SCENE A

TEASER

FADE IN:

INT. MONICA & RACHEL'S LIVING ROOM - MORNING (DAY 1)
(Rachel, Monica)

MONICA IS IN THE KITCHEN PUTTING JUICE AND BANANAS INTO A BLENDER. RACHEL ENTERS FROM HER ROOM, IN A ROBE.

MONICA

Hey. How was the big anniversary

dinner?

RACHEL

We never got to dinner.

MONICA

(LEWD SMILE) Niiiice.

RACHEL

We kind of broke up instead.

MONICA

What??

STUNNED, MONICA HITS THE BUTTON ON THE BLENDER. HOWEVER, THE LID IS STILL IN HER HAND. JUICE AND BANANA GO FLYING. SHE SCREAMS AND QUICKLY SHUTS IT OFF.

RACHEL

Oh, my god. It's on the ceiling.

MONICA

(WITH EFFORT) That's okay. This is more important. You broke up??

RACHEL

But it's all right. 'Cause after Ross left, Mark came over and -MONICA

Oh, no! You and Mark?

Calm down. Mark and I talked, and I realized how much I love your stupid brother. And, yeah, we have problems, but I really, really want to make it work.

CUT TO:

SCENE B

INT. ROSS'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME (DAY 1)
(Ross, Chloe)

ROSS IS ASLEEP IN BED. HIS EYES OPEN. HE WARILY LOOKS OVER AT THE PILLOW NEXT TO HIM. NO ONE IS THERE. HE IS VISIBLY RELIEVED. JUST THEN, CHLOE STICKS HER HEAD INTO THE ROOM. SHE HAS TAKEN A SHOWER AND IS DOING HER HAIR.

CHLOE

Morning! Do you have any hair stuff that's not gel?

ON ROSS'S SINKING EXPRESSION...

FADE OUT.

ACT ONE

SCENE C

FADE IN:

INT. ROSS'S LIVING ROOM - A LITTLE LATER (DAY 1)
(Ross, Rachel, Chloe)

ROSS STRUGGLES TO OPEN AN ASPIRIN BOTTLE. HE IS FEELING LOUSY, FILLED WITH REGRET. HE NOTICES THAT THE MESSAGE LIGHT IS BLINKING ON HIS MACHINE. HE PUSHES THE BUTTON. THE MACHINE BEEPS.

RACHEL'S VOICE

Hi, it's me. It's around midnight.

I've been trying to reach you all
night. I feel awful. Please,
you've got to know there's nothing
between me and Mark. This whole
break thing is stupid, and I'm so
sorry I put you through it, and I
don't want to get back together over
a machine. I do love you.

ROSS SMILES. THIS IS THE BEST NEWS IN THE WORLD.

RACHEL'S VOICE (CONT'D)

You know what? I'll stop by on my way to work tomorrow morning, like, around 8:30. Bye.

THE MACHINE BEEPS. ROSS LOOKS AT THE CLOCK.

ROSS

(PANICKED) Chloe!

CHLOE ENTERS, NOW DRESSED, EXCEPT FOR HER SHOES.

CHLOE

What kind of puppy do you think I should get?

ROSS

(COULDN'T CARE LESS) A big one.

CHLOE

But my apartment's so --

ROSS

A small one. Look, we kinda have to get going...

CHLOE

Wait. Where are my shoes?

ROSS

You need shoes?

HE QUICKLY STARTS TO SEARCH.

CHLOE

Do I know why we're rushing?

ROSS

Well... you know the girlfriend I told you about last night? I think she wants to get back together.

Found them!

HE QUICKLY BRINGS THEM TO HER. SHE PUTS THEM ON.

CHLOE

That's so great for you guys. You must be so happy.

Yes, yes, I am. One of the many

things I'm feeling.

HER SHOES NOW ON, ROSS HUSTLES HER TO THE DOOR.

CHLOE

Well...

ROSS

Well...

CHLOE

Good luck with your girlfriend.

ROSS

Yeah, okay. Thanks.

