CAMERA WIDENS TO REVEAL that Danny is standing alone on a barren stage, reading a scene for an open call audition.

DANNY
(continuing)
Well, here I am. Now what are
you gonna do about it?

MAN'S VOICE
Thank you... that'll be enough.

Danny breaks character and squints out into the darkened theatre.

2 DANNY'S POV OF THEATRE (STOCK)

We can barely see the outline of a man sitting in the middle of the orchestra section.

DANNY
You want me to try it another way?

MAN'S VOICE
That won't be necessary. We're looking for a very special type.

3 BACK TO DANNY

He won't take "no" for an answer.

DANNY I can be special.

(X)

4

(X)

3 CONTINUED:

MAN'S VOICE
I'm sorry, but you're not quite
what we had in mind.

Danny is visibly upset as OVER this we HEAR the ELECTRONIC NOISES of a PINBALL MACHINE.

CUT TO:

4 INT. LOU'S LANES - PINBALL MACHINES - DAY

CAMERA STARTS CLOSE ON the scoreboard of a pinball machine, then WIDENS TO REVEAL Danny taking his frustrations out on the machine.

5 ANGLE ON LOUNGE

CHRIS, made up like a mime, approaches LOU as he comes out of the kitchen. They head towards the front entry together.

CHRIS

(indicating make-up)
Lou, what do you think?

Chris places his hands against an imaginary wall and tries to find an opening by feeling along its "surface."

(continuing)
I'm in a box, and I can't find
my way out. So I....

LOU
(interrupting)
Donlon, how many times I gotta
tell you, mimes don't talk.

CHRIS

If I don't tell people what I'm doing, how are they gonna figure it out?

LOU
 (reconsidering)
A talking mime. It's original.
 (a beat)
Dumb, but original.

They have arrived at the front entry area as Lou gives Chris a pat on the back, then heads up the stairs. Chris looks around and spots Danny at the video game machine.

6 NEW ANGLE

Chris crosses to Danny who continues to fight a losing battle with the machine.

CHRIS

Hey, Amatullo, don't kill the machine.

DANNY

(glancing at Chris)
Donlon, you look ridiculous.

The pinball game ends abruptly and Danny shoves the machine, then steps away. Chris moves to the pinball machine.

CHRIS

I know. But I gotta keep trying out new material. Otherwise the act gets stale, you know.

Chris inserts a quarter into the machine and starts playing. Danny watches Chris for a beat, then:

DANNY

Chris... you think I'm talented?

CHRIS

Are you nuts, Amatullo? I know you're talented. What's the matter with you anyway?

DANNY

I been sneaking out to some auditions.

Chris looks over at Danny; now he fully understands his friend's behavior.

CHRIS

Pretty tough, huh?

DANNY

The pits. I did okay, but no one wants "okay." They're all looking for someone special.

CHRIS

Then they made a mistake not picking you.

DANNY

You're the only one who thinks so.

(X)

(X)

(X)

(X)

6 CONTINUED:

CHRIS

Amatullo, you can't let a couple rejections get you down. You're good.

Yeah, but "good" don't cut it.
Look at you and Leroy... the two

most talented guys I know. He's teaching and you're slaving away here at Lou's.

(a beat)
Let's face it, if you guys are struggling, I don't stand a chance.

Chris doesn't know what to say to his friend... as suddenly the machine goes crazy, lights flashing, MUSIC BLARING, signaling that Chris has won a free game. Danny looks at the machine, shrugs, then turns and heads out the door. Chris watches after him, concerned for his friend.

7 EXT. SCHOOL OF THE ARTS - ESTABLISHING - DAY (DAY TWO)
The usual amount of activity out front.

8 INT. HALLWAY - DAY

DUSTY and JILLIAN move down the hallway together.

DUSTY

The question was who sang "Sunday, Bloody Sunday."

JILLIAN

0 1 1 1 1 1

DUSTY

Of course, it's U2. The trick was getting through to the radio station.

JILLIAN

And you won?

U2.

DUSTY

Two tickets to their concert.

JILLIAN

Great. Who you going with?

DUSTY

Hopefully a guy. If I can find one.

JILLIAN

That should be easy.

DUSTY

For you maybe. Me... I'd have to lose major pounds.

JILLIAN

Dusty, I'm sure there are plenty of guys who'd love to go out with you.

JESSE (V.O.) Hey, ladies, lookin' good.

9 NEW ANGLE

as JESSE approaches the girls and walks along with them.

JILLIAN

And how many girls have you said that to this morning?

JESSE

Who's counting?

(to Dusty)

Hey, Dusty, can I talk to you for a minute?

DUSTY

Sure.

(to Jillian)

Excuse us.

Jillian smiles, then moves into a classroom as Jesse and Dusty continue to walk together.

JESSE

Listen, Dusty, I wrote this song. I'm gonna make a demo, and I want you to see it.

DUSTY

Me?

JESSE

You've got the best voice in the school.

(CONTINUED)

(X)

DUSTY

You really think so?

JESSE

Sure. Want to give it a shot tomorrow afternoon?

(X)

DUSTY

Fine.

JESSE

(joking around)
Stick with me, kid, I'll make you a star.

(X)

Jesse smiles at her, then turns and moves off down the hall in the opposite direction. Dusty stops and watches him go, an excited smile lighting up her face. OVER this, we HEAR the SOUND of MUSIC.

(X)

10 INT. ACTING CLASSROOM - DAY

10

CAMERA STARTS CLOSE ON a T.V. set on which we SEE NICOLE the end of "My Way." She finishes, and takes a bow. She moves to the plano behind her, sits, and starts playing her "theme."

NICOLE

Well, that's all the time we have for this week on "The Nicole Chapman Show." Bye.

