TEASER

FADE IN:

1 EXT. SPACE - VOYAGER (OPTICAL)

1

at warp.

2 INT. SICKBAY

2

An unhappy SEVEN OF NINE sits on the clamshell as THE DOCTOR scans her face with a MEDICAL TRICORDER. On her cheek is a nasty-looking RASH.

SEVEN OF NINE

This is your fault.

DOCTOR

You can't blame me for an allergic reaction...

Seven disagrees:

SEVEN OF NINE

You encouraged me to "indulge my appetites."

DOCTOR

There's a difference between indulgence and gluttony.

SEVEN OF NINE

(defensive)

I enjoy the taste of strawberries --

DOCTOR

That doesn't mean you should eat them at <u>every</u> meal. It's no wonder you've developed an allergy.

A beat as he checks a few readings.

DOCTOR

If anything, you should be thanking me.

Seven looks up at him, incredulous.

DOCTOR

If it weren't for me, you'd still be drinking "nutritional supplement thirteen alpha." VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 TEASER 2.

2 CONTINUED:

SEVEN OF NINE My nutritional supplements never caused rashes.

DOCTOR

True... but how did they <u>taste</u>?

When Seven doesn't answer, the Doctor smiles, pleased with himself. He picks up a DERMAL REGENERATOR, begins to run it over Seven's rash.

DOCTOR

As I said... you should be thanking me.

OFF Seven...

3 INT. BRIDGE (OPTICAL)

3

2

The Viewscreen shows a listing ALIEN VESSEL. It's obviously damaged, spewing smoke and vapors. JANEWAY addresses the com as CHAKOTAY, TUVOK, PARIS, and KIM work stations.

JANEWAY

This is Captain Kathryn Janeway of the Starship Voyager. We're responding to your distress call.

A beat, and then a staticky reply...

YEDIQ'S VOICE

...ruptured conduit... flooding my ship with plasma radiation... request immediate transport...

The voice is obscured by STATIC. Kim checks a reading.

KIM

I'm detecting eleven lifesigns. Two are weak.

JANEWAY

Transport the injured to Sickbay and the rest to Cargo Bay One. (to Tuvok)

I want security teams at both locations.

Tuvok nods his understanding and EXITS to the Turbolift.

4 INT. CARGO BAY

4

Tuvok and TWO SECURITY N.D.s ENTER armed with PHASERS. They take position by the door as...

5 NINE ALIEN FORMS (OPTICAL)

Ξ,

begin to MATERIALIZE at the center of the room. The aliens are in a "formation" of sorts: three UNIFORMED men (all members of the Nygean race) are flanking the other six (a mixture of Nygeans and members of a race we'll come to know as Benkarans). All nine have sustained minor PLASMA BURNS on their faces and arms. The uniformed aliens' arms are positioned as though they were holding phasers on the other men just prior to transport. As they realize their hands are now empty, one of the uniformed aliens — a man we'll come to know as YEDIQ — addresses Tuvok authoritatively.

YEDIO

Our weapons?

TUVOK

They'll be returned to you when you leave.

Unhappy, Yediq indicates the six prisoners.

YEDIO

These are dangerous criminals. They have to be secured.

TUVOK

We'll do our best to accomodate you --

But Yediq is looking around, concerned. He cuts Tuvok off:

YEDIQ

I had <u>eight</u> men in custody -- where are the other two?

OFF the question...

6 OMITTED

6

7 INT. SICKBAY

7

where a massive, wild-eyed Nygean prisoner named IKO has his arm locked firmly around Seven's neck. The PLASMA BURNS marking his face and arms are quite serious, as are the burns on the unconscious N.D. PRISONER at his feet. (NOTE: Seven's rash is no longer visible.)

Iko presses a SHARP SURGICAL INSTRUMENT against Seven's chin, holding a horrified Doctor and TWO VOYAGER SECURITY N.D.s at bay.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 TEASER 3A.

7 7 CONTINUED:

IKO Stay away, or I'll kill her.

OFF the ferocious looking alien...

FADE OUT.

END OF TEASER

ACT ONE

FADE IN:

(NOTE: Episode credits fall over opening scenes.)

INT. SICKBAY 8

A moment later. Iko and the two N.D.s remain in a tense standoff. The Doctor, who is positioned between them, tries his best to mediate, addressing everyone:

DOCTOR

I'm sure we can resolve this without resorting to violence. (to Iko)

What is it you want?

IKO

A ship... some food...

DOCTOR

(stalling)

I might be able to arrange that... but you'll have to release her first.

Iko only tightens his grip on Seven.

IKO

I'm not a fool.

Before the Doctor can answer, Tuvok and an unarmed Yediq ENTER from the corridor. Iko pushes the surgical instrument harder against Seven's skin, looks to Yediq, threatening.

You know I'll do it. Tell them.

YEDIQ

You're not getting off this ship.

TUVOK

If you release her... I promise you won't be harmed.

IKO

Not until I get a ship.

YEDIO

(firm, to Tuvok)

We don't negotiate with criminals.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 5.

8 CONTINUED:

8

Annoyed by Yediq's interference, the Doctor turns on him:

DOCTOR

Who are you?

YEDIO

Warden Yediq of the Nygean Detention Force.

(re: Iko)

This man is my prisoner.

DOCTOR

If that were true, he wouldn't be holding my friend hostage!

9 SEVEN OF NINE

9

realizes Iko has been distracted by the disagreement. She suddenly buries her elbow DEEP in his stomach and breaks free of his grasp!

10 IKO (OPTICAL)

10

recovers quickly, GRABBING a surprised Doctor to replace her, shouts to the advancing N.D.s.

IKO

Get back.

The Doctor struggles to explain to Iko the tactical error he's made...

DOCTOR

I'm a hologram -- I can't be
harmed --

But before he can finish, Tuvok simply raises his weapon and FIRES, shooting a blast THROUGH the Doctor's matrix to stun Iko. The EMH FRITZES as Iko crumples to the floor. The Doctor shoots Tuvok a wry look.

DOCTOR

I think you proved my point.

OFF the moment...

11 INT. READY ROOM

11

Mid-scene as Yediq addresses Janeway, Chakotay, and Tuvok.

6.

YEDIQ

We're lucky you came along, Captain. Ten more minutes, and none of us would've survived the plasma leak.

JANEWAY

Your vessel was equipped with escape pods. Why didn't you use them?

YEDIQ

I couldn't risk letting any of the prisoners get away.

(beat)

As you've seen, they're extremely dangerous.

CHAKOTAY

Where are you taking them?

YEDIO

Back to our homeworld.

(explaining)

They're due to be executed.

Janeway and her two officers exchange uncomfortable looks at this news.

CHAKOTAY

What were their crimes?

YEDIQ

All eight are murderers... three are multiple offenders.

A heavy beat as everyone absorbs this. Yediq appeals to the Captain:

YEDIQ

We're just thirteen light years from our system.

(beat)

I'd appreciate it if you'd take us there.

JANEWAY

Actually, we were headed in the opposite direction.

Yediq nods, understanding.

YEDIO

I can arrange for one of our ships to rendezvous with Voyager... but it'll take several days.

(beat)

My prisoners will have to be strictly monitored.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 6A.

11 CONTINUED: (2)

11

JANEWAY

Commander Tuvok will help you make arrangements.

Yediq nods his thanks and then EXITS with Tuvok. Chakotay seems a little troubled by the Captain's decision.

CHAKOTAY

Some of the crew may not be comfortable helping to deliver eight men to their deaths.

JANEWAY

I can't say I like it either. But we have a Prime Directive to follow.

A beat, and then Chakotay nods his understanding. OFF a troubled Janeway as he EXITS...

INT. SICKBAY (OPTICAL) 12

12

Iko and the second prisoner have been revived and treated for the plasma burns they sustained during the accident on Yediq's ship. They stand behind a forcefield in the surgical area, watched by TWO ARMED VOYAGER SECURITY N.D.s. In the foreground, the Doctor runs the dermal regenerator over Seven's neck, irritated by her reckless escape from Iko...