HE OPENS THE DOOR. RACHEL IS STANDING THERE, POISED TO KNOCK. FORTUNATELY FOR ROSS, THE DOOR BLOCKS RACHEL'S VIEW OF CHLOE.

ROSS (CONT'D)

Rachel! (RE: CLOCK) Right on time!

RACHEL

Hi.

SHE ENTERS. ROSS OPENS THE DOOR AS FAR AS IT CAN GO, PRESSING CHLOE AGAINST THE WALL.

RACHEL (CONT'D)

So, what do you say? Can I be your

girlfriend again?

ROSS

You can very much.

BEHIND RACHEL'S BACK, CHLOE GIVES ROSS A THUMBS UP. HE IMMEDIATELY HUGS RACHEL AND GIVES CHLOE A SEVERE WARNING LOOK.

DISSOLVE TO: *

SCENE D

INT. MONICA & RACHEL'S LIVING ROOM - LATER (DAY 1)
(Phoebe, Monica)

MONICA IS HOLDING A MOP. SHE DIPS IT IN A BUCKET OF WATER, THEN LIFTS IT UP TO WASH THE CEILING (WE ASSUME, EVEN THOUGH WE CAN'T SEE IT). PHOEBE ENTERS, CARRYING THE MAIL.

PHOEBE

Why are you mopping the ceiling?

MONICA

There's banana on it.

PHOEBE

Wow. I've got the spirit of an old Indian woman living in mine.

MONICA

(BEAT) So then you know.

PHOEBE

Oh, the mailman was downstairs, so I brought yours up. (RE: A PACKAGE)
What's Fabulon Industries?

MONICA

(COMING OVER) Okay, don't judge me too much, but... there was this infomercial -- and I swear, I have never, ever bought anything I saw on TV before --

(MORE)

MONICA (CONT'D)

(OFF PHOEBE'S LOOK) except for this mop. But they showed this leg waxing stuff that looked so amazing --

PHOEBE

Waxine?

MONICA

Yes! Have you seen it?!

PHOEBE

Incredible! I so want to be a Waxine girl.

MONICA

I know!

PHOEBE

You really think it doesn't hurt? I mean, how do they do that?

MONICA

Hello? "Organic substances recently discovered in the depths of the rain forest"?

PHOEBE

Uch. They have the best stuff in there.

CUT TO:

SCENE E

INT. CHANDLER & JOEY'S APT. - A LITTLE LATER (DAY 1)
(Chandler, Joey, Ross)

ROSS IS TELLING HIS TALE TO JOEY AND CHANDLER.

CHANDLER

Oh, my god. Oh, my god.

JOEY

We just figured when we couldn't find you, you'd gone home to make up with Rachel. Which I guess is what you should've done, huh?

ROSS

You think?! (THEN) I'm in hell.
Rachel's, like, "I love you" and
"let's work on this". And all I
keep thinking is, what's she going
to say when I tell her what I did?

CHANDLER

I think before we answer that, we should address the equally important question: how dumb are you?

ROSS

What? We're trying to rebuild a relationship here. How can I do that without being totally honest?

JOEY

Look, I'm on board with the total honesty thing. Just not about stuff that's gonna get you in trouble.

CHANDLER

He's right. You're only going to hurt her.

JOEY

And then there's not going to be a relationship to rebuild.

ROSS

But --

CHANDLER

If you absolutely feel the need to tell her, at least wait till the timing's right. That's what your deathbed is for.

ROSS

(OFF THEIR LOOKS) Yeah, okay.

JOEY

Okay! Now, you just have to make sure she doesn't find out some other way. Have you thought about the trail?

ROSS

What trail?

JOEY

The trail from the woman you did it with to the one you hope will never find out you did it. You always have to think about the trail.

ROSS

I don't think there's any trail.

CHANDLER

Wait, wait, wait. Chloe... works with that guy Isaac... whose sister... is Jasmine... who works at the massage place with Phoebe... and Phoebe knows Rachel and that's the trail! Did it.