(X)

Nicole waves good bye and continues to play the piano as CAMERA WIDENS TO REVEAL a group of students, including Danny, Jesse, Jillian, Dusty, and Nicole herself, sitting and watching the set. Nicole good naturedly acknowledges the APPLAUSE of her friends as the T.V. SCREEN FADES to BLACK.

NICOLE

Tha- tha- tha- that's all folks.

Everyone LAUGHS, then the group starts to break up. Danny moves to Nicole.

11 NEW ANGLE

11

We can SEE the television set in the background as Danny speaks to Nicole. The only thing on the screen is a card which reads: "Coming Up Next: MISTER WACKY'S WORLD"

DANNY

Unbelievable, Nicole, your own show.

NICOLE

It's only on the public access station. Anyone can have a show if they've got thirty-five dollars.

DANNY

That's all it takes to get on T.V.?

NICOLE

Sure, they give you the use of the studio and all the equipment.

In the background, we SEE the show "Mister Wacky's World" start on the T.V. screen. Mister Wacky's THEME MUSIC ("Moon River") PLAYS OVER a shot of his set.

DANNY

(incredulous)

Do people know about this?

NICOLE

Danny, it's no big deal. Most of the shows are terrible.

Danny glances at the T.V. set and reacts.

DANNY

Hey, "Mister Wacky's World."

NICOLE

Yeah, that's the only one with any kind of following.

helmet on his head, and carrying a tennis racket.

DANNY

I love that quy.

12 INSERT OF T.V. SET

MISTER WACKY, a man in his early thirties, swings down fron out of the rafters and flies right past CAMERA. A beat, as we all wait for Mister Wacky to swing back into FRAME, but he doesn't. Another beat, then Mister Wacky enters through door at the back oif the set. He's dressed in white tie and tails, with a pith

Greetings my fellow Venutians,

MISTER WACKY

(continuing)
That's the name.

He pushes another button and we HEAR LOUD APPLAUSE as Wacky graciously accepts this adulation.

13 BACK TO DANNY AND NICOLE

They continue to look at the T.V. set as Mister Wacky takes in the APPLAUSE and pretends to be humbled by it.

MISTER WACKY

(on T.V.)
Thank you. Please. This is embarrassing. Thank you. No more. Please.

Danny is smiling at Wacky as Nicole reaches down and turns OFF the T.V.

DANNY

Nicole, when's your next taping?

NICOLE

Never. A one-woman show is too tough to pull off every week.

DANNY

Oh, that's too bad.

(a beat)

So does that mean your timeslot is available?

NICOLE

I guess.

DANNY

(announcing)
Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to
"The Danny Amatullo Show."

HOLD ON Danny. He sees stardom within his grasp.

14 EXT. PUBLIC ACCESS T.V. STUDIO - ESTABLISHING - DAY (STOCK)

OVER this, we HEAR:

DANNY (V.O.)
I got no luck at all.

15 INT. TELEVISION STUDIO - BACKSTAGE - DAY

15

Nicole stands with a very disappointed Danny.

NICOLE

I can't believe they filled my timeslot so fast.

DANNY

Neither can I.

NICOLE

Don't worry, Danny, there'll be other openings.

DANNY

Yeah, but you heard the lady, it could be two or three months. I need this now.

Frustrated, Danny turns and heads for the door behind him.

NICOLE

Danny... wait... that's the wrong....

(X)

Danny doesn't hear her and starts to open the door as we:

CUT TO:

16 INT. MISTER WACKY'S SET - CONTINUOUS - DAY

16

Mister Wacky is on the air, standing in front of the camera and dressed like a dentist. He is just finishing pulling a pair of plastic surgical gloves over his hands. There is a dummy sitting in a dentist chair just behind Mister Wacky.

MISTER WACKY

Okay, everybody have their gloves on? We wouldn't want to leave fingerprints on the victim... I mean patient.

Suddenly, Danny comes through the door in the background, and immediately realizes his mistake as he looks at Mister Wacky in stunned disbelief.

DANNY

Sorry.

Danny starts to go, but Wacky stops him.

MISTER WACKY Hold it right there!

Danny stops as Wacky crosses to him and we SEE Nicole in the background as she comes around the edge of the set.

> MISTER WACKY (continuing) Well, look who's here, boys and girls... the neighborhood bully. You know, the one who always gives Mister Wacky a hard time.

Mister Wacky flips down the dentist mirror he's wearing on his head and carefully examines Danny's face.

> MISTER WACKY (continuing) And an ugly face like this can only mean one thing. This sucker's got a toothache.

Danny plays along with Mister Wacky by holding his cheek with his hand.

> DANNY (in pain) I think it's a molar.

MISTER WACKY Well, let's have a look.

Mister Wacky grabs Danny, drags him over to a dentist chair, throws the dummy off, and starts strapping Danny in with several belts.

ANGLE ON NICOLE 17

> She stands off to the side of the set and smiles as she watches Danny and Mister Wacky work together.

18 BACK TO DANNY AND MISTER WACKY

Mister Wacky finishes strapping Danny in.

MISTER WACKY Seat belts all fastened?

(CONTINUED)

(X)

18 CONTINUED:

Mister Wacky holds an imaginary mike to his mouth.

Welcome aboard, ladies and gentlemen, this is your Captain speaking. We'll be cruising at thirty thousand feet.

(suddenly hysterical)
Oh, my God, we're going down!
Bail out, baby! Bail out!

(back to normal; to Danny)
Only kidding.

Mister Wacky throws off his pilot's hat, then leans over Danny.