DOCTOR

Thirty more seconds, and I could've resolved the situation peacefully. Instead, you and "Tuvok the Kid" had to take matters into your own hands...

Suddenly, the Doctor's matrix begins to FRITZ.

SEVEN OF NINE

You're damaged.

The FRITZING Doctor looks himself up and down, annoyed.

DOCTOR

Commander Tuvok's "friendly fire" must've caused a feedback surge in my emitters.

SEVEN OF NINE

I'll help you repair it.

Just then, Janeway ENTERS, addresses Seven.

JANEWAY

How are you?

SEVEN OF NINE

Fine, Captain.

Before they can continue, they're interrupted by a voice from off-camera.

IKO (O.C.)

You.

All eyes turn to...

IKO (OPTICAL) 13

13

who is glaring at the Captain from behind the forcefield.

IKO

This is your ship?

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 8.

13 CONTINUED:

13

JANEWAY

Yes.

IKO

Then let me out.

JANEWAY

I'm afraid I can't do that.

A beat as Iko simmers, frustrated. He touches the forcefield, as though to test its strength. As it SHIMMERS, he issues a low threat:

IKC

If you don't, I'll kill you all..

The Captain has heard enough. She taps her combadge:

JANEWAY

Janeway to Tuvok... are the prisoners' "accommodations" ready?

TUVOK'S VOICE

Affirmative, Captain.

JANEWAY

Then by all means, initiate transport.

As we HEAR the familiar sound of a transport...

CUT TO:

14 INT. CARGO BAY - CLOSE ON IKO (OPTICAL)

14

as he REMATERIALIZES in a makeshift "cell." A beat as he gets his bearings...

YEDIQ (O.C.)

You're sure this will hold him?

Tko turns to find ...

YEDIQ AND TUVOK 15

15

standing just outside the cell.

TUVOK

The forcefields are impenetrable, as are the tritanium bulkheads.

Yediq considers this, impressed. As he and Tuvok step away from Iko's cell...

WIDE ANGLE 16

16

to reveal the entire Cargo Bay has been transformed into a high-tech "lockup." BULKHEADS have been positioned perpendicular to the Cargo Bay walls, dividing the space into a series of cells. There are four cells to the right of the Cargo Bay, and four to the left. At the center is a "prisoners' row" -- a wide corridor to be patrolled by security. (NOTE: This is the Cargo Bay that does not contain the Borg alcoves.) As Tuvok and Yedig walk down the row...

TUVOK

In addition to your staff, two Voyager security officers will remain here at all times. Two more will be posted at the entrance to the Cargo Bay.

YEDIO

What about weapons?

TUVOK

You'll be allowed to carry them in this area only.

(beat)

If you leave the Cargo Bay, you'll be asked to surrender them.

As they arrive at the front of the Cargo Bay, NEELIX ENTERS from the corridor, pushing a CART that supports TWO LARGE POTS, and a stack of BOWLS.

What's this?

NEELIX

Dinner.

(cheerful) Since you can't bring the prisoners to the Mess Hall, I brought the Mess Hall to them. VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 10.

16 CONTINUED:

16

Yediq lifts the lid of the pot to inspect its contents.

YEDIQ

What is it?

NEELIX

Talaxian Spice-Stew...
(re: the other pot)
...served over leola rice pilaf.
It's an old family recipe --

YEDIO

Take it back.

Confused, Neelix lifts the lid to sniff the stew himself.

NEELIX

Too spicy?

YEDIQ

These men don't deserve such an elaborate meal.
(beat)
Take it back.

A beat as Neelix looks to Tuvok, then back to Yediq.

NEELIX

Federation guidelines are quite clear about the treatment of prisoners.

TUVOK

He's correct.

NEELIX

I can quote the protocols if you'd like --

Yediq cuts Neelix off, realizing there's no point in arguing.

YEDIQ

My men will assist you.

Neelix nods his thanks, pushes his cart to the first cell.

16A NEW ANGLE (OPTICAL)

16A

A Nygean guard moves to Neelix' side and works a panel on the bulkhead. The forcefield SHIMMERS as a small "slot" opens at its center. Neelix fills a bowl with STEW and hands it THROUGH the slot to the prisoner inside, a man named JOLEG. Joleg regards him warmly as the forcefield SHIMMERS a second time, causing the slot to CLOSE.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 11.

16A CONTINUED:

16A

JOLEG

Thanks for standing up to Yediq.

Neelix shrugs, a little uncomfortable to be talking to a killer.

NEELIX

Just doing my job.

JOLEG

Still, it was kind.

OFF Joleg as Neelix moves on to the next cell...

17 INT. MEDLAB (OPTICAL)

17

While Seven works a console, the Doctor paces.

SEVEN OF NINE

This would be easier if you would remain stationary.

The Doctor stops, faces her. Seven taps a few keys and he ZIMMERS momentarily. A beat, and then:

DOCTOR

It doesn't feel right.

SEVEN OF NINE

You may experience unusual sensations as your matrix realigns --

DOCTOR

I was referring to the "arrangement" the Captain's made with the Nygeans.

(beat)

No matter how terrible the crimes these men committed... it seems wrong to hand them over to be executed. This is a Federation Starship... not "The Barge of the Dead."

SEVEN OF NINE

Would you have preferred the Captain release them?

DOCTOR

Of course not. They're dangerous men.

SEVEN OF NINE

Executing them ensures that they'll never pose a danger again.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 12.

17 CONTINUED:

17

DOCTOR

So would life-sentences...

(wry)
.. the operative word being

SEVEN OF NINE Confining them for "life" requires significant resources. The Nygeans may not think it worthwhile.

The Doctor is determined to prove his point.

DOCTOR

What about rehabilitation? (beat)

Given the chance, some of these men might become productive members of society one day --

SEVEN OF NINE Their victims won't have the same opportunity.

Seven's casualness aggravates the Doctor even further.

DOCTOR

And that justifies taking their lives? "An eye for an eye?" (beat)

It's not justice, it's revenge.
 (beat)

Quite frankly, I'm surprised you're not troubled by such a barbaric system.

SEVEN OF NINE

I'm merely being objective.

(beat)

You often encourage me to see "both sides" of an argument.

The Doctor's chastened ... but only slightly.

DOCTOR

Well... this is one occasion when my programming won't allow me to be objective.

(beat)

Killing is wrong -- no matter
who's doing it.

OFF Seven as the Doctor steps away...

TIME CUT TO:

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 13.

18 INT. CARGO BAY - IKO'S CELL

18

Iko sits on the floor, eating messily from a BOWL OF FOOD. When he's through he drops the bowl to the floor.

JOLEG (O.C.)

Still hungry?

Iko looks up to see...

19 JOLEG (OPTICAL)

19

in an opposite cell.

JOLEG

I can hear your stomach from here.

Iko glares at Joleg, but Joleg is unfazed:

JOLEG

This must be the first time in a month you couldn't steal poor Egrid's meal...

He indicates EGRID, a meek-looking prisoner in a nearby cell who's eating ravenously from his own BOWL. He addresses Egrid:

JOLEG

Good, isn't it?

As we hear a few LAUGHS from the prisoners, Iko stands, furious. He THROWS his bowl against his forcefield, causing it to FRITZ violently.

20 YEDIQ (OPTICAL)

20

approaches, accompanied by both of his men.

YEDIQ

Is there a problem?

Iko says nothing, continues to glare at Joleg.

JOLEG

Iko was just telling me he didn't get enough to eat.

YEDIQ

I see.

A beat, and then Yediq moves closer to Iko's cell, looks him square in the eye:

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 14.

20 CONTINUED:

20

YEDIO

Cause another disturbance... and I'll see to it you're not fed for the rest of the journey.

(beat)

Do you understand?

A beat as Iko matches Yediq's stare, and then gives an incongruous response:

TKO

"Boche and Ledara."

A beat as Yediq's expression turns dark.

YEDIO

What did you say?

IKO

Your children.

A beat. Yediq is deeply disturbed to hear Iko utter his children's names.

YEDIO

How do you know that?

The prisoner issues a veiled threat:

IKO

Are you sure they're safe?

A long beat, and then Yediq shakes his head at Iko, as if in pity.