ON ROSS'S DESPERATE LOOK...

CUT TO:

SCENE H

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - LATER (DAY 1)
(Phoebe, Monica)

MONICA AND PHOEBE ARE TRYING OUT THE WAXINE. THEY HAVE A LITTLE POT OF WAX HEATING ON A TINY HOT PLATE. BOTH OF THEM HAVE ALREADY APPLIED SEVERAL STRIPS OF WAX AND LINEN TO ONE OF THEIR LEGS. PHOEBE READS FROM INSTRUCTIONS:

PHOEBE

"After applying the Waxine and linen strips to leg number one..."

MONICA

Did that...

PHOEBE

"...grasp one of the linen strips by its easy-grab tab and pull it off in one quick, pain-free motion."

MONICA

Okay...

SHE QUICKLY PULLS THE FIRST STRIP OFF. AND SCREAMS. IT IS UNBELIEVABLY PAINFUL. SHE GASPS FOR BREATH.

PHOEBE

(TENTATIVE) It wasn't pain-free?

MONICA

No! It was pain<u>ful</u>! Uch! They should call it "<u>Pain</u>zeen, now with a little wax"!!

PHOEBE

Huh. The girls in the satin nighties on the commercial don't seem to think it's that bad.

MONICA

Their nerves are probably deadened from being so stupid! But, hey, if you don't believe me, please, be my guest.

PHOEBE TAKES A TAB, HESITATES, THEN YANKS IT OFF. SHE LETS OUT A SERIES OF LITTLE YELPS.

PHOEBE

Oh, my god! They're such big, fat liars!

MONICA

Now aren't you glad we didn't start with the bikini strips?

CUT TO:

SCENE J

INT. COPY CENTER - A LITTLE LATER (DAY 1)
(Ross, Chloe, Isaac, Extras)

CHLOE IS BEHIND THE COUNTER. ROSS ENTERS.

ROSS

Chloe. Hi.

CHLOE

(WINCING) Is this about me taking your watch?

ROSS

You took my watch?

CHLOE

I'm sorry. I do that.

ROSS

That's okay. Keep it. Listen, did you tell anyone about us?

CHLOE

Oh, no. I feel like it really isn't anybody's business. You know?

ROSS

Exactly. So you didn't mention it
to Isaac?

HE INDICATES CHLOE'S CO-WORKER WHO IS AT THE REGISTER.

CHLOE

Oh, well, I tell Isaac everything.

Of course you do. (GOING TO ISAAC)

Isaac. Hi. We've never actually

met --

ISAAC

(BIG SMILE) You dawg.

ROSS

Yes, I suppose I am a dog. But listen, I have this girlfriend --

ISAAC

Right. That Rachel chick. From the coffee place.

ROSS

That's the one. And I would never want to hurt her --

ISAAC

Hey, man, I know. Doesn't matter how much we love 'em. Monogamy is too cruel a rule.

ROSS

Yeah, well, if you could keep this to yourself --

ISAAC

Not a problem, dude. We've got to look out for each other. We're the same, you and me.

ROSS

Actually, no, we're not.

ISAAC

Yeah, we are.

ROSS

No, we're not.

ISAAC

Yeah, we are.

ROSS

(EMPHATIC) No, we're not.

ISAAC

Okay, we're not. (BEAT) But we are.

ROSS

Fine. I just need to know that you're not going to tell your sister.

ISAAC

No problem. Well, little problem.
I already told her.

HE LAUGHS. ROSS IS NOT AMUSED.

CUT TO:

ķ...

SCENE K

INT. MASSAGE CUBICLE - A LITTLE LATER (DAY 1)
(Ross, Jasmine)

JASMINE IS SETTING UP FOR A CLIENT. ROSS ENTERS.

ROSS

Jasmine. Hi. We met at Phoebe's birthday party. I'm Ross Geller.

JASMINE

You did a bad thing.

ROSS

Yes, I did.

JASMINE

Very bad.

ROSS

Yes.