(continuing)
Open wide. Wider. Wider.
(screaming)
I said wider!
(a beat; echoing into
Danny's mouth)
Hello, hello, hello, lo, lo,
lo...
(to audience; with a
wink)
I guess that's wide enough.
(to Danny)
Don't move... I'll be right back.

Mister Wacky moves away.

DANNY
Take your time.
(turning to camera)
What a guy. He also fixes cars...
an absolute genius with mufflers.

Mister Wacky returns holding a giant, plastic hypodermic needle behind his back.

DANNY
(referring to his hair)
Could you take a little off the back and trim the sides?

Mister Wacky reveals the giant hypodermic.

MISTER WACKY Relax, you won't feel a thing.

Mister Wacky lets out an HYSTERICAL LAUGH as he pushes down the plunger on the hypodermic and squirts water all over Danny.

18 CONTINUED: (2)

Wacky tosses the hypodermic aside, then rushes to a closet and pulls out a huge pair of rubber pliers. He runs back to Danny in the chair and hovers over him.

MISTER WACKY
I'm going in. Any last words?

Danny looks at the pliers and SCREAMS.

DANNY

Help!

MISTER WACKY

That's good.

Mister Wacky thrusts the pliers into Danny's wide open mouth, then starts pulling. Danny's legs flail all over as Wacky slowly climbs up the chair to get better leverage. Finally, Wacky gives one final yank and pulls the pliers out of Danny's mouth. Pinched in the pliers are a pair of CHATTERING FALSE TEETH. Wacky jumps to the floor and examines the teeth at the end of the pliers.

That ought to do it.
(to Danny)
How do you feel?

Danny talks like all his teeth are gone.

DANNY (mumbling)
Better. Much, much better.

Danny smiles a toothless grin as Mister Wacky pushes a button on the console and we HEAR WILD APPLAUSE. Mister Wacky turns and acknowledges this with a wave and a bow.

19 ANGLE ON NICOLE

as she APPLAUDS along with the canned audience.

20 BACK TO WACKY AND DANNY

They look at each other and smile, both of them pleased that they've turned a near-disaster into a very funny skit.

21 INT. MUSIC CUBICLE - DAY (DAY THREE)

Jesse sits at a synthesizer, accompanying Dusty as she BELTS OUT his SONG.

(CONTINUED)

(slowly smiling)

Unbelievable!

Jesse jumps up from the piano, crosses to Dusty, and gives her a big hug.

DUSTY

You really liked it?

JESSE

(excited)

Dusty, you made it come to life.

DUSTY

The song's beautiful, Jesse.

JESSE

So are you.

DUSTY

(slightly embarrassed)

Come on. Me?

JESSE

I mean it, Dusty. You're great.

DUSTY

(pleased)

Yeah? If you say so.

(X)

They smile at each other.

INT. HALLWAY - DAY 22

Jesse and Dusty come out of the music room together.

JESSE

All I have to do is lay down some tracks, then we'll cut the demo together.

DUSTY

I can't wait.

Jesse gives Dusty another hug, then turns and heads off down the hallway. Dusty looks after him for a moment, then CAMERA DOLLIES WITH her as she moves down the hall in the opposite direction. She passes Jillian at her locker.

JILLIAN

Hey, Dusty, how was Jesse's song?

DUSTY

Perfect.

(still walking; to

herself)

Just like Jesse.

Dusty smiles as she continues walking down the hallway.

23 INT. LOU'S LANES - BANDSTAND - DAY

(X)

23

An excited Danny paces back and forth while Chris sits on a stool, SHUFFLING a deck of CARDS.

DANNY

You should have seen us, man. It was like we'd been working together for years.

CHRIS

And improv is the hardest thing to pull off.

(holding out cards)

Here ... pick a card.

Danny takes a card from the deck and looks at it.

DANNY

That Mister Wacky is a pro.

CHRIS

So are you.

Danny hands the card back to Chris who SHUFFLES it into the deck. Chris pulls out a card, the ace of diamonds, and holds it up.

CHRIS

(continuing)

I believe your card was the ace

of diamonds.

DANNY

Nope.

CHRIS

Sign on the dotted line.

25 INSERT OF PAPER

The only thing on it is a crudely drawn dotted line.

(X)

DANNY

I'm only on page ten.

MISTER WACKY

(crushed)

You don't like it! My life

doesn't move you?

DANNY

It's not that.

Mister Wacky grabs the manuscript away from Danny.

MISTER WACKY

Never mind.

Mister Wacky throws the manuscript out the window of the set.

MISTER WACKY (continuing; cavalier)

It's not important.

Mister Wacky walks over to a photo of a little girl that's hanging on the wall and sadly leans his head against it.

MISTER WACKY

(continuing; tortured)
Peggy... Peggy... they don't
understand.

DANNY

(tentatively)

Who's Peggy?

MISTER WACKY

(looking at the picture

adoringly)

My daughter... the light of my life. I haven't seen her since her mother and I divorced. You can't imagine how I miss her. This sweet little face means everything to me. Peggy, lovely, darling Peggy....

(a beat)

... or is her name Judy? Judy, Peggy, whatever, the little brat never writes!

Mister Wacky turns the picture over to face the wall, then moves back to Danny, acting like the outburst never occurred.

MISTER WACKY

(continuing)

So you excited about being part of "Mister Wacky's World?"

DANNY

Who wouldn't be.

MISTER WACKY

Are you saying that because you

mean it?

(taking Danny's wallet

out)

Or because you want your wallet back?

DANNY

(smiling)

A little of both.

Mister Wacky tosses the wallet to Danny.

MISTER WACKY

Now, Danny, there's something I

have to tell you.

(a beat)

I love your name!

(CONTINUED)

(X)

28 CONTINUED: (2)

DANNY

(somewhat confused)

Thank you.

MISTER WACKY

But it's wrong for the show.