YEDIO

Some people don't understand why we deal so harshly with men like you.

He steps closer to Iko's forcefield, speaking in a low voice:

YEDIO

It's because you never <u>learn</u>.

Yediq looks to his men, gives a silent command. One of the Nygeans deactivates the forcefield in front of Iko's cell, and it SHIMMERS from view.

21 THE SECOND NYGEAN

21

SMASHES Iko in the face with the butt of his rifle, and Iko crumples to the floor. As his fellow officer KICKS Iko, now (O.C.).

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT ONE 15.

21 CONTINUED:

21

VOYAGER SECURITY OFFICER (O.C.)

Stand down!

Yediq turns to see...

22 TWO VOYAGER SECURITY N.D.S

22

have come up behind them, training their PHASERS on the Nygeans. The Nygeans freeze, realizing they're in danger of being fired upon. Yediq is incredulous:

YEDIO

He needs to be disciplined --

VOYAGER SECURITY OFFICER

(firm)

Lower your weapons and step away.

One of the Nygeans takes one last "cheap shot," driving his rifle into Iko's (O.C.) body as he steps away. He and the other Nygean reluctantly exit Iko's cell to reveal...

23 IKO 23

lying on the floor of his cell, battered and unconscious. OFF his crumpled form...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO

FADE IN:

INT. READY ROOM 24

24

Mid-scene. Tuvok looks on as Janeway and Yediq engage in a heated discussion regarding the Nygeans' assault on Iko.

YEDIO

Our response was justified.

JANEWAY

How do you "justify" beating a defenseless man?

YEDIO

Violence is the only thing he understands.

JANEWAY

You seem to have a pretty good grasp of it yourself.

Yedig doesn't appreciate the Captain's tone.

YEDIQ

Don't presume to tell me how to handle my prisoners, Captain. You don't know Iko like I do.

(beat)

He killed a young father for no reason. Before that, he committed dozens of violent crimes. He's spent his entire life hurting people.

JANEWAY

That doesn't excuse what you did to him.

A beat as Janeway comes to a decision.

JANEWAY

Until your transport vessel gets here, you and your men won't be allowed in the Cargo Bay.

(to Tuvok)

You're in charge of the prisoners.

YEDIQ

They're my responsibility --

JANEWAY

Not as long as you're aboard my ship. I won't risk any more violence.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 17.

24 CONTINUED:

24

YEDIO

(anger rising)
The only risk will be to your crew. Commander Tuvok isn't qualified to guard prisoners this dangerous.

JANEWAY

(sharp)
Tuvok's been a Starfleet Security
Officer for the last sixty-seven
years -- I'd say he's "qualified."

A long beat as Yediq realizes the Captain's made up her mind.

YEDIO

I hope you're right.

He moves to the door and EXITS, followed by Tuvok. OFF Janeway...

25 INT. SICKBAY (VPB)

25

An unconscious Iko lies on the clamshell in the surgical area. The Doctor works over him with a MEDICAL TRICORDER, while an ARMED VOYAGER SECURITY N.D. stands by the door. The Doctor looks up as Seven ENTERS from outside, indicates Iko wryly...

DOCTOR

You remember Mister Iko.

SEVEN OF NINE

Vividly.

DOCTOR

The Nygeans decided to make an "example" of him.

A beat as Seven takes in Iko's grave condition.

SEVEN OF NINE

Did you call me here to make a point about Nygean "barbarity?"

DOCTOR

I called you here because I need your help to save his life.

Seven reacts. The Doctor gestures to a MONITOR that displays a GRAPHIC of Iko's BRAIN.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 18.

25 CONTINUED:

25

The Doctor taps a key, and the image ZOOMS IN to a dark, ominous-looking SPOT on his upper lobe. The Doctor gestures to it.

DOCTOR

He sustained a severe blow to the head which caused an edema in his parietal lobe -- it's blocking vital neurotransmitters.

(beat)
I'd like to program some of your
nanoprobes to bypass the edema.

A long beat as Seven considers. Finally:

SEVEN OF NINE

I'll comply...

DOCTOR

I sense a "but" coming.

A beat.

SEVEN OF NINE
It seems inefficient to save the
life of someone who's about to be
executed.

The Doctor straightens at this, a little disappointed in Seven.

DOCTOR

If the Nygeans insist on killing him, there isn't much I can do about it. But I won't let them do it on Voyager.

OFF his determination...

26 INT. CARGO BAY (OPTICAL)

26

where Neelix has parked his cart just outside Joleg's cell. An ARMED STARFLEET SECURITY N.D. works a panel on the bulkhead as Neelix scoops the contents of his POT into a BOWL. Joleg regards him warmly.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 19.

26 CONTINUED:

26

JOLEG

I didn't expect to see you back so

(explaining)

Ordinarily, we're lucky to get one meal a day.

The forcefield SHIMMERS as the "slot" appears, and Neelix passes the bowl through it.

NEELIX

That's terrible.

JOLEG

Yediq likes to keep us hungry.

As Neelix withdraws his hand, the slot SHIMMERS closed. A beat as Neelix observes Joleg, struck by his friendly demeanor. Joleg smiles, a little amused by Neelix' interest.

JOLEG

You're wondering why I'm here.

NEELIX

(embarrassed)

Excuse me?

JOLEG

You're wondering what I did... (sotto voce) ... to end up with men like them.

He indicates the other prisoners. An uncomfortable beat.

NEELIX

You killed someone.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 20.

26 CONTINUED: (2)

26

JOLEG

That's right.

A beat. Neelix can't help being curious.

NEELIX

Why?

JOLEG

(shrugs)

Because I'm Benkaran.

Neelix doesn't understand.

NEELIX

What does that have to do with it?

JOLEG

(sarcastic)

It's common knowledge that all Benkarans are criminals... so when I was found in the vicinity of a murder, I was immediately arrested.

A beat as Neelix catches Joleg's meaning.

NEELIX

Are you saying you didn't do it?

Joleg just smiles wryly...

JOLEG

I told you... I'm Benkaran. What I say doesn't matter.

OFF Neelix, clearly curious to hear more of Joleg's tale...

27 OMITTED 27

28 INT. SICKBAY (OPTICAL)

28

The Doctor applies a HYPOSPRAY to Iko, who lies unconscious on the clamshell. Seven looks on from just outside the surgical area. A beat as Iko gradually begins to stir. He takes in his new surroundings, disoriented.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 21.

28 CONTINUED:

28

DOCTOR

You suffered severe neurological trauma... but I believe we've repaired the damage.

IKO

(beat)

Thank you.

The Doctor reacts, a little surprised to hear any sort of gratitude from Iko.

DOCTOR

Don't thank me -- thank Seven of Nine. She donated the nanoprobes that saved your life.

Iko looks at Seven, gingerly touches a hand to his brow...

IKO

My head...

DOCTOR

The pain is normal. I'll prepare an analgesic.

He steps THROUGH a forcefield, causing it to SHIMMER momentarily. He steps past Seven, who begins to work at a console. A long beat as Iko studies her. He makes an observation:

IKO

You're not afraid of me.

Seven continues working.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 22.

28 CONTINUED: (2)

28

SEVEN OF NINE

There's no reason to fear someone in your condition.

Another beat as he watches her work.

IKO

You were <u>never</u> afraid of me... not even when I tried to kill you.

Seven looks up at this. Iko studies her face, manages a small smile.

IKO

It's nice to look into someone's eyes... and not see fear.

A beat, and then Seven EXITS, disquieted. OFF Iko, who watches her...

29 INT. MESS HALL

29

Neelix stirs a pot absentmindedly in the kitchen area, focusing most of his attention on a PADD.

PARIS (O.C.)

Do you have to be a criminal to get something to eat around here?

Neelix turns to find ...

30 PARIS AND TORRES

30

standing behind him at the counter.

NEELIX

Sorry. Dinner will be ready in fifteen minutes.

TORRES

You said that fifteen minutes ago.

A beat, and then Neelix poses a question:

NEELIX

Did you know the Nygeans govern a sector of space occupied by several different humanoid species?

