FRANKIE (to Grace) You're welcome.

NICK Oh, look, Frankie's here. Still. Again.

FRANKIE

And always.

NICK (to Frankie) I was sort of hoping I could just have dinner with my wife.

FRANKIE But she hates Indian and I ordered it.

GRACE Frankie was just leaving.

FRANKIE (taking the hint) All right, I'm picking up what you're putting down.

Frankie tries to get off the couch. It isn't an easy task.

FRANKIE (CONT'D) I think your couch wants me to stay.

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GRACE AND FRANKIE

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CONTINUED: (2) GRACE I think my husband wants you to go. Frankie finally gets up. FRANKIE Okay, fine. I'll take out my takeout. (taking a bag) But if you forgot the tofu tikka, I swear to god--GRACE Frankie! I'll see you in the morning. 9 A.M. sharp! Frankie heads to the door. FRANKIE (turning back) Can we say noon? (re: take-out bag) You see what I'm gonna eat tonight. She exits. NICK I definitely forgot the tofu tikka. GRACE I'll lock the door. NICK And you think that's gonna stop her? GRACE I'm sorry we've been taking over the place. NICK Stop worrying. You're going to do great and Frankie's made for TV. GRACE I know, I know. And we only need one Shark to say yes. NICK That's right. Little thing, though, that one Shark... can't be Cuban. (CONTINUED)

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GRACE I'm sorry? NICK Anyone but Mark Cuban. (quickly deflecting) I'll grab the plates and the Zantac. Be right back. GRACE I don't understand--NICK Curry doesn't sit well with me. GRACE Why can't we make a deal with Cuban? NICK I have a bad history with that guy. Some ugly stuff went down between us. Rich guy stuff. GRACE What did he do to you? NICK I don't want to talk about it. It's actually painful just to think about. GRACE You do realize this would reduce our chances of funding the Rise Up by twenty percent. How am I supposed to tell Frankie that? NICK And there it is again. The most important thing is Frankie. GRACE This is a very big thing for us--NICK I have completely accepted Frankie as part of our marriage. I've done everything short of inviting her into the marital bed.

GRACE

That's good, because she'd probably accept.

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NICK So, just once, could you do something for me for the simple reason that I'm your husband and I'm asking you?

This lands on Grace.

GRACE Fine. I promise, I won't sell to Cuban. I promise.

NICK Thank you, Honeybear. (then) Now let's eat this damn Indian food that neither of us wanted.

2 INT. ROBERT & SOL'S - FOYER / LIVING ROOM - NIGHT (N1)

ROBERT, still panicked over losing a large amount of money in * Ep. 610 (which Sol doesn't know about), talks to PETER.

ROBERT ... And now all Sol can talk about is going on a cruise!

PETER

Oh, you can't afford that. You gave all that money to save the theater.

ROBERT

I know that, Peter. And I need it back before he finds out. Our limit on spending without telling each other is \$679. That precedent was clearly settled in Sol v. Inflatable Jacuzzi.

PETER

You know, when you really look at it, this is all Sol's fault. He's the one who turned our community theater fundraiser into a benefit for a guy with cancer.

ROBERT

(sarcastic)
You're right, Sol's priorities are
all out of whack. Why help a guy
with cancer when you can fund "A
Chorus Line"?

PETER * Robert, you're not right for "A * Chorus Line". * SOL enters with Carl and some brochures. ROBERT PETER (CONT'D) (low energy) (low energy) Hi, honey. Hi, Sol. SOL Why do you two look so grim? ROBERT * (covering) * Oh, you know, just two old thespians trying to figure out how * * to raise the curtain one more time. * PETER * You remember, Sol, how you ruined * our fundraiser? * SOL But, don't you feel good that we * did a wonderful thing for a man who was suffering? PETER ROBERT (lamely) (unenthused) Yeah... I quess... SOL (re: brochures) Okay, well, these will at least cheer up Robert. ROBERT (pointed, to Peter) Cruise brochures... Sol presents each one to Robert. * SOL I've whittled it down to three choices, depending on what we want to spend: Queen of the Sea, which is super luxury deluxe, Sea Chaser --that's medium luxury deluxe -- or the Drunk Seahorse, which is not deluxe at all, but still a boat that goes to nice places.

Robert points to the brochure for the low rent cruise.