Mister Wacky moves over to a painting on the wall and takes it off to reveal a safe.

Danny shakes Mister Wacky's hand and smiles.

DANNY

Noodles?

CUT TO:

29 INT. CAFETERIA - CLOSE ON T.V. SET - DAY (DAY FIVE)

29

Mister Wacky is on-the-air with Danny as Noodles, standing against the wall with a metal conductor cone on his head. Mister Wacky is acting like a game show host.

Now for the car, the trailer, and dream vacation for two in Lubbock, Texas, what is the chemical symbol for water?

(X)

DANNY
(as Noodles)
I know that one. H2o.

MISTER WACKY Unfortunately, you're absolutely correct.

Mister Wacky throws the big electrical switch on the wall beside Danny to "on." Danny squirms and shakes as we HEAR the SOUND of CRACKLING ELECTRICITY. OVER this, we also HEAR LAUGHTER as CAMERA WIDENS TO REVEAL the kids, including Nicole, Jesse, Jillian, Dusty, and Danny, watching the T.V. set. From the HYSTERICAL LAUGHTER, it is obvious that the kids are enjoying the show. On the T.V. set, Mister Wacky is smiling into camera and waving good bye as Danny continues to squirm in the background, trying desperately to reach the electrical switch with his hand.

Well, that's all we have time for today. Thanks for tuning in. We'll see you next time on "Mister Wacky's World." Wave good-bye, Noodles.

(to Danny)
Amatullo, you finally
found someone as crazy

DANNY Mister Wacky's crazier!

The kids continue to LAUGH as they watch Mister Wacky and a squirming Danny wave good-bye. "Moon River" starts PLAYING as the screen goes to black and the credits roll. The kids turn to Danny and APPLAUD his performance. Danny is very pleased by their response to the program and his work.

DANNY

(a la announcer)
And remember you can watch Mister
Wacky and Noodles every week on
your local station.

(X)

They give Danny one more CHEER, then one of the kids TURNS OFF the T.V. and everyone starts dispersing. A BAND begins TUNING UP in the background.

(X)

30 NEW ANGLE

Dusty, Jillian, Jesse, Nicole and several other kids surround Danny.

JILLIAN

So how does it feel being a big T.V. star?

DANNY

It's only public access.

DUSTY

You'd be surprised how many people watch Mister Wacky.

JESSE

Yeah, he's very hot with the intelligentsia

NICOLE

And college kids.

JILLIAN

I heard he was going to be on the cover of Andy Warhol's magazine next month.

DANNY

Well, I did hear that we're David Letterman's favorite show.

The band starts playing some MUSIC in the background.

NICOLE

Face it, Danny, Mister Wacky is hip.

JESSE

And so are you.

DANNY

Two weeks ago, I was Danny Amatullo from the Bronx. Now I'm hip.

(a beat)

I like it.

Danny moves to the platform where the band is playing and starts SINGING a SONG about what it's like to be a hip, trendy, and successful performer ("I'm Hip" by The Romantics). As the NUMBER ENDS and the kids go their separate ways, we SEE Dusty start to approach Jesse, but then she stops. Jesse heads out the door and Dusty looks after him, obviously struggling with something. After a beat, she runs after him.

31 INT. HALLWAY - DAY

CAMERA DOLLIES WITH Jesse as Dusty follows behind him. Suddenly, Jesse stops at his locker and Dusty almost bumps into him. He smiles as he takes a cassette tape from his pocket.

JESSE
Hey, Dusty, I finished doing the music tracks for our song. We can lay down the vocal whenever you're ready.

Jesse gives her the tape.

DUSTY

Great.

Dusty just stands there as Jesse exchanges some books in his locker.

JESSE

So what's new?

DUSTY

(blurting it out)
I won two concert tickets!

JESSE

That's great. I never win anything. Who's playing?

DUSTY

U2.

JESSE

My favorite band.

DUSTY

Really? Yeah, they're pretty hot.

JESSE

Who you taking?

DUSTY

(hesitant)

I'm not sure exactly. I mean,

no one yet.

(a beat)

If you want to go... that would be okay.

Jesse closes his locker.

JESSE

Name the time and I'm there.

DUSTY

Eight o'clock, Saturday. At the Garden.

JESSE

It's a date.

(a friendly hug) U2! This is gonna be a blast.

Jesse turns and moves away.

DUSTY

(calling after him)

I hope so.

(to herself; excited)

I hope so!

All smiles and walking on air, Dusty heads off in the opposite direction.

32 INT. LOU'S LANES - NIGHT (DAY SIX)

Danny is signing autographs for several admirers, including LAURA MACKIE.

DANNY

(as he writes)

To Laura... Don't ever change ...

Love ya....

LAURA

And can you sign it "Noodles?"

DANNY

How about Danny "Noodles"

Amatullo?

LAURA

I guess that's okay.

Danny finishes signing the autograph, then hands it to Laura.

LAURA

(continuing; kidding)

Who knows, this could be worth

big money someday.

Danny smiles, then heads for the lounge.

(X)

(X)

33 NEW ANGLE

Lou carries a stack of paper in his hands as he comes down the stairs and intercepts Danny.

LOU

Hey, Amatullo, how about a few autographs?

Lou offers Danny the stack of paper.

DANNY

You call that a few?

LOU

You can divide them up between you and the Wack Man.

Lou hands the paper to Danny.

LOU

(continuing)

Whenever you get a chance.

Lou retreats back up the stairs.

CHRIS (O.C.)

Hey, Amatullo....

Danny reacts, then heads into the lounge.

34 ANGLE ON STAGE

Chris is carefully juggling three oranges as Danny approaches and reacts.

DANNY

Don't tell me you're still trying to spice up the act.

