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ACT ONE

FADE IN:

ON ELEGANTLY CLAD FEET

... skillfully negotiating a polished, black marble DANCE FLOOR as they steer a PAIR OF WOMEN'S FEET past...

A TABLE

... UNDER which we see ...

TWO MORE PAIRS OF FEET

...a MAN'S and a WOMAN'S... entwined... the woman's leg rubs seductively up and down along the inside of the man's leg in time with the music... as the woman's HIGH HEEL drops to the floor... OFF CAMERA we hear the sound of KISSING... and then, we become aware that the couple is slowly SLIPPING out of the booth and onto the floor under the table as their romance intensifies and we see RICHIE ADDISON in a passionate clutch with a raven-haired beauty named CARLA... and we STAY WITH THEM as they land... and after a moment, ANOTHER PAIR OF FEET ENTER frame and the pedestal of a WINE COOLER is planted next to the table... and then... OFF CAMERA a WAITER CLEARS HIS THROAT... but...

RICHIE AND CARLA

... continue kissing unabated ... and then ...

WAITER (O.C.) Mr. Addison...

...and then...

RICHIE

...pops his head out from under the table and smiles at the Waiter, who is somewhat less than amused...

RICHIE

Earthquake drill.

WAITER

Your wine.

...and reaches over and sips from a GLASS, then swishes it around in his mouth... savoring it, and then...

(CONTINUED)

RICHIE

Excellent nose... Oak... hay... and a kiss of pepper...

...and with that, Richie DISAPPEARS back under the table as the waiter RETIRES... and then...

RICHIE Promise me we won't hire stuffy waiters when we open our place.

CARLA (trying to disengage herself) Richie...

...but Richie silences her by planting another kiss on her mouth and then...

CARLA Richie... we shouldn't be under here.

RICHIE Worried about getting gum in your hair?

CARLA People are looking.

RICHIE So... close your eyes and you won't see them.

...and Carla resists... and then...

RICHIE Come on... close your eyes... for Richie?

...Carla CLOSES HER EYES and then... Richie pulls a RING out of his pocket and...

CLOSEUP - RING

... as he SLIPS IT ON her ring finger ...

... OPENS her eyes in surprise ...

CARLA

CARLA

Oh, Richie... it's... beautiful.

RICHIE It was my grandmother's.

CARLA

I don't know... I mean... you really think we're ready to do this?

RICHIE

No rush... Let's consider this a token of our agreement to agree that at some <u>future</u> date... yet to be determined... we <u>might</u> want to consider the <u>outside</u> <u>possibility</u> of a more formal relationship... (and then) Did I leave enough loopholes for everybody?

ANGLE ON CARLA

...a moment as Carla, very moved, gazes at the ring, then at Richie, and then, quite suddenly, she BURSTS INTO TEARS, as she bustles back up into her seat, and then...

RICHIE

...alarmed, scrambles after her...

RICHIE Carla, what's wrong?

CARLA

Nothing's wrong... everything's... right... as rain... Only I can't accept this.

RICHIE You don't like the setting?... (and then) We'll go to another restaurant... Check, please.

(CONTINUED)

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CARLA

4.

Richie... if you give me this ring... I'm afraid... (and then, and this is hard) I'll hock it.

RICHIE

I don't think my grandmother would like that very much. She's dead... but I think she'd oppose that idea from beyond the grave.

CARLA

We can't even afford this dinner... let alone the rest of our bills... and we may as well forget ever opening a restaurant.

RICHIE Who promised you he'd get back every penny of your dough?

CARLA

Richie...

RICHIE Answer the question.

CARLA

You did... but...

RICHIE

B-U-T, the three most insidious letters in the language... the word that separates people from their dreams... (and then) Carla... may I call you Carla?

...and he's on a run and she laughs...

RICHIE (CONT'D) I find the guy who swung with the loot... I get it back... you and me; big church wedding... we open a restaurant... we buy the biggest shoe we can find... fill it with tons of kids... bing, bing, bing, bing, bing. ... just looking at this guy ...