30 CONTINUED:

30

PARIS

If we say "yes," will you feed us?

Neelix ignores Tom's joke, continuing:

NEELIX

One of those species is the Benkarans.

(beat)

They occupy just ten percent of Nygean space, but they take up nearly <u>eighty</u> percent of the space in Nygean prisons.

PARIS

(shrugs)

Maybe they commit more crimes.

NEELIX

Not according to Joleg.

The name obviously doesn't mean anything to them. Neelix explains:

NEELIX

One of the prisoners.

Torres is finally starting to catch on...

TORRES

You think he was given a harsher sentence because of his species?

Neelix responds by showing them a reading on his PADD...

NEELIX

According to this, Benkarans are ten times more likely to be executed for their crimes than Nygeans!

A beat as B'Elanna peruses the PADD...

TORRES

Where'd you get this?

NEELIX

I contacted the Nygean government and told them I was interested in a "cultural exchange." Among other things, they let me access data on their criminal justice system.

(beat)

It all supports what Joleg told me.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 24.

30 CONTINUED: (2)

30

Paris looks up from the PADD, studying Neelix' face for a moment...

PARIS

Neelix...

NEELIX

I know what you're thinking --

PARIS

That you're the softest touch in the Delta Quadrant?

He produces a second PADD...

NEELIX

These are the transcripts from Joleg's trial. He was convicted on circumstantial evidence --

PARIS

Let me guess: he was in the "wrong place at the wrong time."

NEELIX

Apparently.

Paris shakes his head at Neelix, sympathetic.

PARIS

When I was in the Federation Penal Colony, everyone had a story.

(beat)

I never put much stock in them. Neither should you.

NEELIX

How many of those people were sentenced to die?

A beat as Neelix lets his point sink in.

NEELIX

Joleg isn't claiming to be an upstanding citizen -- he admits that he's committed less serious crimes.

(beat)

But if there's any chance he's innocent of this crime...

Neelix can't bring himself to finish the thought. Tom and B'Elanna exchange looks, a little worried for their friend. Torres addresses him gently.

TORRES

You always want to help people, Neelix.

(MORE)

(CONTINUED)

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 24A.

30 CONTINUED: (3)

Commander (and)

30

TORRES (cont'd)
It's one of the things we all love

about you...
(beat)

...but someone in Joleg's position might take advantage of that.

NEELIX

You're probably right.

(beat)

I shouldn't get involved.

B'Elanna nods, puts the PADD on the counter. But as she and Tom move to sit, Neelix can't help himself. He picks up the PADD and starts to read it again...

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 25.

31 EXT. SPACE - VOYAGER (OPTICAL)

31

at impulse.

32 INT. SICKBAY

32

In the surgical area, the Doctor uses a MEDICAL TRICORDER to scan Iko, who is still on the clamshell. They're mid-conversation -- Iko is straining to wrap his mind around something:

IKO

I still don't understand... why weren't you hurt?

DOCTOR

Because my matrix is photonic.
(simpler)
I'm made of light.

32A SEVEN OF NINE

32A

ENTERS from the corridor, carrying a PADD. She moves past an ARMED SECURITY N.D., addresses the Doctor.

SEVEN OF NINE

You wanted to see me?

DOCTOR

I'll be with you in just a moment.

He turns back to complete his scan of Iko, who has a new question for him:

IKO

You don't feel pain?

DOCTOR

(light)

Well, I suppose my <u>pride</u> can be wounded on occasion.

A long beat as Iko mulls this. Finally...

IKO

I wish I was made of light.

The Doctor is touched. A beat as he finishes up.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 26.

32A CONTINUED:

32A

DOCTOR

Try to rest.

Iko nods at this.

32B THE DOCTOR (OPTICAL)

32B

steps out of the surgical area, causing a FORCEFIELD to SHIMMER. He approaches Seven, explains why he called her here.

DOCTOR

Iko responded so well to the first dose of nanoprobes, I thought a second might improve his condition further.

(beat)

It'll only take a moment to extract them.

A beat before Seven reluctantly rests her PADD on a console and follows the Doctor into...

32C INT. MEDIAB

32C

As the Doctor prepares a HYPOSPRAY, Seven considers the unexpectedly friendly exchange she just witnessed.

SEVEN OF NINE
You and Mister Iko seem to be getting along well.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 26A.

32C CONTINUED:

32C

DOCTOR

It's the strangest thing... when he first arrived, he was crude, abusive...

(beat)

Now he's a model patient. Grateful, considerate...

SEVEN OF NINE

He's obviously an unstable individual -- inconsistant behavior is hardly surprising.

DOCTOR

Still, if it weren't for the security detail, I'd forget he was a criminal.

Seven is still suspicious.

SEVEN OF NINE

It's possible he's trying to manipulate you.

Suddenly, we HEAR Iko's voice calling loudly from the other room...

IKO (O.C.)

Doctor ...

The Doctor quickly EXITS to...

32D INT. SICKBAY (OPTICAL)

32D

The EMH moves to the surgical area, followed by Seven. They arrive to find Iko sweating, breathing a bit raggedly.

DOCTOR

What's the matter?

IKO

My stomach.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 26B.

32D CONTINUED:

32D

The Doctor steps THROUGH the FORCEFIELD again, starts scanning Iko with his tricorder.

DOCTOR

I'm not detecting anything...

Iko struggles to communicate something:

IKO

I... I can't...

DOCTOR

(prompting)

What's wrong?

A beat before he makes a difficult admission:

IKC

I can't stop thinking about the man I killed.

SEVEN OF NINE

That's not surprising. You're experiencing guilt.

A long beat as Iko tries to wrap his mind around this.

IKO

Is that what it is?

(beat)

Is that why I'm feeling sick?

The Doctor considers.

DOCTOR

Nausea could be a symptom of guilt.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 26C.

32D 32D CONTINUED: (2)

IKO

(confused)

I've never felt quilty before.

Seven finds this difficult to believe.

SEVEN OF NINE

You've committed many crimes --

IKO

None of them made me feel like

A long beat as Iko struggles to accept the reality of his "condition," closing his eyes. When he opens them again, he speaks to Seven and the Doctor through tears:

Why did you do this to me?

SEVEN OF NINE

We're not responsible for your quilt --

IKO

It didn't happen until you put those... nanoprobes in me.

A beat as Seven and the Doctor react. Iko's tone turns accusatory:

IKO

You knew this would happen, didn't you? This is some kind of punishment.

A beat, and then Iko addresses the Doctor, angry:

IKO

Take the nanoprobes out!

The hologram is puzzled by the request:

DOCTOR

You could die --

IKO

Take them out!

Seven and the Doctor are momentarily silenced by Iko's outburst. A beat as Iko struggles to compose himself, nearly overcome with emotion ...

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT TWO 26D.

32D CONTINUED: (3) 32D

IKO
Please... I don't want to feel
this way anymore.

OFF his desperate appeal...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT TWO

ACT THREE

FADE IN:

A33 INT. MEDLAB (VPB)

A33

A moment later. The Doctor ENTERS from his office, deeply troubled. Seven is right behind him.

SEVEN OF NINE

You don't honestly believe we're responsible for his condition --

The Doctor moves to a console, starts working.

DOCTOR

We applied the Borg technology. It's possible there were some unforeseen side-effects.

SEVEN OF NINE

(dubious)

"Guilt," for example.

The Doctor ignores her comment and hits a control, calling up a three-dimensional GRAPHIC of IKO'S BRAIN on the monitor. It's the same graphic as earlier, but various neurological components are now FLASHING intermittently, as though new electrical reactions are occurring. The Doctor seems surprised by this.

DOCTOR

Look at this...

SEVEN OF NINE

What?

The Doctor indicates the "flashes" on the graphic.

DOCTOR

It's my most recent scan. The neurotransmitters have established new pathways throughout his cortex.

SEVEN OF NINE

Wasn't that your intention?

DOCTOR

No.

(intrigued)

I was simply trying to bypass the edema...

A beat as Seven considers the graphic.

SEVEN OF NINE Then how did this happen?

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 27A.