CHRIS

Yeah, and it's not getting any easier.

Suddenly, Chris loses control and the oranges fall to the floor. Danny helps Chris retrieve his oranges.

CHRIS

I've been watching the show. Funny stuff.

(CONTINUED)

(X

DANNY

You ain't seen nothing yet. I'm really getting a handle on this "Noodles" guy. I've got some great bits for Mister Wacky, too.

CHRIS Sounds exciting.

DANNY

It is. I'm a lucky man, Donlon.

Danny glances down at the orange he's holding and gets inspired.

DANNY

(continuing)

Hey, you ever think about juggling grapefruits instead of oranges?

CHRIS

(a revelation)

You're right, grapefruits would be funnier.

DANNY

It's my gift to you.

Danny smiles, then tosses the orange to Chris.

DANNY

(continuing)

Catch you later.

Danny turns and heads out of the lounge.

35 NEW ANGLE

Lou passes Danny on his way out.

LOU

(to Chris; indicating

Danny)

That kid's on a roll.

Lou heads off to the counter as CAMERA HOLDS ON Chris who continues to look after Danny.

CHRIS

Couldn't happen to a nicer guy.

(a beat; to himself)

Except me.

36 EXT. NEW YORK STREET - NIGHT

Dusty and Jesse walk along together, both of them very up from the concert and truly enjoying each other's company.

JESSE

I can't believe it... you like Science Fiction?

DUSTY

I've been reading it for years.

JESSE

That's all I ever read.

They stop walking and turn to each other.

DUSTY/JESSE

(simultaneously)

"Stranger in a Strange Land."

They both LAUGH.

JESSE

My favorite book.

DUSTY

Mine too.

They smile at each other, then resume walking as Jesse innocently puts his arm around Dusty's shoulder.

JESSE

It's incredible.

DUSTY

Tell me about it.

(a beat)

Jesse, I had a wonderful time tonight.

JESSE

So did I.

They arrive at a corner and stop as Jesse tries to flag down a cab.

JESSE

(continuing)

Yo, cab!

A cab pulls to a stop at the curb and they cross to it.

DUSTY

I wish it didn't have to end.

JESSE

Hey, the concert lasted three hours. Wasn't that enough?

They arrive at the cab as Dusty stops and nervously glances at She wants to say something, but she's not sure how. Jesse.

DUSTY

I don't mean that. It's being

with you.

(a beat; tentative)

Most guys only care about what's

on the outside.

(a beat; nervous)

And I got too much outside.

JESSE

Outside, inside... they both look good to me.

Jesse sees that Dusty is becoming more and more nervous.

JESSE

(continuing)

Are you all right?

She buries her head into his shoudler and snuggles up close as Jesse reacts to this unexpected display of affection.

JESSE

Dusty....

Dusty looks up at Jesse.

DUSTY

(blurting it out)

Jesse, I'm so happy I found you.

JESSE

What? (surprised)

(a beat; smiling)

You're putting me on. Right?

DUSTY

(humiliated)

Putting you on?

Overwhelemed with embarrassment, Dusty turns to get into the cab as Jesse realizes the seriousness of the situation and tries to stop her.

JESSE

Dusty, wait.

(X)

36 CONTINUED: (2)

She pulls away from him and gets into the cab, shutting the door behind her. After a beat, the cab pulls away as a very upset Jesse watches it disappear down the street.

37 INT. WACKY'S WORLD SET - DAY (DAY SEVEN)

"Mister Wacky's World" is on-the-air as Mister Wacky, dressed in a yachting outfit, sits atop a Pitch 'n Dunk water tank, holding a baseball in his hand.

Welcome to Mister Wacky's
Carnival. We're here today to
raise money for a very worthwhile
cause... Mister Wacky.
(looking offstage)
Oh, I see someone coming now.

38 NEW ANGLE

as Danny, dressed as Noodles, enters the set.

MISTER WACKY
(continuing)
Why, it's Noodles! Want to take
a shot at me, pal? It'll only
cost you five bucks.

DANNY
No... cause I know what'll happen.
I'll be the one who gets wet.

MISTER WACKY
Come, come, my paranoid little
friend. How could you get wet?
You're nowhere near the tank.
(tosses Danny the ball)
Trust me.

Danny takes out a big, funny five dollar bill and sets it down on a nearby table, then lines up to throw the ball.

39 ANOTHER ANGLE

Danny takes aim and lets the ball fly.

40 INSERT OF TARGET

The ball hits right in the middle.

41 BACK TO SCENE

Nothing happens, but, after a beat, a torrent of water drops down on Danny.

MISTER WACKY
Tough luck, Noodles. Care to try
again?

Danny suddenly breaks away from his Noodles character as he turns to CAMERA and does a great imitation of the Wicked Witch from "The Wizard of Oz."

DANNY
Oh, what a world, I'm melting...
melting...

Danny slowly "melts" down into the floor, then suddenly jumps back up and starts SINGING "Singing in the Rain."

DANNY
(continuing; singing)
"I'm singing in the rain. Just singing in the rain..."

42 ANGLE ON MISTER WACKY

as he watches Danny perform and can't help but enjoy his discovery's talent.

DANNY (O.C.)
"What a glorious feeling, I'm happy again."

MISTER WACKY You're killing 'em, babe!

43 BACK TO DANNY

He moves over to the spot where he got hit with the water and looks up as he continues to SING.

DANNY
(singing)
"I'll waltz down the lane, to a happy refrain."

Danny is drenched with water once again.

MISTER WACKY Bring it on home, Noodles!

Danny smiles, then starts strolling towards Mister Wacky and the water tank.

DANNY

(singing)

"I'm singing "

(singing very fast)

"... just singing in the rain."