JASMINE

Very, very bad.

ROSS

I'm agreeing with you. You haven't by any chance told Phoebe yet, have you?

JASMINE

No.

Then please, please don't. I love my girlfriend, and I want a chance to make our relationship work.

JASMINE

(CONSIDERS IT) All right.

ROSS

Thank you! Thank you!

HE STARTS FOR THE DOOR.

JASMINE

But you should probably talk to my roommate. 'Cause I told him, and he knows Phoebe, too.

ROSS

Who's your roommate?

SMASH CUT TO:

SCENE M

EXT. COFFEE HOUSE - A LITTLE LATER (DAY 1)
(Ross, Gunther, Extras)

GUNTHER IS CHANGING THE CHALKBOARD. ROSS RUNS UP, OUT OF BREATH.

ROSS

Gunther! Please tell me you didn't say anything to Rachel about me and the girl from the Xerox place.

A LITTLE SMILE PLAYS ACROSS GUNTHER'S FACE.

GUNTHER

(ALL INNOCENCE) I'm sorry. Was I not supposed to?

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO

SCENE P

FADE IN:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM/INT. LIVING ROOM - MOMENTS LATER
(DAY 1)
(Monica, Phoebe, Joey, Chandler, Rachel, Ross)

MONICA AND PHOEBE STILL HAVE THE STRIPS OF WAX AND LINEN ON THEIR LEGS.

MONICA

Okay. How 'bout you pull mine off and I'll pull yours.

PHOEBE

Or you pull yours off, and I'll leave mine on... 'cause I think I can make this look work.

MONICA

Come on. We can do this.

THEY BOTH TAKE DEEP BREATHS, THEN START PULLING. THEY ALTERNATE BACK AND FORTH, SCREAMING AS THEY GO. JUST AS THEY FINISH, JOEY AND CHANDLER COME RUNNING IN.

JOEY/CHANDLER

What? What is it? Are you okay?

MONICA/PHOEBE

We're all right! It's okay!

MONICA

We were just waxing our legs.

CHANDLER

Off?

PHOEBE

For your information, it happens to be a pain like nothing any man will ever experience.

CHANDLER

Excuse me. You can not make that statement until you've been kicked in a part of your body that God only meant to be treated with kindness.

JOEY

I think women just have a lower threshold for pain than men, that's all. I mean, c'mon, it's just a little wax.

PHOEBE

Oh, really?

SHE QUICKLY TAKES THE APPLICATOR FROM THE POT AND SLAPS A LITTLE BIT OF WAX ON JOEY'S ARM. SHE STICKS A PIECE OF LINEN ON IT.

CHANDLER

Well, that was mature.

JOEY

Fine. So, now what? I just pull it off?

MONICA

That's right.

JOEY RIPS IT OFF. HE DOESN'T SCREAM, BUT TEARS BEGIN TO COME OUT OF THE CORNERS OF HIS EYES.

CHANDLER

You okay in there?

JOEY

I'm not crying from the pain. I'm crying for all the women of the world who have to do this to be so smooth.

JUST THEN, THEY HEAR THE FRONT DOOR OPEN.

ROSS (0.S.)

Talk to me.

CUT TO:

<u>INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME</u> (Rachel, Ross)

RACHEL

Talk to you? I can't even look at you right now.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

CHANDLER GINGERLY SHUTS THE BEDROOM DOOR.

MONICA

(WHISPERED) What?

CHANDLER

(WHISPERED) Nothing. It's nothing.

MONICA

(WHISPERED) Rachel said everything

was okay.

CHANDLER SHRUGS.

PHOEBE

(TO JOEY) What're they talking

JOEY SHRUGS.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

about?

RACHEL IS PACING AND WRINGING HER HANDS.

ROSS

Rachel, I --

RACHEL

No! Get away from me!

ROSS

It was a mistake. I made a mistake.

RACHEL

A mistake?! Where were you trying to put your penis, in her purse?!

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

PHOEBE

(INTRIGUED) Where did he try to

put it?