CARLA What did I ever do to deserve a guy like you?

...and Richie just looks at her a long, loving moment... and then...

RICHIE Well... I don't know for sure... but, if I had to guess... I'd say you probably weren't a formula baby.

SHOCK CUT TO:

MADDIE

... standing in the ELEVATOR... ready to meet the day... and then the ELEVATOR DOORS OPEN and a COUPLE ENTER and fall into each others' arms and begin kissing passionately and Maddie is uncomfortable at this public display of affection... and she looks up, then down, here and there, and then finally, thankfully, the DOORS OPEN and Maddie tries to EXIT...

MADDIE

Excuse me.

...but the couple is oblivious to her and Maddie has to CIRCUMNAVIGATE them to exit... and then... as Maddie SETS OFF down the hall, we...

CUT TO:

INT. BLUE MOON

...as Maddie ENTERS the office... marching past Dipesto's / desk, tossing off a cursory...

MADDIE

Morning, Miss Dipesto.

...she continues a step or two, then STOPS, turns to Dipesto's desk, which she only now notices is unmanned... she shrugs, then CONTINUES to her office door... 10

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INT. MADDIE'S OFFICE

... Maddie ENTERS, hears something, then looks over toward the couch, and then...

MADDIE Miss Dipesto?

... and then Dipesto's head pops up... and then...

MADDIE

Mr. Viola?

...and then Viola's head pops up... and then the two of them scramble out from behind the couch... and Maddie just looks at them, a shocked expression on her face...

DIPESTO

(flustered; babbling) Miss Hayes... I'm sorry... I don't know what I was doing.

MADDIE Mr. Viola... from the looks of it.

VIOLA Entirely my fault... What you just witnessed had nothing

whatsoever to do with Agnes.

MADDIE

It didn't?

DIPESTO

It didn't?

VIOLA

Of course it did... What I mean is... this round-the-clock surveillance on the Anselmo case is really taking its toll...

(and then) ...Forcing me to snatch affection wherever and whenever I can get it... no matter how inappropriate the setting.

MADDIE You and Mr. Addison were out all night again?

(CONTINUED)

VIOLA

With only each other for warmth. Not that he isn't a fine detective and a great wit... But, five nights in a row without...

... and Viola just looks at Dipesto longingly ...

DIPESTO Miss Hayes, I know it was wrong for Burt and me to sneak in here and turn your office into our own private... (searching, and then)

VIOLA (head hung low) ...nookatorium.

DIPESTO It'll never ever happen again. It's just... if you knew what it was like to go without Herbert for so long.

MADDIE

... A MOMENT, then...

MADDIE I'll take your word for it.

ANOTHER ANGLE

... as Viola tries to matt down his hair and straighten his clothes as he realizes there's nothing much more to say...

VIOLA Well... okay... I guess we'll get out of your hair then.

...Burt and Agnes start to back towards the door... and then...

MADDIE ... Is Mr. Addison in yet?

(CONTINUED)

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CONTINUED:

DIPESTO (concerned) Yes... but he doesn't have to hear about this... does he?

MADDIE

No...

ON VIOLA AND DIPESTO

... heaving relieved sighs ...

MADDIE

That doesn't mean I condone this sort of behavior in the workplace... but, I think we can let this one incident slide.

VIOLA

(buoyant) Whatta gal.

ON MADDIE

...looking at Viola like he shouldn't push his luck... and then she CROSSES past them toward the door...

MADDIE

I'm going to debrief Mr. Addison on the Anselmo case, and I'd appreciate it if you two would stop debriefing each other.

...and Maddie EXITS...

CUT TO:

DAVID'S OFFICE

...as Maddie enters...

MADDIE David... there must be

something in the air ...

(CONTINUED)

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CONTINUED:

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... she STOPS herself when she sees ...

DAVID

...face down on the sofa, jacket off, a pillow over his head, clearly asleep...

ON MADDIE

...touched by this sight... she CLOSES THE DOOR gently, makes her way to the sofa, SITS down beside him... DAVID shifts a bit... as she looks down at him... an appreciative expression on her face... and then...