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CONTINUED: (2) ROBERT Seahorse! They sound like they know how to party. Besides, the other ones sound fiscally irresponsible. PETER Isn't the Seahorse the one that had an outbreak of botulism and several passengers perished at sea? ROBERT (now very irritated) This is the one I want to go on, Peter! SOL But don't we deserve the super luxury deluxe? As Saroyan said, "In the time of your life, live." We're all going to end up in the ground anyway. PETER Like the people who died of botulism. SOL I'll call Queen of the Sea and check availabilities. Sol walks into the bedroom with Carl and closes the door. PETER You know what that made me think? ROBERT That I'm going to put you in the ground? PETER No. That I want to borrow your inflatable jacuzzi. But also, didn't you guys just recently buy fancy burial plots? ROBERT Last year. It was a very emotional day. PETER I'm sure it was. You need to sell them.

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CONTINUED: (3)

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ROBERT

What? Are you insane?

PETER

It's the perfect solution to this mess Sol's put you in. By the time it comes out, either <u>he'll</u> be dead and have no idea, or <u>you'll</u> be dead and have no idea how angry he is.

Robert considers that a moment, then:

ROBERT

How come I'm not right for "A Chorus Line"?

EXT. HANDSOME JAKE'S - THE NEXT MORNING (D2)

COYOTE and a very anxious BUD are waiting at a table.

BUD

I can't believe how nervous I am. I've never met a blood relative.

COYOTE

What's the worst that could happen? He punches you off your bike and thinks you're fucking his mom?

BUD

Less that, and more... What if I hate him? What if I <u>like</u> him?

COYOTE It's gonna be fine. If you hate him, you never have to see him again. And if you like him, you've doubled your friend count.

BUD Do people call cousins "cuz"? Is that a thing?

COYOTE

I'm not sure, bro. But let's take the pressure off. We'll agree on a safe word. And if you're miserable, just say it, and I'll make an excuse to go.

BUD Okay, good idea. What's the word? GRACE AND FRANKIE CONTINUED:

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COYOTE How about "latte"?

BUD That's not gonna work.

COYOTE

Why?

BUD Because I'm ordering a latte.

COYOTE Order something else.

BUD I have to change my drink? Change your safe word.

COYOTE Fine. "Sugar"?

BUD

Perfect.

Bud spots a 30-something black man approaching them. This is * JORDAN. Bud jumps up to greet him: *

BUD (CONT'D) Hey... Are you my Jordan?

JORDAN You must be Bud.

Bud goes for a hug as Jordan goes for a handshake.

BUD Sorry, that was awkward. (then) Jordan, this is my brother, Coyote.

Coyote shakes Jordan's hand and kisses him on the cheek.

BUD (CONT'D) But, not as awkward as that.

They all sit down. It's still weird.

JORDAN Wow, this is...

BUD Yeah. It is, isn't it? 5.16.19

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CONTINUED: (2)

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JORDAN

So... what made you go onto YourGeneMap.com?

BUD

Actually, my wife did. She thought our one-year-old might be a genius, and was hoping I'd be related to one.

JORDAN

Sorry, I was only third in my class at Stanford. Just kidding, I was first. Kidding again, I didn't go to Stanford. Sorry, I'm bad at jokes. Please don't think I'm weird. I went to Harvard.

Bud smiles understandingly.

BUD

It's okay.
 (re: Coyote)
My brother just kissed you. So,
weird is a relative term in this
family.

COYOTE (to Jordan, re: Bud) You wanna hear weird? He banged a couch.

BUD (self-deprecating) I get around. (then) Anyhoooo... why'd <u>you</u> go on the website.

JORDAN

Well, I actually have this condition called CKD, so I was looking for a genetic match because... I kind of need a kidney.

This stops Bud in his tracks.

BUD

A what?

JORDAN A kidney. Donor. BUD

Wow. (then, to Coyote) Could you pass the <u>sugar</u>?

Oblivious, Coyote passes Bud the sugar. Then, to Jordan:

COYOTE Sorry about the kidney, man. Hey, maybe Bud can give you one.

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INT. BEACH HOUSE - LIVING ROOM - SAME (D2)

The Grace and Frankie dummies sit next to each other with photos of Greiner and Corcoran pasted on their faces. We PAN to a broom with Mr. Wonderful's face, then a rainstick with Rohan Oza, and finally to Sol, in a t-shirt with Mark Cuban on it. We WIDEN to see Grace and Frankie. Frankie is sitting on the Rise Up. Grace is mid-pitch:

GRACE

... So I realized, there must be a
lot of people in the same exact
situation as I was- (to Frankie)
I can't pitch like this.