A33 CONTINUED:

A33

DOCTOR

I don't know. It's possible this is normal Nygean brain activity... but I have no basis for comparison.

Seven can't help but be a little intrigued now herself.

SEVEN OF NINE
You should ask Mister Yediq to
contact a Nygean medical official.
Maybe they could provide some
relevant information.

A beat as the Doctor realizes he's put a dent in Seven's skepticism. He nods, and then Seven turns to leave.

33 INT. SICKBAY

33

She ENTERS from the Doctor's office, moves to the console where she left her PADD. As she picks it up and heads for the door...

IKO (0.C.)

Seven of Nine...

Seven stops, looks back to the surgical area where Iko still lies in the clamshell.

IKO

Stay... talk to me.

SEVEN OF NINE

I'm extremely busy.

She starts to go, but he calls after her.

IKO

Please...

(beat)

I'm scared.

This stops her. She turns, looks at him. She's still somewhat dubious, but her curiosity has been piqued. She steps closer to the surgical area.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 28.

33 CONTINUED:

33

SEVEN OF NINE

What would you like to discuss?

A long beat. Iko can't seem to think of anything to say. Seven's impatient.

SEVEN OF NINE

I'm due in Astrometrics, so if
vou --

Iko seizes on this.

IKO

"Astrometrics." What's that?

SEVEN OF NINE

A laboratory... where we observe stellar phenomena.

IKO

Stars?

SEVEN OF NINE

Yes.

Iko seems pleased to hear this...

IKO

When I was a child, I'd lie under the stars for hours...

(beat)

I'd stare at them until I could see the <u>shapes</u>.

SEVEN OF NINE

"Shapes?"

IKO

Faces... and animals... made out of stars.

A beat as Seven processes this, realizing:

SEVEN OF NINE

You're referring to constellations.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 28A.

33 CONTINUED: (2)

33

IKO

I named them.

(remembering)
There was Paedos, "The Warrior"...
Gezid, "The Beast"...

(beat)

No matter how hard he tried, Paedos could never catch Gezid --

Seven can guess why:

SEVEN OF NINE

Because the distance between them always remained the same.

Iko nods, surprised:

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 29.

33 CONTINUED: (3)

33

IKO

You've seen them?

Obviously, Seven hasn't, but she's willing to play along.

SEVEN OF NINE

Possibly -- I've catalogued approximately six billion stars.

IKO

Then you must've seen Onella too -- "The Mother."

Seven pulls up a stool, intrigued in spite of herself.

SEVEN OF NINE

Describe her.

IKO

She was surrounded by sixteen smaller stars...

(smiles)

...her "daughters."

A beat as Iko rests his head back on the clamshell, nostalgic...

Iko

If I try... I think I can remember all their names...

OFF Seven, getting drawn in by this enigmatic man...

34 EXT. SPACE - VOYAGER (OPTICAL)

34

at impulse.

35 INT. CARGO BAY

35

CAMERA FOLLOWS one of the Voyager Security N.D.s as he slowly moves down the "prisoners row," patrolling the cells. Suddenly, we HEAR Joleg's voice:

JOLEG (O.C.)

Green. Grid Eleven-Six.

(beat, excited)

Kot-Kot!

As the N.D. continues OUT OF FRAME, we STAY ON...

30.

36 NEELIX 36

who sits on a CARGO CRATE at the edge of Joleg's cell, just beyond the forcefield. In front of him is his cart, but instead of food, it now supports a KADIS-KOT BOARD. Joleg has pulled his cot to the very edge of the forcefield to play.

NEELIX

That's <u>Kadis-</u>Kot. Congratulations.

As Neelix begins to clear the gameboard, he brings up something that's been on his mind.

NEELIX

I've been doing some research on the Nygean legal system. (beat)

You were right about Benkarans receiving harsher sentences. I saw the statistics.

JOLEG

"Statistics" won't save me.

Neelix shakes his head sadly. A beat as they sit together in silence, and then something occurs to Neelix:

NEELIX

I noticed that some people convicted of murder -- even terrible, premeditated murders -- weren't executed. Some weren't punished at all.

(beat)

But you were sentenced to death.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 31.

36 CONTINUED:

36

JOLEG

(shrugs)

That's what the family wants.

Neelix reacts, confused. Joleg tries to explain.

JOLEG

After you're convicted, the family of the "victim" sentences you.

NEELIX

Shouldn't you be sentenced by someone less partial? Like a judge?

Joleg smiles.

JOLEG

"Vekto Valek K'Vadim."

Neelix responds with a blank look. Joleg explains:

JOLEG

It's ancient Nygean. It means
"favor the victims."

Joleg nods to the Kadis-Kot board.

JOLEG

What if I stole your gameboard?

(beat)

What right would a "judge" have to assign a value to your loss? To him it's just a gameboard... but to you, it might be a priceless family possession.

A beat. Neelix is gradually coming to understand.

JOLEG

And what if I murdered your child...

NEELIX

(disturbed)

I think I get the point.

JOLEG

"Vekto Valek K'Vadim."

(beat)

(MORE)

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 32.

36 CONTINUED: (2)

36

JOLEG (cont'd)
It's the basis for the Nygean legal system.

NEELIX

What about the criminals who didn't serve a sentence at all?

JOLEG

Some people prefer "restitution" to "revenge." If a defendant is wealthy enough, he can negotiate a settlement with the victims' family.

NEELIX

That doesn't seem fair.

JOLEG

It's perfectly fair...

(wry)

...unless you're destitute.

A long beat as Neelix considers everything he's heard.

NEELIX

Maybe I could talk to the Captain about finding a way to compensate your victims --

JOLEG

I'm grateful... but that would imply I'm guilty.

(beat)

I wouldn't want that.

Neelix is impressed.

NEELIX

There must be something I can do...

A beat as Joleg considers this.

JOLEG

You could transmit a letter to my brother.

(explaining)

I'd like to let him know what's happened to me.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 33-35.

36 CONTINUED: (3)

36

Neelix smiles.

NEELIX

Let me get a PADD.

OFF a grateful Joleg...

37 OMITTED

37

38 INT. SICKBAY - CLOSE ON IKO

38

who still lies on the clamshell in the surgical area. A beat as he stares at the ceiling, a troubled look on his face. He turns when he HEARS a door OPEN (O.C.).

39 SEVEN OF NINE (OPTICAL)

39

approaches his forcefield, accompanied by the armed Voyager Security N.D. assigned to Sickbay. The N.D. works a panel, and Iko's forcefield SHIMMERS from view. Seven hands Iko her PADD.

SEVEN OF NINE

I thought you might find this interesting.

Iko inspects it as Seven takes a step back, allowing the N.D. to REACTIVATE the forcefield. Iko looks at the PADD.

IKO

What is it?

SEVEN OF NINE

An astrometric log.

(beat)

It contains data about various star formations.

Iko looks the PADD over, doesn't seem to know what to make of it. He taps a few buttons...

39A CLOSE ON THE PADD (OPTICAL)

39A

as DATA rapidly scrolls across it. Iko looks up to Seven, confused...

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 36.

39A CONTINUED:

39A

IKO

These are just words... and

numbers...

I'd rather look at the stars.

An awkward beat as Seven realizes the information she brought Iko is too advanced for him.

SEVEN OF NINE

I'll bring you a starchart after my next shift.

Another awkward beat, and then Iko breaks the silence.

IKO

What's that metal above your eye?

Seven raises a hand to the implant just above her eye.

SEVEN OF NINE

A cybernetic implant.

TKO

Where did you get it?

SEVEN OF NINE

It was installed by the Borg.

IKO

It must have hurt.

Seven's uncomfortable with this line of questioning.

SEVEN OF NINE

I don't recall.

Iko turns inward for a moment, becomes contemplative.

IKO

I hurt people...

Iko looks away. A long beat before he turns back to Seven.

IKO

I <u>deserve</u> to die.

This takes Seven completely by surprise. A beat as she struggles to formulate a response, and then...

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 37.

39A CONTINUED: (2)

39A

DOCTOR (O.C.)

Seven...

She turns to see ...

40 THE DOCTOR

40

is standing in the doorway of his office.