MADDIE

I'm really proud of you, David... working like this... the long hours... sleepless nights... (and then) You must be exhausted.

DAVID

Hmmmm...

... as he shifts again and puts a hand up to the back of his neck and stretches...

MADDIE stressed out... tensed up....

...and David indicates his neck... and then, Maddie regards him a moment, hesitating, and then David indicates his neck once again and it's clear he wants her to rub it... and then slowly, cautiously... her obligation clear... she puts one hand on David's neck, then the other... and then...

MADDIE

Boy... you're one great big knot.

... and then Maddie starts to massage his neck ...

MADDIE Haven't done this in a while, have I?... What am I talking about? I never did this... You were always the one who gave the back rubs...

...and then David PURRS with delight under her touch, and then...

(CONTINUED)

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MADDIE (CONT'D) Y'know, David... When you finish this damn Anselmo case... I want you to take a vacation... You deserve one... a couple days on a beach somewhere... work on your tan... Or a fishing trip... (and then) Why don't you do deep sea fishing?

DAVID (O.C.) Wanna come along and bait my hook?

...and Maddie turns and looks over at...

DAVID

... in yesterday's shirt, unbuttoned, standing at the open door of his bathroom, wiping his freshly shaved face with a towel...

MADDIE

...looks back at the figure on the couch and then it hits her and she PULLS her hands back abruptly... and then, RICHIE ROLLS OVER and looks up at Maddie...

> RICHIE Oh... hi, Maddie... Mind taking a swipe at my lower lumbar?... actually... lower than my lower lumbar... store most of my tension there...

DAVID (to Richie, bundling him toward the door) ... Great seeing you... congrats... hope you and the little lady'll be very happy... bye... the blonde and I got turkey to talk.

... on his feet now ... but dragging them ...

(CONTINUED)

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RICHIE

Hold the phone, bro... Gimme a chance to say 'hey' to the boss lady... (to Maddie) ...who's looking mightee fine, I might add.

DAVID Save the butter, Rich. (to Maddie) The answer is no.

MADDIE What's the question?

DAVID You don't want to know.

MADDIE

Maybe I do.

DAVID Trust me, you don't.

... as both of them wheel on Maddie ...

RICHIE

I'm in love.

DAVID Do you have any idea what the failure rate is for a new restaurant?

RICHIE This one's slam dunk... almost... Which is where you guys come in.

DAVID And you go out.

MADDIE David, let him talk.

RICHIE Yeah, Dave, let him talk.

DAVID Fine... walk and talk.

CONTINUED: (2)

RICHIE

(as he's edged toward the door) This is about a lot more than a restaurant... This is about our future... Carla's and mine.

MADDIE

(yanking him back) Who's Carla?

RICHIE DAVID The woman of my dreams. The flavor of the month.

MADDIE

David...

RICHIE On our first date... we fell madly, deeply, passionately in love.

DAVID

(singing) She wore Blue Velvet... whoa... whoa... whoa...

...and Maddie just rolls her eyes as David SLIDES OFF into the bathroom to tie his necktie and he keeps SINGING tauntingly in the BACKGROUND... not the least bit interested in the conversation...

> RICHIE Restaurant I took her to was a horror show... sent back the food... the wine... the dessert... coffee... and got hit with a check for a 180 clams... Best evening of my life, though.

... and David POPS his head out and CROONS ...

DAVID Whoa... whoa... whoa...

... then DISAPPEARS again ... keeping up the serenade ...

RICHIE Great girl... terrible dinner... and a dream was born.

(more)

(CONTINUED)

CONTINUED: (3)

RICHIE (cont'd) We decided that if these hash slingers could charge an arm and a leg, we could open our own place... and do it right.

DAVID (belting out the finale) And I still can see Blue Velvet through my tears... (and then; bowing) Thank you.

MADDIE (to Richie) Expensive proposition... bankrolling a restaurant.

DAVID Only it is a problem... it is the problem.