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

RACHEL

Ross, you had sex with another woman!

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

PHOEBE AND MONICA REACT TO THIS NEWS.

MONICA

Oh, my god!

PHOEBE

I can't believe this. This is the most horrible thing that's ever happened ever. I knew something had to be wrong. My fingernails did not grow at all yesterday.

CHANDLER

Apparently, they had a fight and he got drunk, and --

MONICA

(SMACKING THEM) You guys knew about this and you didn't tell us??

CHANDLER

(TO JOEY) He has sex and we get hit on the head.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

RACHEL

You know what? Just go. Leave! Now!

ROSS

No. I want to stay and talk about this.

RACHEL

(WHIPPING AROUND) Okay. How was

she?

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

CHANDLER

(LISTENING) Uh oh...

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

ROSS

(PALING) What?

RACHEL

Was she good?

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

JOEY

Don't answer that...

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

RACHEL

Come on. You said you wanted to talk about it. Was she good?

ROSS

I don't even remember. (OFF HER LOOK) She was...

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

JOEY/CHANDLER

(OFFERING SUGGESTIONS) Horrible.

Awful. Nothing compared to you.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

ROSS

She was... different.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

JOEY/CHANDLER

(WRONG ANSWER) Oooo.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

RACHEL

Good different?

ROSS

(ON THE SPOT) Nobody likes

change...

RACHEL STARES AT HIM FOR A BEAT, THEN PICKS UP A NEARBY NEWSPAPER AND JUST STARTS WHACKING HIM WITH IT.

ROSS (CONT'D)

Ow! Ow! Okay!

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

AS THEY LISTEN TO ROSS BEING HIT:

PHOEBE

(UPSET) Should we do something?

CHANDLER

Yes. Never cheat on Rachel.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME ROSS GRABS THE PAPER.

ROSS

I'm sorry! I'm sorry! I feel
horrible about this, too! Believe
me. I was out of my mind this
morning. And then when I heard your
message, I was so happy, and I just
wanted to get her out of there,
and --

RACHEL

(A NEW THOUGHT) Whoa, whoa, wait a minute. When exactly did your little friend leave?

ROSS

(UNEASY) Uh...

RACHEL

Oh, my god. She was there when I was there??

ROSS JUST HANDS HER BACK THE PAPER.

RACHEL (CONT'D)

(HITTING HIM) It just keeps getting worse!

But -- but -- but the important

thing is: she meant nothing to me!

RACHEL THROWS THE PAPER AT MONICA'S BEDRROM DOOR.

CUT BACK TO: *

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

THE FRIENDS REACT.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

RACHEL

And yet, she was worth jeopardizing our relationship!

ROSS

I didn't think there was still a relationship to jeopardize! We were broken up!

RACHEL

We were on a break.

ROSS

That for all I knew, could last forever. That, to me, is a "break up".

RACHEL

You think you can get out of this on a <u>technicality</u>??

I'm not trying to "get out" of anything. I'm telling you I thought our relationship was dead!

RACHEL

Well, you sure had a blast at the wake.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

JOEY

You know what? I don't think we should listen to this anymore.

HE REACHES FOR THE DOOR KNOB.

MONICA

What are you doing? We can't go out there now.

JOEY

Why not?

MONICA

They'll know we've been listening.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

RACHEL

Oh, god, and to hear about it from Gunther?!

C'mon, like I wanted him to tell you?? Believe me, I was running all over the place to make sure that didn't happen.

RACHEL

That is so sweet. I'm falling in love with you all over again.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

CHANDLER

We can definitely go out there.

They've got bigger things to worry about.

JOEY

Yeah, we'll be fine.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

ROSS

Look, I wanted to tell you. I did.
Joey and Chandler told me not to.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

CHANDLER

Wax the door shut. We're never leaving, ever.

DISSOLVE TO:

SCENE R

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM/INT. LIVING ROOM - LATER
(Phoebe, Joey, Chandler, Monica, Ross, Rachel)

JOEY, CHANDLER, AND MONICA ARE STILL LISTENING AT THE DOOR. PHOEBE IS ON THE PHONE.