FRANKIE Is it the rainstick?

GRACE

No, it's Sol! (to Sol) What are you doing here?

SOL

I'm Mark Cuban. I thought, baserd *
on my performance, it was pretty *
obvious.

FRANKIE

I plu	ıcked	him	0	ut c	f	obscurity,	*
give	the	kid	a	char	nce	2.	*

GRACE

No, no, no. There's no chance Cuban's going to buy this. Forget about Cuban. Sol, go home.

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SOL Actually, in doing my research for the role of Mark Cuban, I discovered he recently had a hip replacement. FRANKIE Interesting. Go on, Mark... SOL So, even though my character isn't the target demo, "I" can relate to why a person would need this. FRANKIE I knew you were one of those actors who does research. I'm very glad I cast you. GRACE When was there a casting session ?! FRANKIE Looks like Cuban's our guy, Grace. Bingo-bango, that's our mango! SOL Would you like to hear my offer? GRACE No. No offer. (to Frankie) I'm telling you Barbara Corcoran is going to flip for the Rise Up. FRANKIE I don't know, she's pretty fancy. GRACE She's a New York real estate mogul. Do you know how many toilets she controls on the Upper East Side alone? I'll focus on Barbara, you focus on Lori. She's a Midwest city girl, like you.

FRANKIE I can work that angle.

SOL But what about my hip?

FRANKIE What about his hip?

GRACE AND FRANKIE CONTINUED: (2)

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SOL I could even use the Rise Up to get up from my Shark chair. Sol mimics getting out of his chair in a very painful way. SOL (CONT'D) Ow. Ow. * GRACE * Sol. Overacting. * FRANKIE But he does make a good point with * the hip. GRACE Frankie, the women Sharks will get * this. We need to concentrate on * them. As your partner, I'm asking * you to trust me. * FRANKIE Okay. You're my partner. I trust you. Grace sighs, relieved. Sol gets up and heads to the door. * SOL If you want me, I'll be in my * trailer. * EXT. PARK - TACO STAND - LATER (D2) 5 * Coyote and ALLISON stand in a long line for a taco cart. * ALLISON * We've been in line for forty-five * minutes. No tacos are worth this. * * COYOTE Bud says every bite is like a * sunset in your mouth. * ALLISON * He told Faith the same thing about * her strained peas. * A stressed Bud approaches them. * ALLISON (CONT'D) * Oh, here he is. Just as we're * getting close.

BUD * You know how you said there was * almost a no-percent chance I was * going to be a kidney match? * ALLISON * Yeah... * * BUD Well, you were very, very, very, * * very wrong. COYOTE ALLISON * Are you serious? No way. MAN IN LINE (O.S.) * (to Bud) * Dude, no cutting! * Bud turns around to see a pissed off MAN IN LINE. * * BUD Dude, I've got some life issues * going on, okay? * MAN IN LINE * So do I. Someone just cut in front * of me in line. * ALLISON * * (to Bud) Wait. What are you going to do? * BUD * What choice do I have? Call him up * and say, "Hey, Jordan, good news, * I'm a match, but I gotta look out * for number one, so, best of luck." * * ALLISON Hold on. You tell him you're * saving your spare parts for your family. BUD Allison, if you were sick, and your cousin could save you, I'd want more than anything for them to give you a kidney. (then) * Why couldn't he be like every other * relative and just ask for money? *

5 CONTINUED: (2) COYOTE * Speaking of, can you spot me a ten * for the tacos? * They're almost to the taco stand. * * BUD This could only happen to me. The * first time I meet a real cousin, * and I'm down one kidney. You do * realize I won't be able to play * contact sports now, right? * COYOTE * Is badminton a contact sport? * BUD * It gets physical out there! * * They reach the front of the line where MIGUEL is taking orders. * MIGUEL Hey. Were you just talking about * giving someone a kidney? * BUD Oh, Jesus, you don't need one, do * * you? MIGUEL No, but that's really cool. My * sister was saved by an organ donor who died in a car accident. I always wanted to thank him, but I can't. So, how about I thank you? (re: their tacos) Free tacos for you and your * friends. BUD Oh. You don't need to do that. MIGUEL It's the least I can do for a hero. Allison puts her hand on Bud's and looks at him admiringly. ALLISON * He just called you a hero. * Wow. BUD * That is a first for me. (CONTINUED)

