MICHAEL

Me!

No one else wants any, leaving Pam with a big tray. She glances at the camera.

He was one of the strongest salesmen this company has ever seen. I've never come close to his numbers.

ANGELA

He's not a salesman anymore. In my opinion, a manager's job is to protect his employees from verbal abuse and man handling.

(beat)

Like you would do. If you were manager.

Dwight gets a mischievous look.

DWIGHT

Maybe not all man handlings.

Angela shoots him a look, then glances at the camera.

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - MOMENTS LATER - D1

Dwight returns.

MICHAEL

Kevin, you want to do scenes from last week?

KEVIN

Really?

MICHAEL

Yep.

MICHAEL

Jan, hey, just in time. Come on in and close the door.

JAN

... Are you showing a movie during work hours?

MICHAEL

Jan?

JAN

Michael?

Pam looks to camera, "What the hell?"

KELLY (CONT'D)

Fashion show! Fashion show! Fashion show at lunch!

22 INT. OFFICE - DWIGHT AND RYAN'S DESKS - D1

Angela walks by Dwight's desk and gives him a pointed look as she continues to the kitchen. After a beat, Dwight heads to the kitchen.

23 INT. KITCHEN - MOMENTS LATER - D1

EXTREME SPY SHOT: Angela is at the fridge and Dwight aimlessly looks through the cupboards.

THE OFFICE

ANGELA

I suppose you're happy.

DWIGHT

(suspecting a trap)

I'm not, I mean in general I'm hap-- I'm not unhappy. Are you talking about--

ANGELA

Michael is going to get us all fired.
You sat back and let him play that dumb movie and now Jan is peeved off and we're all going to lose our jobs.

DWIGHT

That won't happen.

ANGELA

You know she has it out for him.

#### DWIGHT TALKING HEAD 24

DWIGHT

Ever since Michael dumped Jan for Carol, she's been bitching out on him. Reject a woman and she will never let it go. It is one of the many defects of their kind. Also, weak arms.

#### INT. KITCHEN - CONTINUOUS - D1 25

ANGELA

You should be running this office, Dwight.

DWIGHT

Michael won't let me.

Ryan and Kelly enter from the Annex and pass through. Dwight and Angela both hustle to look occupied.

RYAN

Fives miles, that's great.

Thanks. But don't tell my mom I've been running, she thinks it makes my legs look too muscular.

RYAN

No problem, I've never met your mom.

Michael and Dwight exit into ...

Michael addresses the room.

MICHAEL

Alright. I believe that we were all watching a movie together before we were so rudely interrupted. So, let's get back in there.

Nobody moves.

MICHAEL (CONT'D)

Hellooooo? Movie Monday?! Stanley?

SPY SHOT: Dwight SPRINTS BACK AND FORTH through the parking lot, tormented, trying to figure things out.

After a beat, he takes out his cell and dials.

JAN (V.O.)

Hello.

DWIGHT

Is this Jan?

JAN (V.O.)

Who is this?

DWIGHT

Is this Jan?

JAN (V.O.)

Yes, who am I speaking with?

DWIGHT

Sorry, I had to make sure. Jan, this is Dwight Schrute.

Jan SIGHS audibly.

DWIGHT (CONT'D)

DWIGHT

Thirty four? Thirty five?

Pam comes out of the bathroom in an outfit that is much cooler than she normally wears. Kelly, Meredith and Phyllis APPLAUD her new outfit.

KELLY

It's so sexy. You look so hot.

PHYLLIS

It's really something.

Call of Duty is in progress. Karen starts to smile. CAMERA TIGHTENS on her.

KAREN

(whispering to camera) Look how cute he is.

ANGLE ON: Karen's screen. She sees "Unknown Soldier" up against a wall, facing it, and jumping repeatedly.

KAREN (O.S.) (CONT'D)

(whisper)

He can't even turn around. And he's trying to shoot with his binoculars.

THE OFFICE

39

Her soldier puts away a scoped rifle and takes out a handqun.

JIM (0.S.)

What are you whispering about back there?

KAREN (O.S.)

Nothing. You just concentrate on turning around.

JIM (0.S.)

I'm trying.

KAREN (O.S.)

Tap S, then D.

"Unknown Soldier" slowly backs up a bit, turns, and stares into Karen's pistol.

KAREN (O.S.) (CONT'D)

Any last words? No?

She executes him.

Their confidence in me is at an all time high.

Michael leans against Ryan's desk.

MICHAEL

Everything good?

RYAN

Yeah.

Michael waits. After a beat, Dwight enters.

MICHAEL

Hey Dwight. Want an M&M?

DWIGHT

No thanks, I'm stuffed.

Seriously, have an M&M, they're really good.

Michael holds out the bag, offering, and Dwight holds out his hand, accepting. Michael watches Dwight eat a few.

MICHAEL (CONT'D)

Good, huh?

DWIGHT

They're okay.

MICHAEL

I thought you weren't supposed to eat for a few hours after getting a crown put in.

DWIGHT

They have quick bonding stuff now.

MICHAEL

Oh. Sounds like a good dentist. What's his name?

DWIGHT

Crentist.

MICHAEL

Your Dentist's name is Crentist? That sounds a lot like dentist.

DWIGHT

Maybe that's why he became a dentist.

MICHAEL

My name is Scott, and I didn't become a...

Michael searches for a rhyme. He looks to Ryan, who shakes his head, and then to Pam, who shrugs.