RICHIE

RICHIE Dave... she's got the money.

DAVID Had the money.

Not a problem.

RICHIE All we have to do is find the guy who took it.

MADDIE Who took it?

RICHIE Benny Largo.

DAVID And he's just gonna give it back?

RICHIE He'll give it back.

DAVID Seventy-two thousand dollars?

MADDIE

Gone?

CONTINUED: (4)

DAVID Ta Ta.

MADDIE No?

Yes.

RICHIE So we lean on him a little.

DAVID

DAVID We lean?

RICHIE

I lean...

MADDIE (and then) All that money... Eileen must feel terrible.

RICHIE (correcting her) Carla... and she feels worse than terrible.

MADDIE Cheated, swindled, used, exploited.

RICHIE I knew you'd understand.

MADDIE Because I've been there.

DAVID Which is why big bro hung around to play the blues on

your heart strings... 'cause he was getting nowhere with me.

MADDIE That poor woman... You poor guy.

...and Richie musters the most hang-dog expression he can...

(CONTINUED)

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CONTINUED: (5)

DAVID

Rich... have you gone to the cops about this?

MADDIE Oh, they'll be a big help... shuffle around some papers, then it's...

RICHIE ... off to the donut shop.

MADDIE You got it. And by the time they get around to Carla's case, this... this... (really getting wound up) ...<u>snake</u>--

RICHIE

Bennie Largo.

MADDIE Bennie Largo, will have spent all their money on the Riviera or something. And where's Richie?

DAVID

In my office using up valuable oxygen.

MADDIE David... he needs help... Carla needs help... They need help... professional help... (and then; to Richie) Have you thought about hiring a detective?

ON DAVID

...slapping a palm to his forehead ...

ON RICHIE

... who gives a smile of triumph ...

DAVID

Excuse us for a second.

... as he takes her by the arm... and then he HUSTLES her out of his office, we ...

CUT TO:

DAVID

...pulling the door shut behind him... he HUSTLES her across the outer office toward her office...

DAVID

I've been working twenty-four hours a day... seven days a week... bustin' my hump, eatin' bad food... watchin' Viola's beard grow... Don't get me wrong, he's a fine detective... and a great wit.

MADDIE Where have I heard this before?

DAVID Fact is... this agency is over-worked and under-staffed... and while I love my brother like a brother...

...as they approach Maddie's office, the DOOR OPENS and Dipesto EMERGES... Her lipstick, a Rorshach test across her mouth, she CROSSES to her desk as she tucks in her blouse as Maddie and David BLAST into the office and find...

VIOLA

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...lying on the floor... shirt open... smoking a CIGARETTE... a satisfied, post-coital smile splashed across his face...

MADDIE

Out.

...and Viola VANISHES... and then...

(CONTINUED)

DAVID (CONT'D)

The thing you need to know about my brother... (and then) As a child he only brought home pets that had things seriously wrong with them.

MADDIE I think we should help him.

DAVID

Of course you do... because he's an operator and you're a soft touch... an easy mark... a sucker.

MADDIE

Just like this woman... whose bank account was cleaned out by someone she trusted...

(and then) I wake up every morning thinking how much better my life would be if I hadn't been taken like that.

DAVID

You wouldn't have met me.

MADDIE

I rest my case. But, it's not just the money, David... Don't you want to see your brother happy? Don't you want this relationship to get off to a good start?

DAVID

Relationship? Hah... Richie only falls in love after midnight...

(and then) I know what he's thinking. We track down this babe's loot, <u>he'll</u> be the hero, and she'll drop the laundry.

MADDIE

Your brother is a man in love... you can hear it in his voice... see it in his eyes...

(CONTINUED)

DAVID

He probably couldn't even tell you this babe's last name.

... and then the DOOR OPENS and Richie sticks his head in ...

RICHIE Look, guys... I don't wanna start a fight around--

MADDIE (wheeling on him) What's her last name?

RICHIE

Huh?

DAVID Carla's last name?

RICHIE

McCabe.

