...taped on the window...it reads "ON VACATION"...and we HOLD on it for a long moment...until we HEAR a light, continual SQUEAK...the unmistakeable sound of tennis shoes...coming CLOSER and CLOSER...getting LOUDER and LOUDER...then coming to a STOP...and we HEAR the sound of KEYS JANGLING...and the sound of one being inserted into the door...and the door opening slightly...and then...

THE EMPLOYEES

Ees true, I am he. Back by popular demand...

(lowers shades)

...and certain outdated extradition laws...

(shades back up)

...the hombre who put the "f" in siesta, the man to whom Speedy Gonzales once said, "Hey, dude, slow down..." fresh from Me-hi-co and coming soon on kodacholor slides to living rooms everywhere...please hold your applause 'til the end...

it's... (he stops; cups his ear to the air)

...but wait...what is that sound? Could it be ... could it possibly be...the almost undetectable, yet unmistakeable collective moan of an office full of people back at work?

... and they both stop again, frustrated... and then...

Sun rises in New York first...

MADDIE

(giving in)

Well...I wouldn't know where to start...

(brightening;

(and then, straightforward)

(absently)

It's a long story, Miss Dipesto...

DIPESTO

(confused)

How did you know...it just came.

... Maddie looks over at her, confused...

DIPESTO

(holds up envelope)

It's for Mr. Addison...a refund check...for his hotel room in Mexico.

MADDIE

Oh...just put it on his desk...

... she continues to her office... then STOPS... as something registers... TURNING BACK to Dipesto...

MADDIE

...a refund check...

DIPESTO

(innocently)

Isn't that what I said?

MADDIE

(walks over,

takes envelope)

...for the hotel room...

161

DIPESTO

(to self)

Didn't I say that, too...?

MADDIE

Do you know what that means?

DIPESTO

I don't enunciate properly?

MADDIE

(looking at

envelope)

David didn't stay in Mexico... he came back after two days...

(musing)

...Why would he do that? And why would he lie about it? Why would he go to the lengths he did to make us think he did when he didn't?

How was it?

...but Maddie doesn't stop to acknowledge her, heading straight for David's office...

MADDIE

Is Mr. Addison in yet?

...Ms. Dipesto starts to answer, but before she can, Maddie GOES straight into...

(flatly)

I had my reasons...

MADDIE

What reasons?

DAVID

(angry)

I told you, I don't want to talk about it. I don't wanna talk about it with him and I don't wanna talk talk about it with you. See the pattern?

(hits each word)
I...don't...want...to...
talk...about...it...

MADDIE

(almost screams, frustrated, and then)

That's your problem.

DAVID (exasperated)

My problem?!

MADDIE

Your problem! The things you don't want to talk about.

DAVID

What are you talking about?

MADDIE

I'm talking about talking
about it!

DAVID

Slow down, you're stuttering...

MADDIE

(on a roll)

When people are close to you, they like to think they can talk about anything with you, they like to think you won't hold things in...that you won't have to hide your feelings... (pointedly)

...or lie.

DAVID

Lie?

MADDIE

Lie?

DAVID

I didn't lie. I didn't say enough to lie...

MADDIE

I don't just mean last night...

DAVID

(confused)

What?

MADDIE

(backing off)

Forget it...

DAVID

I'm trying, but you keep talking about it...

MADDIE

Okay, maybe it isn't any of my business...but I think you at least owe your father an explanation.

... David gets up from his chair... and, in no uncertain terms...

DAVID

And \underline{I} think it's time for this discussion to end.

MADDIE 170

...stares at him for a moment...her frustration boiling over... then TURNS and STORMS OUT, SLAMMING the door behind her...and...

DAVID 171

... just stands there, staring at the door...

DAVID

Five-four-three-two...

...and...

THE DOOR 172

MADDIE 173

... STRIDES back in, far from finished...

MADDIE

You know what it all boils down to...

DAVID

(starting for the sofa) Getting a lock on my door...

MADDIE

...it all boils down to selfishness!

Should I be taking notes...?

MADDIE

You're pouting, David. Your father comes to town and for some reason only you seem to know, you pout. Like a selfish child.

DAVID

Maddie...

MADDIE

You told me he doesn't feel like a father to you...Did you ever think maybe you don't feel like a son to him? Why do you suppose he asked you to be best man? Maybe because he wants things to be better. I know you think your problems are his fault...but he thinks they're yours.

DAVID

(skeptical)

He said that...?

MADDIE

Talk to him, David...He's hurt...he's a real person, and he wants his son to talk to him like a real person.

DAVID

174

...takes it all in...he's at a loss, doesn't quite know what to say...

DAVID

Sometimes talking isn't the best way...

ANOTHER ANGLE

175

... as Maddie walks over toward him... and then...

175

MADDIE

I don't believe that. I don't believe there's a problem you could have that couldn't somehow be worked out by sitting down and tactfully, and lovingly, talking it out between the two of you.

DAVID

176

...thinks about that for a moment...then, deciding something, he GETS UP from the sofa and WALKS back toward his desk...not looking at Maddie...he stops...and then, finally...

DAVID

Maddie...

(pauses another long moment, and then)

I slept with her.

MADDIE

177

... is stopped cold... and just stands there... there's a LONG SILENCE.. and then...

MADDIE

What?

DAVID

178

... moves around his desk, still not looking at her...

DAVID

Yeah, well, I'm not sure we ever actually...slept...

MADDIE

179

...SITS DOWN on the sofa...

MADDIE

What are you telling me?

DAVID