PHOEBE

(INTO PHONE) Hi, it's Phoebe.

Someone's gonna have to take my nine o'clock with Mr. Rehak, 'cause it's, like... nine fifteen now, and I'm not there. ... No, I'm stuck in the middle of a big relationship fight.

... That's okay. It's not mine.

SHE HANGS UP AND RETURNS TO EAVESDROPPING.

CUT TO:

<u>INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME</u> (Ross, Rachel)

ROSS AND RACHEL HAVE CLEARLY BEEN AT IT FOR A LONG TIME. HIS SLEEVES ARE ROLLED UP, ETC.

ROSS

You realize I would never have done this if I didn't think, at that very moment, you were sleeping with Mark.

RACHEL

All right. Let's say I had slept with Mark. Would you have been able to forgive me?

(BEAT) Yes, I would.

RACHEL

You'd be okay? If you knew that Mark had kissed me and been naked with me and made love to me?

ROSS

(TEETH GRITTED, SUFFERING) Yes!

RACHEL

If you knew that our hot, sweaty, writhing, bodies --

ROSS

(DROWNING HER OUT) La la la la la!

Okay! It would be horrible! (THEN,

SOFTER) But I'd still want to be

with you. 'Cause it's you.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

MONICA/CHANDLER/JOEY

(MOVED) Aww...

DISSOLVE TO:

SCENE T

INT. LIVING ROOM/INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - LATER THAT
NIGHT (NIGHT 1)
(Ross, Rachel, Joey, Monica, Phoebe, Chandler)

RACHEL IS DEEP IN THOUGHT. ROSS TENTATIVELY APPROACHES HER.

ROSS

(GENTLY) What? Rachel. Tell me what you're thinking.

RACHEL

I'm thinking... I'm gonna order a pizza.

ROSS

(REACHING) Order a pizza, like...

"I forgive you"?

RACHEL JUST STARES AT HIM.

CUT TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME
(Joey, Monica, Phoebe, Chandler)

JOEY

(STARVING) Oh, man... Pizza.

Remember pizza?

MONICA

I have two Zagnut bars in my purse... (THEY BRIGHTEN; SHE REALIZES) ...on the kitchen counter.

PHOEBE

We could eat the wax. It's organic.

CHANDLER

Mmmm. Food with hair in it.

PHOEBE

Not the used wax.

CHANDLER

Right, that would be crazy.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

RACHEL PICKS UP THE PHONE AND DIALS.

ROSS

(TENTATIVELY) Can -- can I get in on that? I'm kinda hungry myself.

RACHEL

(COLD) Fine. (INTO PHONE) Hi, I'd like to order a large pizza.

ROSS

(WHISPERED) No anchovies.

RACHEL

(INTO PHONE) Extra anchovies.

ROSS

That's okay, I'll just pick them off.

RACHEL

(INTO PHONE) And can you also cut some up and put them in the sauce?

DISSOLVE TO:

SCENE W

INT. LIVING ROOM/INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - A LITTLE LATER
(NIGHT 1)
(Ross, Rachel, Phoebe, Chandler, Monica, Joey)
ROSS AND RACHEL HAVE EATEN MOST OF THE PIZZA.

ROSS

You can have the last piece.

RACHEL

I should think so. You slept with someone.

CUT TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME
(Phoebe, Chandler, Monica, Joey)

THEY'RE EATING WAX.

PHOEBE

They're gonna get through this, aren't they?

CHANDLER

Oh... sure. C'mon. They're Ross

and Rachel. They've got to.

MONICA

What if they don't?

THIS QUESTION HANGS IN THE AIR. THEN:

JOEY

You think I need a new walk?
THE OTHERS STARE AT HIM.

CHANDLER

What?

JOEY

I've been walking the same way since high school. You know those guys who just walk into a room and everybody takes notice? I think I need a take notice walk.