...and Maddie just turns and smiles at David... and then David grills Richie...

DAVID What color are her eyes?

... and then, after a moment...

RICHIE Blue... Hazel... (and then) You know... I'm not sure.

... and now David turns and smiles at Maddie ...

MADDIE Where's she from?

CONTINUED: (3)

RICHIE Back East somewhere.

> DAVID (smelling blood)

Where?

RICHIE

Beats me.

... and David flushes at the prospect of victory ...

MADDIE How old is she?

RICHIE Thirty-five.

...and Maddie is vindicated...

DAVID When's her birthday?

RICHIE What is this?

DAVID Answer the question.

RICHIE I don't know when her birthday is.

DAVID Advantage, Dave.

MADDIE Where'd you meet her?

RICHIE In a bar.

...and Maddie sags in defeat...

DAVID

Match point.

RICHIE Look... I don't know her life story... okay... only met her a couple weeks ago... but, the one thing I can tell you... (more)

CONTINUED: (4)

RICHIE (cont'd) (and then; after a moment) She's a keeper... (and then) At night... when I crash... I wanna sleep fast, so I can wake up and see her again.

ON MADDIE

... caught up in this... and then...

ON DAVID

... not buying ...

DAVID

Sheesh...

RICHIE I want to find out the answers to all those questions ... I mean she's... she's...
(and a smile flickers across his face as he conjures her up in his mind) I never let anybody inside the wire like this ... (and then; plainly, simply) It's really weird... I love her... (and then) But, look ... you're busy ... and I'm holding up the war ... Sorry to have taken your time.

... and Richie TURNS and HEADS for the door ...

ON MADDIE

... watching him go ... and then, looking to David ...

ON DAVID

...looking away... and then...

(CONTINUED)

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CONTINUED:

DAVID What's Benny Largo look like?

ON RICHIE

... TURNING BACK, he's one vast, sincere smile ...

ON DAVID

...looking to Maddie...

DAVID Don't gloat... I hate it when you gloat...

CUT TO BLACK

END OF ACT ONE

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ACT TWO

FADE IN: Provent

...at the wheel... David riding shotgun and sulking... they drive in silence for a long moment... David looking like he's being held prisoner... and David checks his watch as Maddie glances over to him... and then...

> MADDIE You're awfully quiet.

> > DAVID

Am I?

MADDIE

Yes, you are.

DAVID

Oh.

...and after a long moment...

MADDIE

I mean... usually when we're driving together, I can barely get a word in edgewise.

DAVID

Oh.

...and there's another long moment and David looks at his watch again...

MADDIE Maybe we've finally run out of things to yammer about.

DAVID

Could be.

MADDIE ...Like some old married couple.

DAVID

Hmm...

... and then David looks at his watch again ...

MADDIE David... why do you keep looking at your watch?

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DAVID

To see what time it is.

MADDIE

Look, maybe we're taking the wrong tack... Maybe there's a smarter way to find Benny Largo than going door to door... trying to shake something out of his business contacts.

DAVID

Can't think of a better way to waste...

(looking at watch) ...four hours, seventeen minutes and thirty-seven... eight... nine...

MADDIE

He's your brother.

DAVID

...one quarter of a day... dragging our fannies from one modeling agency to another... looking for Clutch Cargo...

MADDIE

Benny Largo.

DAVID

...when we could be bringing home the bacon on the Anselmo case.

... and they drive in silence for a moment, ... and then...

MADDIE

Okay..maybe Benny Largo's flown the coop... maybe he's not even in L.A. anymore.

DAVID

Local hustler... he's hustling locally.

MADDIE

If I embezzled seventy-two thousand dollars from my modeling agency... I'd want to put some real estate between my partner and I...

CONTINUED: (2)

DAVID My partner and me.

MADDIE I'd move to the south of France.

DAVID Not on seventy-two G's... Keep you in snails for a year... Max.

MADDIE If we just had a lead.

DAVID If we had a lead... we'd solve the case... and we wouldn't be having all this fun.

MADDIE David... We agreed to help your brother.