Danny rushes towards the dunking apparatus and pushes the target with both hands. A stunned Wacky plunges into the tank of water and flounders around like a netted tuna.

44 INT. DRESSING ROOM IN TELEVISION STUDIO - DAY

Danny is in a robe and drying his hair with a towel as Mister Wacky comes in the door, still dripping wet. He carries a Polaroid camera which he offers to Danny.

What's this for?

MISTER WACKY

(posing)

Say cheese.

Danny hesitates a moment, then aims the camera and shoots. The picture pops out and starts developing as Danny pulls it out of the camera. Mister Wacky crosses to Danny and takes the picture from him.

(looking at picture)
Ah, yes, just as I thought.
(to Danny)
What's wrong with this picture?

DANNY The lighting?

MISTER WACKY
Mister Wacky is wet. And why is
he wet? Because Noodles dunked
him.

DANNY I was improvising.

MISTER WACKY
The audience doesn't tune in to
see you improvise. If they did,
the show would be called "Mister
Noodles' World."

(X)

44 CONTINUED:

DANNY

(insisting)

You've got to admit it was funny.

MISTER WACKY

But it wasn't necessary. Mister Wacky is funny enough for both of us.

DANNY

But I saw you laughing.

MISTER WACKY

No, no, no, you don't understand. This is not open for debate.

DANNY

I think it is.

MISTER WACKY

Okay, it's a debate. And I win.

(a beat)

Am I getting through to you?

DANNY

You're saying you don't want to hear my ideas.

MISTER WACKY

(touching nose)

Exactly.

DANNY

(disappointed)

And I keep being the stooge.

MISTER WACKY

Brilliant. That's my boy.

Mister Wacky gives Danny a hug, then turns and moves OUT OF SHOT as CAMERA PUSHES IN CLOSE ON Danny.

MISTER WACKY (O.C.)

It's going to be a great year,

Noodles. Right?

Danny isn't so sure as he looks after Mister Wacky.

DANNY

Right.

Danny starts to turn and we:

QUICK CUT TO:

45 REVERSE ANGLE ON DANNY (MISTER WACKY'S WORLD SET)

45

as he completes his turn, he's hit flush in the face with a pie. OVER this, we HEAR the SOUND of CANNED LAUGHTER as CAMERA PANS TO REVEAL a smiling Mister Wacky, mugging for the television camera. He stands in front of a small, children's organ and accompanies himself as he SINGS his rendition of "Moon River."

(X)

CUT TO:

46 SERIES OF SHOTS IN MISTER WACKY SET

46

(X)

MUSIC continues OVER as Mister Wacky subjects Noodles to abuse, done in quick staccato cuts which build in momentum, each hitting Danny worse than the previous one.

- A) A DOOR SLAMS in Noodles' face.
- B) Seltzer is sprayed in his face.
- C) DOOR SLAM!
- D) Eggs are BROKEN over his head.
- E) Pie in the face.
- F) DOOR SLAM!
- G) DOOR SLAM!
- H) Noodles holds a bomb which EXLODES in his face.
- I) DOOR SLAM!
- J) A humungous mass of green slime pours down over Noodles.
- 47 CLOSE ON DANNY

47

Totally covered with green slime. He tries to wipe the gooey substance off his face as the SOUND of CANNED LAUGHTER plays OVER. The look in Danny's eyes tells us that playing Noodles and being a stooge for Mister Wacky's abuse is starting to get him. We FREEZE FRAME ON Danny, HOLD for a moment, then:

FADE OUT.

(X)

ACT THREE

FADE IN:

48 EXT. LOU'S LANES - DAY (DAY EIGHT)

It is lunchtime and the kids from SOA are hanging out in front of Lou's. CAMERA PICKS UP Jesse as he crosses to the front window and looks in. Nicole has just finished playing one of the video games as Jesse knocks on the window, gets her attention, then waves for her to come outside. CAMERA TRACKS WITH Jesse as he moves to the door and opens it for Nicole.

JESSE Have you seen Dusty?

NICOLE She's really upset, Jesse.

CAMERA DOLLIES WITH them as they move across the street through a maze of cars stuck in a traffic jam.

JESSE We went to a concert. It was no big deal.

NICOLE
It was to Dusty. She thought you liked her.

I do like her.

Jesse, she thought you "liked" her.

They arrive at the front of the school and head up the steps.

JESSE Is that my fault?

NICOLE Come on, this is me you're talking to. I've seen you in action.

They go into the school.

49 INT. LOBBY - CONTINUOUS - DAY

Jesse and Nicole come up the steps and move across the lobby.

NICOLE

I know how you can turn on that Latin charm. Admit it, you love to flirt.

JESSE

Okay, but nobody takes it seriously.

NICOLE

Dusty did.

JESSE

What am I gonna do?

NICOLE

Talk to her.

JESSE

I don't know what to say.

NICOLE

A little honesty wouldn't hurt.

Jesse nods as they start up the stairs.

JESSE

(kidding)

None of this would have happened if we hadn't broken up.

An uncomfortable beat as we see the pain of their separation hasn't totally disappeared for either of them.

NICOLE

(lightly)

That wasn't my fault.

JESSE

Well, it wasn't mine.

NICOLE

Was to.

JESSE

Was not.

Jesse and Nicole disappear up the stairs as CAMERA PICKS UP Danny and Jillian coming down the hallway. Jillian carries a a magazine.

49 CONTINUED: (2)

JILLIAN

This is fantastic, Danny. An article on you in New York Magazine.

DANNY

It's really about Mister Wacky.

JILLIAN

That's you in the picture --

DANNY

Yeah, under two quarts of motor oil.

JILLIAN

Listen to this....