DOCTOR

I've found something.

CUT TO:

40A A MONITOR (VPB)

40A

displaying a three-dimensional GRAPHIC of an ALIEN BRAIN.

DOCTOR (O.C.)

This is a scan depicting a <u>healthy</u> Nygean brain...

We WIDEN TO REVEAL we're in...

41-42 OMITTED 41-42

42A INT. MEDLAB (VPB)

42A

where the Doctor and Seven are mid-scene with Janeway. The Doctor taps a key and the image ZOOMS IN to a small spider-like GLAND at the center of the brain. Dozens of NEURAL PATHWAYS extend from it like "roots," connecting to various other parts of the brain.

DOCTOR

This node is analogous to a human pineal gland -- in addition to controlling behavioral impulses, it regulates decision making.

(beat)

You might say it's the physiological equivalent of a "conscience."

Seven indicates the neural pathways.

SEVEN OF NINE

Normally, the node connects to the rest of the brain through a series of neural pathways.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 38.

42A CONTINUED:

42A

DOCTOR

Now look at the scan of Iko's node before we applied the nanoprobes...

The Doctor taps a few keys and the image changes to depict IKO'S NODE. It's noticeably SMALLER than the previous node; a bit atrophied. We'll notice immediately that there are no neural pathways sprouting from the node - it obviously doesn't connect to any other part of Iko's neurology.

DOCTOR

It's detatched.

A beat as the Captain considers the graphic...

JANEWAY

Did that happen when he was assaulted?

The Doctor shakes his head, "no."

DOCTOR

I believe it's a congenital <u>birth</u> defect.

SEVEN OF NINE

Without the node, Iko would've been prone to violence and sociopathic behavior all his life.

Janeway reacts.

DOCTOR

When I used Seven's nanoprobes to treat the injuries from the assault...

(re: graphic)

...it seems they inadvertently repaired the defect as well.

The Captain puts it in starker terms:

JANEWAY

You've... activated his conscience.

(beat)

That would explain why he's suddenly experiencing guilt...

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT THREE 39.

42A CONTINUED: (2)

42A

DOCTOR

There's more to it than that.

(beat)

I believe he's become capable of controlling his violent impulses.

JANEWAY "Capable," maybe... but how do you know he will?

DOCTOR

Even the thought of violence makes him ill now.

(beat)

In my opinion, he's no longer a threat to anyone.

SEVEN OF NINE

By some definitions, Captain... he's not the same man who committed that murder.

OFF this radical pronouncement...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT THREE

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR

40.

ACT_FOUR

FADE IN:

INT. BRIEFING ROOM 43

43

Mid-scene as Janeway, Tuvok, Seven of Nine, Yediq, and the Doctor confer regarding Iko's condition. Yedig looks up from a PADD, incredulous:

YEDIO

Are you suggesting we release him?

DOCTOR

Of course not. But at the very least, his case should be reexamined.

YEDIO

(wry)

Because he's "sorry."

SEVEN OF NINE

There's new medical evidence to be considered --

YEDIO

(re: PADD)

None of it changes the fact that he killed a man.

SEVEN OF NINE

He was suffering from a neurological defect -- he couldn't control his behavior.

The Doctor takes this argument even farther:

DOCTOR

If Iko had been diagnosed and treated, he never would've committed that crime.

(beat)

In a manner of speaking, he's a victim of his own biology.

YEDIQ

So Iko is the victim now.

JANEWAY

No one's denying that he committed a terrible crime. But as a result of the Doctor's treatments, he's undergone a fundamental change.

(beat)

Killing him won't accomplish anything.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 41.

43 CONTINUED:

43

YEDIO

That's not your decision to make.

SEVEN OF NINE

(sharp)

Nor is it yours.

A beat, and then Yediq turns back to Janeway.

YEDIQ

He's obviously deceiving you somehow --

Janeway cuts him off, tired of arguing.

JANEWAY

We could debate this all day... but the fact is, our personal opinions are irrelevant.

(beat)

All that matters is Nygean <u>law</u>.

TUVOK

(to the point)
Does Iko have a legal means of
appeal at his disposal?

A long beat, and then Iko gives a reluctant, "by the books" response.

YEDIQ

In accordance with the Nygean Penal Code... a capital defendant has the right to appeal his sentence to the family of his victims.

A beat as Janeway formulates a plan.

JANEWAY

I'd like you to help Commander Tuvok draft an appeal and submit it to the proper authorities.

Yediq isn't happy, but nods his compliance. He heads for the door, followed by Tuvok. As they EXIT, Seven nods her thanks to Janeway. OFF the moment...

TIME CUT TO:

44 INT. SICKBAY

44

Mid-scene. Seven has just informed Iko of her plan to appeal his case. His response takes her by surprise:

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 42.

44 CONTINUED:

44

IKO

Take back the appeal.

A long beat as Seven locks eyes with Iko.

SEVEN OF NINE
You'd rather die because you think
it'll relieve your pain.

IKO

(angry)

Death is what I deserve.

(beat)

You say I've changed...

He shows his hands to Seven.

IKO

...but I look at these hands every day... and I see them squeezing that man's throat... I hear the sounds he made...

He can't bring himself to finish the thought.

IKO

I'm disgusting...

A beat as Seven considers this.

SEVEN OF NINE

Do you think I'm disgusting?

Iko is a bit puzzled by the question...

IKO

You've been nothing but kind to me.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 43.

44 CONTINUED: (2)

44

SEVEN OF NINE

You asked me earlier if it "hurt" when my occipital implant was installed.

(beat)

I told you I didn't remember...

Iko nods, recalling. Seven continues haltingly. This is difficult for her.

SEVEN OF NINE

...but the truth is... it was one of the most painful experiences of my life.

IKO

(confused)
Why did you lie?

A beat before Seven explains, uncomfortable...

SEVEN OF NINE

It's difficult for me to talk about...

(beat)

...because I forced others to undergo the same procedure.

Iko is completely taken aback by this admission.

IKO

Why?

SEVEN OF NINE

I was compelled to do so by the Borg Collective.

(beat)

I wasn't in control of my actions... just as you weren't in control when you took a life.

A beat as she lets this sink in.

SEVEN OF NINE

My nanoprobes have given you control. You're a different person now.

(beat)

You don't deserve to be executed.

A long beat as Iko wrestles with this. Clearly, Seven's arguments still haven't convinced him his life is worth saving.

IKO

I want to go back to my cell.

SEVEN OF NINE

You're free to remain here.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 43A.

44 CONTINUED: (3)

44

IKO Am I still sick?

SEVEN OF NINE

IKO

Then I don't want special treatment.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 44.

CONTINUED: (4) 44

OFF Seven...

44

45 EXT. SPACE - VOYAGER (OPTICAL) 45 at impulse.

46 INT. CARGO BAY - ANGLE JOLEG'S CELL

where Joleg has just been handed a BOWL OF FOOD by Neelix. Neelix is once again accompanied by an armed Security N.D.

JOLEG

Still no word from my brother?

NEELIX

Not yet.

Joleg tries to cover his disappointment with a joke:

JOLEG

He never was good at corresponding.

NEELIX

(sympathetic)

I'll check the transmission logs as soon as I'm through here.

Joleg nods his appreciation, and Neelix steps away.

47 NEW ANGLE

as Neelix moves on to another cell, which contains Iko. Iko sits on his cot, deep in thought. The Security N.D. looks on as Neelix starts scooping FOOD into a BOWL.

NEELIX

I'm glad to see you're feeling better...

Iko doesn't respond. He's looking past Neelix, into an opposite cell. Neelix continues, unfazed:

NEELIX

You must be hungry.

Iko still doesn't respond. Curious, Neelix follows Iko's gaze to the cell containing Egrid, the prisoner that Iko once routinely abused. Egrid is watching Iko nervously from his cell.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 44A.

47 CONTINUED:

47

Neelix doesn't make much of this, turns back to Iko with his food.

NEELIX

Here you go.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 45.

47 CONTINUED: (2)

47

Neelix starts to work the controls to open the forcefield. But before he finishes, Iko comes to a decision... points to Egrid.