DAVID You agreed... I'm along for the ride... a long, tedious, boring, non-paying ride... but who's complaining?

MADDIE Okay... Pretend he's not your brother.

DAVID

Tried.

MADDIE Why can't you just tell yourself, you're helping two people in love.

DAVID (rolls his eyes) Saccaharin's been linked to cancer, you know.

...and they drive in silence for another long moment... and then...

DAVID Tell you one thing this little field trip's taught me... (more)

CONTINUED: (3)

DAVID (cont'd)

You had some racket going for yourself in the modeling biz... raking in all that moolah for saying cheese.

MADDIE

Not as easy as it looks... believe me. The most grueling thing I can imagine is putting in a long day in front of a camera...

(and then) No wonder Carla wants to get out of the agency business and open a restaurant.

DAVID

Yessiree... smiling and wearing clothes at the same time... a real death march.

MADDIE

Demanding clients... tempermental photographers ...hot lights.

DAVID

And a great big check waiting for you at the end of the day.

MADDIE

Which you earn by giving up a lot.

DAVID

Like?

MADDIE

Privacy, for instance. David... you have no idea what it's like to walk into a supermarket and see your face everywhere.

DAVID Used to happen to me all the time back in the 60's.

MADDIE Goodbye, anonymity.

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CONTINUED: (4)

DAVID

Hello, swimming pools, mansions, and sports cars.

MADDIE

People forget you're a human being. You're just an image... a logo... they talk about you... to your face... in the third person.

DAVID That like a threesome?

MADDIE They treat you like a piece of meat.

DAVID ... for five thou a day.

MADDIE I made a lot more than that.

DAVID And you walked away from it, so you could drive around... (and then, looking around at his watch) ...for four hours and nineteen minutes and forty-seven seconds... making squat?... Maddie... shoulda had a chat with your guidance counsellor.

MADDIE What's next?

DAVID Thirtysomething.

MADDIE On the list.

SHOCK CUT TO:

...taking us through a DOOR emblazoned with the LOGO for EMBASSY MODELS...

SHOCK CUT TO:

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A PERFECT PAIR OF LIPS		37

(CONTINUED)

MADDIE We have an appointment.

WOMAN

28.

With?

MADDIE

With Mr....

...searching... and then Maddie looks to David, who is absorbed in a YOUNG LOVELY... and Maddie plants an elbow in his side... and David TURNS... and then...

> DAVID Eddie Skins here... (extends his hand) Eddie Skins Personal Management. Benny Largo phoned this morning, told me you were interested in using my client... May I present?... (making an introduction) ...Madolyn Hayes.

WOMAN (she looks at Maddie; and then recognition sets in) Maddie Hayes... didn't realize you were trying to make a comeback.

... to which Maddie can only offer a tight-lipped...

MADDIE

Yes...

...and then...

WOMAN I'm sorry... Who did you say referred you?

DAVID Benny Largo...

WOMAN Name doesn't ring a bell... (and then) Are you sure it was Embassy that was interested?

(CONTINUED)

CONTINUED: (2)

...and suddenly they are interrupted as an ANGRY MAN cuts in...

MAN

...Where'd you dig up this meat puppet?... Nobody looks like this. Do you know anybody who looks like this? I've never even seen anybody who looks like this.

...and Maddie and David turn to see ...

A MALE MODEL

...standing next to the angry man... dressed in beachwear... perfect face... perfect body... perfect smile... which remains firmly in place throughout...

> MAN The hair... the teeth... save me from these teeth... (emphatically) ...wrong...

... and the woman recoils... and then he blusters on...

MAN

I'm trying to sell a product to men... out there... in America... This isn't a man... This is a statue... Why don't we find ourselves someone real?... not too bright... bicycle tire around the waist, maybe... I want ordinary, I want run-of-the-mill... I want...

... and then, his gaze falls on David ... and then ...

MAN ...this guy... I want this meat puppet.

CUT TO:

DAVID M

... on a BEACH SET... now wearing the BEACHWEAR seen earlier on the Male Model... only it kind of hangs off David...