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GRACE AND FRANKIE

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COYOTE * Hey, hero, I could still use that * * ten. Off Bud, liking that word "hero"... * 6 EXT. LAGO VISTA CEMETERY - SAME (D2) 6 * Robert stands by two burial plots with a "For Sale" sign. Peter mans a fold-up table with a sign-in sheet, a punch bowl and a plate of cookies. ROBERT I'm starting to think this might be in bad taste. PETER Robert, if you're selling bathing suits, you go to a pool. If you're selling gravesites, you go to a graveyard. ROBERT No one sells anything at either of those places. PETER * Pretend we're listed on Zillow, and * treat it like it's any other real * estate. Emphasize the view, the neighborhood. The excellent school district. A MAN walks by. PETER (CONT'D) (big smile) Can I interest you in a glass of punch? He takes a glass. ROBERT (awkwardly) You know, the sunset is particularly spectacular from this spot. And the neighbors are... (re: gravestones) ... very quiet. MAN Are you having an open house for a burial plot?

ROBERT (pointing to Peter) It was his idea!

PETER He stole twenty grand from his husband!

The Man hurries away.

PETER (CONT'D) All right, so that's a soft yes.

ROBERT This was a horrible idea. I should have never let you talk me into it.

As he starts dismantling the "open house" setup, a brother and sister, NICO and SOFIA MARTINEZ (30s) approach, confused:

> SOFIA Excuse me, we're looking for the sales office?

PETER You found us. You buying? We're selling.

SOFIA We're actually looking for a place for our mom and dad. They passed

unexpectedly.

NICO (by way of explanation) They studied bats.

ROBERT I'm so sorry for your loss, Mr. and Mrs...

SOFIA Martinez. But we're actually brother and sister.

PETER Tell you what, you need two, we've got two. Fifty grand and your parents are sleeping here tonight.

NICO Oh, wow. That's really out of our range.

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5.16.19 6 GRACE AND FRANKIE CONTINUED: (2)

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SOFIA And really offensive. But it is a beautiful spot.

They start to walk away. Robert feels bad.

ROBERT

Wait. Please.

The Martinezes stop and turn around.

PETER (sotto) Robert, nobody buys a car without walking out of the dealership.

ROBERT I don't want to make money off these people. And I need a check to clear before Sol finds out.

PETER You've gotta get out of sales.

Robert approaches the Martinezes.

ROBERT I think we can work something out.

7 INT. SHARK TANK STUDIO - BACKSTAGE HALLWAY - DAYS LATER (D3) 7

Grace and Frankie are backstage at the "Shark Tank" studio, moments before going on. A STAGE MANAGER with a headset * stands nearby.

> FRANKIE Grace, look at where we are. * GRACE I'm so proud of you right now. * FRANKIE * I'm proud of you for telling your * story. * STAGE MANAGER I'm proud of both of you. You're * on in thirty seconds. GRACE * (to Frankie) * Remember, I've got Barbara, you've * got Lori.

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FRANKIE (holding up her fist)		*
Pound it.		*
Grace looks at her fist, confused.		*
FRANKIE (CONT'D) Just touch my fist to your fist.		*
They do and Frankie mimes a huge explosion.		*
EXT. PARK - TACO STAND - SAME (D3)	8	
Bud, munching on a taco, is back at Miguel's, holding court in front of a few people who are enjoying their tacos. He leans in to a COOL GUY.		* * *
BUD So I meet this guy I never even knew existed and he asks me for this huge favor. And you know what I do? I say, "Fuck yeah, man. Whatever you need." And he says, "Even if it's a kidney?" And I say, " <u>Especially</u> if it's a kidney."		* * * * * * * *
COOL GUY That's intense. What'd your wife say?		* * *
BUD Obviously, she was concerned. Who can blame her? But I said to her, "When our daughter grows up, I want her to know two things: her Daddy's a hero, and only wrestle with Mommy."		* * * * * * *
Bud basks in the admiration of his new friends		*
INT. SHARK TANK STUDIO - A BIT LATER (D3)	9	
Grace and Frankie do the "Shark Tank" entrance, looking fantastic. Their demo Rise Up toilet is already set up. They pitch to the seated Sharks: BARBARA CORCORAN, LORI GREINER, KEVIN O'LEARY AKA "MR. WONDERFUL", ROHAN OZA, and MARK CUBAN.		
GRACE		

GRACE Hello, Sharks. I'm Grace Hanson. CONTINUED:

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FRANKIE

And I'm Frankie Bergstein.