IKO Give it to him.

NEELIX

(confused)

He's already had his dinner --

IKO

Please.

NEELIX

(beat)

All right...

Iko watches as Neelix moves to the opposite side of the CARGO BAY...

48-49 OMITTED

48 - 49

50 NEW ANGLE (OPTICAL)

50

The Security N.D. works a panel, causing a SLOT to OPEN in Egrid's forcefield. Neelix hands him Iko's dinner. A beat, and then Egrid nods a strained "thank you" to Iko. OFF the other prisoners exchanging looks at Iko's curious good will...

51 INT. READY ROOM

51

SEVEN OF NINE

You wanted to see me?

JANEWAY

We just received a response from the Nygeans.

A beat before Janeway breaks the news to Seven:

JANEWAY

The family has refused to consider the appeal.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 46.

51 CONTINUED:

51

Seven reacts, stunned. A beat as she tries to figure out what went wrong.

SEVEN OF NINE

But the medical evidence --

JANEWAY

They won't look at it.

YEDIQ

(explaining)

The family found the request "insulting."

SEVEN OF NINE

Your government could <u>insist</u> that they review it --

Yedig shakes his head, "no."

YEDIQ

We have laws that protect victims from emotional distress.

A beat, and then Seven tries a desperate gambit:

SEVEN OF NINE

In that case, we should grant Iko asylum aboard Voyager.

Yedig reacts to this suggestion, angry...

YEDIO

You agreed to work within the confines of our legal system --

SEVEN OF NINE

Your system is <u>flawed</u>.

JANEWAY

(firm)

That's enough, Seven.

Janeway turns to Yediq.

JANEWAY

I assure you, we'll abide by the family's decision.

A beat, and then Yediq nods, satisfied.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 47.

51 CONTINUED: (2)

51

JANEWAY

Now... I need a moment alone with

Seven.

Yediq moves to the door and EXITS. Janeway looks to Seven.

JANEWAY

We did everything we could to help him.

SEVEN OF NINE

We have to do more.

A beat as the Captain studies Seven, not sure what to make of her determination.

JANEWAY

You barely know this man. Why are you so passionate about helping him?

SEVEN OF NINE I want to give him the same opportunity you gave me.

Janeway reacts, surprised. Seven continues.

SEVEN OF NINE
When you severed my link to the

Collective, you <u>changed</u> who I was. You made it possible for me to reclaim my humanity.

(beat)

(MORE)

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR 48.

51 CONTINUED: (3)

51

SEVEN OF NINE (cont'd) Because of my nanoprobes, Iko has

undergone a similar change.

(ardent)
He should be given a chance to

atone for his crimes.

A long beat as Janeway considers this, a little confused.

JANEWAY

"Atonement?" Is that what this is about?

SEVEN OF NINE

Yes.

Janeway makes an observation.

JANEWAY

For him or you?

This takes Seven aback.

SEVEN OF NINE

I don't know what you mean...

JANEWAY

I think part of you still feels responsible for the violent acts you committed when you were a Borg.

SEVEN OF NINE

You're mistaken.

JANEWAY

Am I?

(beat)

Maybe you believe that if Iko is found "not guilty..."

(beat)

...somehow <u>you</u> won't be guilty either.

Seven doesn't respond. We'll sense Janeway has her dead to rights.

JANEWAY

You said it yourself. You've reclaimed your humanity.

(beat)

It's time you stopped blaming yourself for the crimes of the Collective.

"Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FOUR VOYAGER: CONTINUED: (4) 51 51 A long, quiet moment as Seven eyes her. Suddenly, the ship JOLTS! As Voyager goes to RED ALERT, Janeway and Seven hurry out to ... INT. BRIDGE 52 52 at Red Alert. Chakotay, Paris, Kim, and Tuvok man their stations. As Seven and the Captain arrive, the ship JOLTS violently once more. JANEWAY Report. CHAKOTAY An alien vessel just dropped out of warp and opened fire. 53 EXT. SPACE - THE ALIEN SHIP (OPTICAL) 53 flies in low and close, STRAFING Voyager's hull with PHASER FIRE. 54 TNT. CARGO BAY 54 The room shakes VIOLENTLY, lights begin to FLICKER. One of the forcefield panels SPARKS! Most of the prisoners are on their feet in their cells, alarmed. The four Voyager Security N.D.s stand warily at the center of the room, struggling to maintain a back-to-back formation as the ship SHAKES. ANGLE - IKO'S CELL 55 55 as a massive JOLT nearly sends him to the floor. He regains his balance, and a CRACKLING sound draws his eyes to ... 56 HIS FORCEFIELD (OPTICAL) 56 which has begun to FRITZ on and off. 57 INT. BRIDGE 57 as the ship is ROCKED by more phaser-fire. A console SPARKS!

57 CONTINUED:

57

KIM (off console)

We've lost power on Decks Eight through Ten!

The Captain reacts:

JANEWAY

The Cargo Bays.

58 INT. CARGO BAY

58

The prisoners BURST from their cells and CHARGE the four Security N.D.s in the darkened Cargo Bay!

59 THE N.D.S (OPTICAL)

59

OPEN FIRE, STUNNING a few prisoners, but they're quickly locked in hand-to-hand combat by the remaining convicts. As Joleg delivers a particularly vicious blow to an N.D., wresting away his PHASER in the process...

60 IKO

60

observes the violence from the edge of his cell, frozen. OFF the sounds of the melee...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT FOUR

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 51.

ACT FIVE

FADE IN:

61 INT. BRIDGE

61

As before, except that Tuvok is gone and Chakotay has taken his place at the tactical station. The ship continues to SHAKE.

CHAKOTAY

Shields down to sixty percent!

KIM

Still no response to hails.

JANEWAY

Evasive maneuvers. (to Chakotay) Target their weapons.

As the Captain buckles down for a fight...

62 INT. CORRIDOR

62

One of the Benkaran prisoners is on the move, armed with a STARFLEET PHASER. He rounds a corner, moving into...

63 INT. NEW CORRIDOR (OPTICAL)

63

where he's quickly BLASTED by PHASER FIRE! As he drops to the floor, unconscious...

64 REVERSE ANGLE TO REVEAL

64

Tuvok lowering his PHASER. Behind him are Yediq, a VOYAGER SECURITY N.D., and one of the Nygean subordinates. (NOTE: The Nygeans have been armed with Starfleet PHASERS.) As Tuvok moves closer to retrieve the fallen Benkaran's weapon...

65 YEDIQ

65

turns to his officer, uses simple hand signals to convey silent orders. As the Nygeans separate, taking off down different corridors...

66 THE BENKARAN (OPTICAL)

66

begins to SHIMMER in an ALIEN TRANSPORTER EFFECT. Tuvok scans him with a TRICORDER, hits his combadge...

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 52. 66 66 CONTINUED: TUVOK Tuvok to the Bridge... INT. BRIDGE 67 67 As before. TUVOK'S COM VOICE The attacking ship is attempting to transport one of the prisoners --KIM (confirming this) They're trying to lock on to all five Benkaran lifesigns. The ship is ROCKED once more by phaser fire. console SPARKS! Janeway looks to Chakotay. JANEWAY Target their Transporter array! EXT. SPACE (OPTICAL) 68 68 as Voyager FIRES on the smaller ship. 69 INT. BRIDGE 69 as Chakotay looks up. CHAKOTAY Direct hit. They're retreating. PARIS Pursuit course? JANEWAY No. We have more immediate problems. (to com) Bridge to Tuvok, what's your status? CUT TO: 70 70 INT. CORRIDOR - LOW ANGLE

The SOUND of phaser fire as another PRISONER crumples to

the DECK.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 53.

71 TUVOK 71

reaches down to strip the prisoner of his PHASER, handing it to the Security N.D.. Tuvok hits his combadge...

TUVOK

We've neutralized two of the prisoners.

72 INT. BRIDGE 72

as an ALARM sounds at Harry's station...

KIM

Someone's trying to get into the Shuttlebay.

JANEWAY

Lock them out.