(CONTINUED)

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and he's just STANDING ABSOLUTELY STILL while four bikini-clad MODELS go through their POSING MOTIONS all around him... as the photographer arranges David who is constantly hectored by the angry man... as...

MADDIE

...watches off on the sidelines, obviously enjoying David's ordeal...

...KNEELING in the SAND... next to David... who's BURIED in a MOUND OF SAND... feet and head exposed with a SAND CASTLE rising out of his mid-section... and then, the CASTLE COLLAPSES and David takes a LOAD OF SAND in the face... looking really uncomfortable... and we...

CUT TO:

ALL THE GIRLS IN A LINE

...HOLDING DAVID across them... like a surfboard... and the PHOTOGRAPHER SNAPS AWAY... then TURNS AWAY to wait for the next setup... and the GIRLS all simultaneously DROP David on the ground...

ON DAVID

...as the MUSIC CUTS OUT... looking up at the girls... in pain...

DAVID Any of you girls ever run across a guy named Benny Largo?

CUT TO: '

MADDIE

...sitting in a DIRECTOR'S CHAIR just off the set... and then...

A VOICE (O.C.) Miss Hayes...

...and Maddie looks over and sees...

MODEL

57

...one of the GIRLS from the shoot... up close we see how young she is... maybe seventeen, tops... a real China doll... and she very meekly approaches Maddie...

GIRL

Excuse me... could I have your autograph?... I mean, if it's not too weird or anything.

MADDIE Not at all... I'm flattered.

... where we see two guys talking in a booth ...

CUT TO:

INT. DINER - SOMEWHERE IN PHILADELPHIA - NIGHT (4 AM-ISH) 152

...it's <u>1973</u>, Richie and David sit across from each other in a cracked, red plastic BOOTH. David's back is to the entrance. Some cold french fries and ketchup lie on a plate between them... it's obvious they've been there for hours... Richie has LONG SIDEBURNS and COLLAR LENGTH HAIR. He wears a slick POLYESTER JACKET with his SHIRT COLLAR over his LAPELS. David has a MOUSTACHE and LONG HAIR, too, but he wears a tie-dyed T-SHIRT and an old ARMY JACKET...

> DAVID Check out the rack. Full house.

RICHIE You're wasting your breath, Dave, I'm joining a monastery.

DAVID

Here she comes! Here she comes! Look cool.

...David adopts an extremely CASUAL POSE as a stunning, MEDITERRANEAN BEAUTY of about 18 SAUNTERS by the table. She gives them both the eye... but doesn't stop. After she's gone...

> DAVID See? There <u>is</u> life after Muriel.

> > RICHIE

Maybe, but not on this planet.

DAVID

Rich, c'mon. A good lookin' guy like you? Soon as word gets out that you're available, the babes'll be on you like flies on--

(catching himself) --on... stuff they really like.

RICHIE

Dave, it's not working. She said I had the personality of a car wreck.

DAVID

How long'd you know her... two weeks?

RICHIE

Three... But enough blubbering, we're supposed to be celebrating.

... Richie hoists the dregs of his milkshake in a toast...

DAVID

You could come with me, you know. Plenty of beach bunnies dyin' to show off their tan lines.

RICHIE

Naw, I'm an East Coast kind of guy. Besides you can't get a decent cheesesteak out there.

DAVID You'll have to send me some.

RICHIE

85.

You got it. And anything else you want. Just pick up the phone and--(he makes a dialing motion)

DAVID

(chuckles) My brother the millionaire.

RICHIE I'm telling you, Dave, this time, <u>this time</u> it's gonna happen. Eight track tapes are going to be around <u>forever</u>.

... David gives a little skeptical SNORT ...

RICHIE

> RICHIE (nodding; about the approaching girl)

Better.

... the GIRL'S FOOTSTEPS STOP right beside David. WE CAN'T SEE her face, but Richie looks up at her in awe...

MADDIE'S VOICE (0.S.) David?

SMASH CUT TO:

DAVID