CHANDLER

Are you actually saying these words?

DISSOLVE TO:

SCENE X

INT. LIVING ROOM/INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - LATER (NIGHT 1)
(Ross, Rachel, Joey, Monica, Phoebe, Chandler)
RACHEL IS SILENT.

ROSS

What, now you're not even talking to me? (NOTHING) Rachel, I was out of my mind. I thought I'd lost you. I didn't know what to do. C'mon, how insane must I have been to do something like this? I don't cheat. That's not me. I'm not Joey.

CUT TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME
(Joey, Monica, Phoebe, Chandler)

JOEY

(INDIGNANT) Whoa. (OFF CHANDLER'S LOOK) Yeah, okay.

MONICA

(NEW THOUGHT) Hey. It's three in the morning, they haven't seen me come home. You notice how neither of them are wondering where I am?

PHOEBE

(POINTED) Yeah. People can be so self-involved.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

ROSS

You know, I never wanted that "break". You're the one who bailed on us. You're the one who jumped the minute things got a little tough.

RACHEL

(KNOWS IT'S TRUE) That -- that's neither here nor there.

ROSS

Oh, yeah? Well, now we're in a tough spot again. How do you want to handle it? You want to fight for us or you want to run?

SHE DOESN'T ANSWER. ROSS PRESSES ON.

ROSS (CONT'D)

Look, I did a terrible, stupid, stupid thing. I wish I could take it back. But I can't. I'm sorry. I just don't want to see us throw away something that we both know is so damn good.

(MORE)

RACHEL SOFTENS. ROSS TENTATIVELY REACHES FOR HER.

ROSS (CONT'D)

I love you so much.

RACHEL

(QUIETLY) I know.

HE KISSES HER ON HER SHOULDER. THEN ON HER NECK. AS HE STARTS TO KISS HER ON THE MOUTH:

RACHEL (CONT'D)

(PULLING AWAY) No. No! No!! I can't do this! You can't just kiss me and make it all better! It doesn't work like that! This isn't going to just go away!

ROSS

Okay. Okay.

RACHEL

(QUIETER) You have to go now.

ROSS

What? But... but we're not done.

RACHEL

Yeah, we are. I really think you should go.

ROSS

(DESPERATE) But this morning you said there's nothing so big that we can't work it out.

RACHEL

Yeah, well, what the hell did I know?

ROSS

Please. I can't imagine my life without you. Isn't there any way we can get past this?

RACHEL

(WELLING UP) No. I wish there was. But you're a totally different person to me now. I thought you were someone who could never, ever hurt me. Now I can't stop picturing you with her. It doesn't matter what you say or what you do. This has changed everything forever.

THEY ARE BOTH CRYING NOW.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - SAME TIME

THE FOUR FRIENDS ARE CRYING AS WELL.

CUT BACK TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - SAME TIME

ROSS

Come on. This can't be it.

RACHEL

Then how come it is?

ROSS SIGHS. IT'S OVER.

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT TWO

SCENE Y

TAG

FADE IN:

INT. MONICA'S BEDROOM - A LITTLE LATER (NIGHT 1)
(Phoebe, Monica, Joey, Chandler)

THE FRIENDS ARE LISTENING AT THE DOOR.

PHOEBE

It's been quiet for a long time.

MONICA

Think they're okay?

JOEY

Maybe she killed him.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - CONTINUOUS
(Rachel, Phoebe, Monica, Joey, Chandler)

THEY TIPTOE INTO THE ROOM. THEY LOOK DOWN ON RACHEL ASLEEP ON THE COUCH. MONICA PULLS THE AFGHAN OVER HER.

THE FRIENDS

(WHISPERED) 'Night. Goodnight.

JOEY, CHANDLER AND PHOEBE START FOR THE DOOR. JOEY'S WALKING A LITTLE FUNNY.

CHANDLER

(WHISPERED) Is that your new walk?

JOEY

(WHISPERED) No. I just really have to pee.

FADE OUT.