(reading magazine)
'As for Mister Wacky's sidekick,
Noodles, he can take a pie with
the best of them.'

DANNY

I finally get a good review and it's under an assumed name.

JILLIAN

Everybody knows you're Noodles.

DANNY

(testy)

But I'm not Noodles. I'm Danny Amatullo. There's a difference, you know.

Jillian reacts with surprise to Danny's sudden outburst.

BOY STUDENT (O.C.)

Hey, Noodles!

DANNY

(reacting; to Nicole)
I'm beginning to hate that name.

50 NEW ANGLE

50

(X)

Danny turns as the BOY STUDENT catches him completely off guard and SMASHES a pie into his face. As he wipes the pie away with his hand, Danny's grabs the Student and starts to slam him against the wall, but he stops when he realizes the lobby is filled with kids LAUGHING AND APPLAUDING at what looks like a planned stunt. The Boy Student LAUGHS too.

BOY STUDENT Love you on Mister Wacky.

The APPLAUSE continues as Danny turns to Jillian who is trying her best not to crack up. Unable to tolerate anymore of the LAUGHTER, Danny angrily pushes through the students, and disappears down the steps of the main entrance.

51 INT. LOU'S LANES - DAY

Chris is onstage, rehearsing a great DRUM SOLO as Lou looks on from behind the lunch counter. Danny is lost in his own thoughts, sitting at the end of the counter, drinking a coke. There's nobody else in the lounge.

52 ANGLE ON LOU

He's not thrilled with what Chris is doing as he checks his watch, then shakes his head as if to say "enough already."

53 ANGLE ON CHRIS

He FINISHES with a BIG FLOURISH, then crosses to Lou and Danny at the counter.

CHRIS

(twirling drumsticks)
That should add about ten minutes
to the act.

LOU

Eleven-twenty to be exact. Which is about eight minutes too long.

CHRIS

I thought you liked my drumming.

LOU

I do. But a bowling ball only needs three holes. You get what I'm saying?

Chris thinks for a moment, trying to figure it out, then gives up.

CHRIS

No.

Lou grabs the the drumsticks away from Chris as Danny reacts and listens to Lou's words which hit very close to home.

(CONTINUED)

LOU

You don't need these. Just like you don't need the card tricks or the juggling or the other crazy stuff you been throwing into your act.

(a beat)

You're a singer, Donlon. Sing!

CHRIS

That's what I want to do. But what if it's not enough?

LOU

Kid, you do your act the way you want, and they'll be talking about Chris Donlon long after this place is history.

CHRIS

You think so?

LOU

I guarantee it.

Lou heads for the stage as Danny gets up from the counter and moves after him.

DANNY

(passing Chris)
He's right, Donlon. You don't
need gimmicks.

54 NEW ANGLE

Lou is setting up the microphone on the stage as Danny runs over to him.

DANNY

Hey, Lou, how about I perform here some night?

LOU

(excited)

You and Mister Wacky? On my stage?

DANNY

No, I thought maybe I'd do a solo.

LOU

Noodles without Mister Wacky? (a beat) You think the audience'll buy it?

DANNY (hiding his disappointment) Probably not. Forget it.

Danny quickly turns and heads out of the room.

Feeling lonely and depressed, Danny comes out the door, then walks off down the street.

56 INT. HALLWAY - OUTSIDE LOCKER ROOMS - DAY

> Jesse stands across from the entrance to the girls' locker room, waiting. After a beat, Dusty comes out of the door, spots Jesse, and quickly heads for the back stairs. Jesse moves after Dusty and stops her on the stairs.

> > JESSE

Dusty

DUSTY

(embarrassed)

I can't talk now. I'm be late for class.

JESSE

Too late ... we're already talking.

DUSTY

Look, just forget about the other night. I acted stupid.

JESSE

I wouldn't call it stupid. Things got a little mixed up, that's all.

DUSTY

You shouldn't have said all those nice things about me.

JESSE

Why not.

DUSTY

You didn't mean them.

JESSE

But I did. I like you, Dusty.

Dusty didn't expect this. Maybe there's hope.

DUSTY

I like you too.

(a beat; tentative)

Maybe we should try again

d try again... (X)

JESSE

Wait, Dusty, I don't want to lead you on.

A beat as Dusty realizes that Jesse is definitely not interested in her romantically.

DUSTY

(a beat; hurt)

It's because of the way I look, isn't it?

JESSE

No... you're pretty.

(X)

56

(X)

DUSTY

Yeah, pretty for a fat girl.

JESSE

It's got nothing to do with your weight.

DUSTY

You're just saying that!

(a beat)

I thought you were different.

JESSE

Look, I'm sorry I don't feel about you the same way you feel about me.

(a beat; struggling)
But that's how it is.

DUSTY

I thought we had something.

JESSE

We do. Our friendship.

Dusty doesn't want to hear this as she starts up the stairs, but Jesse grabs her by the arm.

JESSE

(continuing)

Maybe that doesn't mean anything to you, but it does to me.

(a beat)

If you want to throw it away, that's your decision, not mine.

They look at each other for a moment, then Jesse lets go of her and moves off down the hallway. Upset and confused, Dusty looks after him.

INT. TELEVISION STUDIO - DAY 57

Danny comes in the door and reacts to the SOUND of someone "singing" the "1812 Overture," complete with crashing cymbals. CAMERA PANS WITH Danny as he crosses to the Mister Wacky set to find Mister Wacky, dressed in a wetsuit with facemask and fins, prancing around a big cannon, "singing" and clashing cymbals together at the appropriate moment. Mister Wacky stops when he sees Danny.

MISTER WACKY

(excited)

Noodles, I have incredible news from Rome. The gods have smiled on us.