GRACE

Today we're seeking a \$200,000 investment in exchange for ten percent equity in our business.

Frankie moves to the demo-toilet and sits on it.

GRACE (CONT'D) I've had a knee replacement and I'm also eighty years old. Two months ago, I was all alone in the house and I couldn't get off the toilet.

Frankie mimes not being able to get up.

GRACE (CONT'D) I grabbed onto the toilet-paper dispenser and it broke off.

Frankie mimes Grace doing that. The Sharks are charmed.

GRACE (CONT'D) It was embarrassing and dangerous. Luckily, my best friend and business partner helped me get up.

Frankie jumps up and heroically flexes her muscles.

GRACE (CONT'D) So, I realized, there must be a lot of people in the same exact situation as I was. If only there was a sleek and stylish product that could help you off the toilet -- without making you feel like you're in a hospital.

Frankie sits back on the toilet, crossing her legs like an elegant lady.

> GRACE (CONT'D) Well, now there is!

Frankie presses the "rise" button on the toilet and is majestically lifted.

> GRACE/FRANKIE The Rise Up!

The Sharks applaud. Grace and Frankie stand to discuss.

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GRACE AND FRANKIE CONTINUED: (4)

> BARBARA CORCORAN Do you have a patent?

GRACE Great question. We're patent pending.

MARK CUBAN I just asked that.

GRACE (re: Cuban) Geez, Barbara, how do you put up * with Mr. Chatty? *

The other Sharks are shocked. Frankie makes the "time-out" gesture of a referee.

> FRANKIE Can we take a time-out? I need to talk to my partner. (directly into a camera) We'll be right back, after this.

Frankie pulls Grace away for a conference.

EXT. PARK - TACO STAND - SAME (D3)

Bud is talking to the same crowd, as rapt as before.

BUD ... "Some are born great, some achieve greatness, and some have greatness thrust upon them." I'm two of those things.

He sees Jordan approaching.

BUD (CONT'D) Hey, Jordan!

JORDAN

(re: taco stand) Oh, man. I've heard of this place. But I don't want to stand in this line.

BUD No, no, no. There's no lines for kidney givers, or kidney getters. We're celebrities here. Mostly me.

Bud calls out to Miguel, who's still serving tacos.

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BUD (CONT'D) * Hey, Miquel! Can you get an al * pastor for my cousin? * MIGUEL * Oh, my god! This is so beautiful. * The long lost cousins. I'll bring * the tacos to you. * JORDAN * Bud, I've kinda gotta talk to you. * Jordan pulls Bud aside. * BUD * Don't be shy. I'm about to have my organ inside you. JORDAN * Well, it's good news, actually. * Another kidney became available and * it turns out it's a better match. * * BUD I'm sorry, what? * JORDAN It means you don't have to give me your kidney. BUD But I want to. JORDAN You can't. BUD Okay, this isn't working for me. You realize the polite thing to do is reject a kidney after it's in you. JORDAN I thought you'd be happy. BUD You give me this great gift, and then you take it right back? Miguel approaches with the tacos. * JORDAN * But don't you feel relieved you get * to keep your kidney?

	GRACE I know, but I really feel	
	FRANKIE And I'm digging it! It's working perfectly. He's eating out of the palm of your hand!	
	GRACE He is?	
	FRANKIE I need you to go at him even harder.	
	GRACE Huh?	
	FRANKIE Sol told me Cuban hates suck-ups. And you've got him looking for <u>your</u> approval.	
	GRACE But I've got Barbara on the hook. She's our whale.	

FRANKIE That'd be great if we were on "Whale Tank". Cuban's our Shark. * Now get out there and be a real * jerk to him! * The Stage Manager signals for them to go back on. Off * Grace's worried face... 12 INT. ROBERT & SOL'S - LIVING ROOM / FOYER - LATER (D3) 12 Sol is working on his computer when Robert walks in. ROBERT That toilet is a helluva thing. SOLPlease. I'm obsessed. ROBERT What are you doing? SOL Just checking our bank balance. ROBERT (nervous) Uh huh... SOL I've been thinking a lot about the cruise and I wanted to make sure it was sensible. ROBERT (still nervous) And is it? Sol closes the laptop. SOL It's definitely sensible. * ROBERT * (breathing again) * Oh, thank god. * SOL * It's about time we had this * * honeymoon.

ROBERT Of course. Now that we know we've * got the money, let's book the super * luxury deluxe. Around the Greek * islands. * * SOL Europe? * ROBERT * We deserve it. * The doorbell rings. Sol answers it -- sitting on the stoop is a gift basket filled with muffins. Sol picks it up and shows it to Robert. ROBERT (CONT'D) Who's that for? SOL Us, apparently. (then) Oh, god. I begged Sidney not to do this. (then, explaining) He told me he wanted to get us something for raising all that money for him. ROBERT You deserve it, Sol. And, frankly, so do I. Now let's take a peek at these goodies. As Robert rips into the basket and a muffin, Sol picks up the card and looks at it. SOL Oh, wait. It's addressed to you. He turns the card over. SOL (CONT'D) Who are the Martinezes? Robert's mouth is too full of muffin to answer. SOL (CONT'D) (reading card) "It's so good to know our beloved * parents will rest in peace. Thank * * you again for selling us your beautiful burial plots." *

GRACE AND FRANKIE 12 CONTINUED: (2)

A stunned Sol stares at Robert.

ROBERT That could mean anything.

13 INT. SHARK TANK STUDIO - SAME (D3)

Grace and Frankie walk back on to face the Sharks.

GRACE

First of all, Mark, I did not mean to be dismissive of you earlier. I think what you've accomplished as a... buyer of basketball teams is... really, I mean, all those championships.

Frankie looks at Grace: "WTF?"

MARK CUBAN One, actually.

GRACE But the best one, right?

MARK CUBAN I gotta be honest. I don't know what to make of you. (then) And that has me leaning in. It's always smart in a negotiation to keep the other party off-balance.

GRACE (sotto) Oh, god.

FRANKIE (sotto, to Grace) You can't lose with this guy!

MARK CUBAN I want to make you an offer.

Frankie grabs Grace's hand in anticipation.

MARK CUBAN (CONT'D) I see the Rise Up helping millions of people worldwide. I'm offering exactly what you asked for. Ten percent equity for 200k.

Frankie's jaw drops.

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GRACE Barbara? Can you do better than that? BARBARA CORCORAN No. GRACE Can you do worse than that? BARBARA CORCORAN I can: I'm out. Frankie opens her arms to Mark Cuban for a hug. FRANKIE Well, that's it then. Bring it home, big boy. MARK CUBAN So we have a deal? FRANKIE Yes we do, partner! GRACE No, we don't. (to Frankie) I'm really sorry. (then, to Cuban) I can't accept this deal. FRANKIE What?! GRACE I'm sorry. We're out. Off everyone's shock... INT. SHARK TANK STUDIO - HALLWAY - MOMENTS LATER (D3) Grace and a frantic Frankie enter the backstage area. FRANKIE What the hell did you just do? GRACE

Frankie, I'm sure we'll find someone else--

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	FRANKIE No, no, no. We have someone. Mark Cuban. (points to stage)
	You need to go back out there right now and tell him yes.
	GRACE They're already in the middle of another pitch.
	FRANKIE It's for a frisbee purse. And I don't care how brilliant it is
	GRACE We can't make a deal with Cuban, Frankie.
	FRANKIE Why not?!
	GRACE Because Nick asked me not to.
Beat, as 1	Frankie stops and takes this in.
	FRANKIE What does Nick have to do with any of this?
	GRACE Cuban did something really bad to him.
	FRANKIE What did he do?
	GRACE That I don't know.
	FRANKIE (sarcastic) Well, in that case, I totally understand why you blew our deal.
	GRACE Nick asked me to do this one thing for him, and he's my husband.
	FRANKIE And I'm your partner. Why the fuck didn't you tell me?!

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GRACE Because I thought we'd sell to someone else and never have to have this conversation. FRANKIE The other day, you asked me to trust you. Frankie exits the studio. Grace stands stunned for a moment.