Danny's attention is focused on the cannon.

DANNY

(referring to cannon) What's that doing here?

MISTER WACKY It's for the circus gag. You're supposed to be shot out of the cannon, but your foot gets stuck and the whole thing blows up with you still inside.

DANNY

Do I survive?

MISTER WACKY Noodles always survives. We'll burn out your clothes, cover you with soot, all that good stuff

Danny looks at the cannon and shakes his head.

DANNY

No....

What do you mean, no?

DANNY I can't do it.

MISTER WACKY
Of course, you can. The
audience'll love it.

DANNY
Look, I appreciate all you've done
for me, but the joke's getting
old fast. I've had it.

Danny turns and starts to go, but Mister Wacky stops him.

MISTER WACKY
Hey, if you've got a problem, we can solve it. I'm a very sensitive guy. Come on, talk to me.

DANNY
The problem is you'll always be Mister Wacky and I'll always be Noodles.

What's wrong with that?

DANNY
I'm tired of being blown up.

58 NEW ANGLE

as Danny moves around Wacky and heads for the exit. Wacky rushes after Danny and grabs him by the arm.

What are you, outta your mind?
You can't leave. You think the
kind of chemistry we have is easy
to find? I've been looking for
twelve years. Twelve years of
paying thirty-five dollars a week
to be on public access. And now,
when things finally start to
happen, you walk out.

DANNY
I'm sorry, but how many times can a guy get hit with a pie?

DANNY

I kinda made up my mind.

MISTER WACKY (O.C.)

It's all too much for Danny as his affection for Mister Wacky gets the best of him.

DANNY

Okay.

MISTER WACKY (O.C.)

Okay what?

DANNY

I'll stay.

MISTER WACKY (O.C.)

Good.

The feet drop out of SHOT, then, after a beat, Mister Wacky pops back up.

MISTER WACKY

(continuing)

I knew I could con ... vince you.

59 NEW ANGLE

59

Mister Wacky takes Danny by the arm and leads him back into the set.

MISTER WACKY

We're finally going to have it all. Money... fame... all the sushi we can eat! The days of being starving cult heroes are over. Wow, are we happy!

Mister Wacky pushes a button on the wall and a bucket of green slime pours down all over himself. Danny can't help but laugh.

MISTER WACKY

(to Danny)

Come to me, my Noodles!

Mister Wacky moves to Danny and throws his arms around him, sliming him in the process.

as Mister Wacky hugs him. He's already having doubts about what he's gotten himself into.

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT THREE

The usual amount of activity in front of the school. OVER this, we HEAR MUSIC (the musical track of Jesse's song).

NICOLE (O.C.)
It's going to be a great song.

63 NEW ANGLE

Nicole stands in the doorway as Dusty reacts to her presence.

DUSTY

It's okay.

Dusty turns OFF the cassette player.

NICOLE

Okay? I wish he'd let me sing it.

DUSTY

Go ahead.

NICOLE

He's still hoping you'll do it.

DUSTY

Sorry, I'm not available.

NICOLE

(to Oliver) Which would you suggest?

OLIVER

I really couldn't say.

MISTER WACKY

Turn around, Noodles.

Danny turns as Mister Wacky proceeds to break the two chairs across Danny's back.

MISTER WACKY (continuing; to Danny) What do you think?

DANNY The second one.

Mister Wacky still holds a piece of the second chair in his hand and he gives it to Oliver.

You heard the man.

Good choice.

Oliver moves away.

MISTER WACKY
(continuing; calling
after Oliver)
And order ten of them.

Mister Wacky puts his arm around Danny.

We can do as many takes as we want.

Danny manages a weak smile at the thought.

65 NEW ANGLE

CAMERA TRACKS WITH Mister Wacky as he leads Danny around the soundstage.

MISTER WACKY
Look around you, Noodles. We've
got new paint....

They pass a guy filling out cue cards.

MISTER WACKY
(continuing)
... cue cards...
(to guy)
... print bigger...

They approach a Chapman stage crane.

(CONTINUED)

74 NEW ANGLE

Dusty stands a few feet away from Jesse, holding up the cassette of his song.

DUSTY (continuing)

How about Monday ... three-thirty?

JESSE

You're kidding.

DUSTY

You want me to sing your song or not?

JESSE

Sure I do.

DUSTY

Then I guess we don't have a problem.

JESSE

I'm glad to hear that.

DUSTY

You better be glad.

NICOLE Congratulations, Danny. We all heard about your T.V. Special. You must be so excited.

DANNY
(watching Chris)
Yeah... Donlon's really "on"
tonight, isn't he?

NICOLE

He's the best.

CAMERA SLOWLY PUSHES IN CLOSE ON Danny as he watches Chris knock 'em dead.

80 BACK TO CHRIS

MISTER WACKY

(referring to crystal ball)

I see in here that he's a bright young comic. Looks like he'd make

an interesting Noodles.

DANNY

Looks aren't everything. This guy any good?

The crane slowly starts to lower.

MISTER WACKY
By the time I'd finish with him,
he'd be wonderful.

84 NEW ANGLE

as Mister Wacky is lowered to the floor in front of Danny. There is a long silence as Danny and Wacky just look at each other, neither of them knowing what to say next.

MISTER WACKY

(continuing)

What do you think I should do?

DANNY

(a beat)

Give him a call.

MISTER WACKY

I was afraid you'd say that.

(a beat; with affection) So, this is goodbye.

DANNY

I guess so.

(a beat)

Here's your contract.

Danny offers it to Mister Wacky, but he doesn't take it.

(CONTINUED)

MISTER WACKY
Keep it as a souvenir.
(a beat)
I hope you're not making a mistake.

DANNY

Me too.