73 INT. CORRIDOR (OPTICAL) 73

Joleg looks on as a prisoner fires a blast from a PHASER RIFLE at the Shuttlebay door, causing SPARKS to fly!

74 ANGLE - THE DOOR 74

to reveal it's slightly CHARRED, but still standing.

JOLEG

Again.

75 THE ARMED PRISONER (OPTICAL) 75

raises his rifle, but before he can fire, he's HIT with a PHASER BLAST! As he SLUMPS to the ground, Joleg wheels to find...

76 YEDIQ 76

approaching him cautiously from the opposite end of the corridor, his phaser raised. He indicates the phaser in Joleg's hand.

YEDIQ Surrender your weapon.

Before Joleg can comply, a phaser is suddenly pressed to the back of Yedig's head. We WIDEN TO REVEAL it's an N.D. Prisoner behind him. Yedig freezes.

NEW ANGLE 77

77

as Tuvok and the Security N.D. round a corner, arriving on the scene. Joleg backs away from Tuvok, moving closer to Yediq and the Prisoner.

JOLEG

You have five minutes to get us a shuttle.

As he and the other Prisoner back away with Yediq, disappearing around a corner, Tuvok hits his combadge.

TUVOK

Tuvok to the Bridge... lock onto Yediq's signature and beam him

JANEWAY'S COM VOICE Transporters are off-line. We need at least ten minutes to get them up and running.

OFF Tuvok, knowing that's five minutes more than he has...

VOYAGER:

78

INT. CARGO BAY (OPTICAL)

78

as Joleg and the other Prisoner ENTER with Yediq in tow. Joleg angrily pushes Yediq to the ground, indicates the Cargo Bay door to the Prisoner.

JOLEG

Seal it.

The Prisoner aims his phaser at the door and begins to WELD it shut with a CONTINUOUS BEAM. Yediq looks up to Joleg, defiant...

YEDIO

You're not getting off this ship.

Angry, Joleg straightens his arm, preparing to fire...

JOLEG

Then I suppose I should kill you right now --

IKO (O.C.)

Don't.

Joleg wheels to find ...

79 IKO (OPTICAL)

79

who has finally emerged from his cell. A beat. We don't know what his motives are and neither does a suspicious Joleg. Finally, Iko nods, indicating Yediq:

IKO

He's mine.

Joleg is reluctant to comply. Obviously, he wants to Kill Yediq. Iko presses his case, reminding Joleg:

IKO

You saw how they beat me.

A beat as Joleg considers... and then he tosses his phaser to Iko. Iko moves closer, raising the phaser at Yediq's head. Yediq looks Iko in the eyes, fearless:

YEDIQ

I knew it was a trick. I knew you hadn't changed.

Joleg reacts, confused -- he obviously isn't aware of the transformation Iko has undergone.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 56.

79 CONTINUED:

79

JOLEG What's he talking about?

Iko doesn't answer. A long beat as he locks eyes with the warden... and then he hands the phaser to Yediq. Before Joleg can grasp what's happened, Yediq quickly lifts the phaser and BLASTS him and the other Prisoner backwards with two quick shots. He swings the phaser around to train it on Iko, who hasn't moved an inch. OFF Yediq, shocked by Iko's unexpected assistance...

80 EXT. SPACE - VOYAGER (OPTICAL)

80

at impulse.

JANEWAY'S VOICE Captain's Log, Stardate 54474.6. Warden Yediq has used his influence to convince the Nygean family to hear Iko's appeal for leniency.

81 INT. BRIDGE (OPTICAL)

81

ON THE VIEWSCREEN are the family of Iko's victim. Seated behind a TABLE, the family consists of the victims' ELDERLY PARENTS, his WIDOW, and his TEENAGE DAUGHTER.

IKO (O.C.)
I won't beg for my life.
 (beat)
It belongs to you.

82 REVERSE ANGLE TO REVEAL (OPTICAL)

82

Janeway, Chakotay, Tuvok, Yediq, Seven, and the Doctor looking on as Iko makes his halting, emotional appeal to the family.

IKO
I only wanted you... to
understand... what's happened to
me.

(MORE)

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 57.

82 CONTINUED:

82

IKO (cont'd)

I'm a different person now... a better person.

(beat)

This crew has helped me see that.

Iko pauses, looking to Seven. She offers a supportive nod.

IKO

If my death helps you find peace... I can accept it...

(beat)

But if you let me live... I'll never hurt anyone again...

(beat)

Whatever you decide... please know how sorry I am... for what I took from you.

OFF his heartfelt words...

83 INT. CARGO BAY - CLOSE ON JOLEG

83

as he accepts a BOWL of FOOD from someone (0.C.) we HEAR the sound of his forcefield slot closing.

JOLEG

Are we playing Kadis-Kot later?

We WIDEN TO INCLUDE ...

83A NEELIX 83A

is standing just outside the cell with his cart, a troubled look on his face.

NEELIX

Sorry.

JOLEG

(tweaking)

Afraid I'll beat you again?

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 58.

83A CONTINUED:

83A

A long beat...

NEELIX

I tried to help you, and you took advantage of me.

JOLEG

What do you mean?

NEELIX

The "note" we sent your brother. (beat)

He traced the transmission to Voyager. He's the one who attacked us.

JOLEG

(incredulous)

Neelix, I swear... I had no idea he would do that.

Neelix gives him a skeptical look.

JOLEG

You have to believe me.

Obviously, Neelix doesn't.

NEELIX

I read Yediq's security report. You threatened to kill him.

Joleg doesn't have a ready response. A long beat, and then he switches gears, looks at the bowl of food he's holding.

JOLEG

I can't eat this.

NEELIX

Why not?

JOLEG

I'm sick.

NEELIX

(skeptical)

You look fine to me.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 59.

83A CONTINUED: (2)

83A

JOLEG

No... I must have the same condition that Iko had.

(beat)

If your Doctor cures me, then I can make an appeal for my life too.

A beat as Neelix looks Joleg in the eye, a little sickened by the depths to which Joleg is willing to sink. Finally, he shakes his head in disgust and moves to the door. OFF Joleg...

CUT TO:

84 A STARFIELD (OPTICAL)

84

replete with twinkling STARS. A number of the stars STAND OUT, BRIGHTER than the others, forming a vaguely GEOMETRIC PATTERN.

IKO (O.C.)

She's beautiful, isn't she?

We REVEAL we're in...

85 INT. ASTROMETRICS LAB (OPTICAL)

85

Seven of Nine and Iko are standing near the main console, studying the starfield on the DOMESCREEN. Standing guard in the b.g. are TWO VOYAGER SECURITY N.D.s. A beat as Seven studies the astral configuration, trying to place its name. Finally:

SEVEN OF NINE "Onella, The Mother."

Iko nods, pleased. A beat, and then he points to a corner of the Dome, indicates another cluster of STARS...

IKO

And there's Paedos, still watching over her...

A long beat as Iko takes in the starfield, nostalgic.

IKO

It was kind of Captain Janeway to let you bring me here.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 60.

85 CONTINUED:

85

SEVEN OF NINE

If your appeal is successful,
you'll be able to go wherever you
want.

Iko manages a small smile at Seven's optimism... but he obviously doesn't share her positive outlook.

IKO

I hope you're right.

He looks back to the Dome. A beat as Seven considers him.

SEVEN OF NINE

If I am... where will you go?

A long beat.

IKO

I don't know.

Another beat.

SEVEN OF NINE

If you'd like... I can ask the Captain to consider letting you stay here.

IKO

I'm not a scientist.

(beat)

I don't think I'd be much help to anyone.

SEVEN OF NINE

There are other ways to be useful. I'm sure we can think of something.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 61.

85 CONTINUED: (2)

85

A long beat... and then Iko smiles, touched by Seven's offer.

IKO

I'd like that.

The warm moment is interrupted by the SOUND of the lab door OPENING...

86 NEW ANGLE

86

as Janeway, Yediq, and one Nygean N.D. ENTER from outside. The Captain doesn't say a word, but her grim expression tells Seven everything she needs to know.

JANEWAY

I'm sorry.

(to Iko, gentle)

The family has denied your appeal.

Yediq confirms this:

YEDIQ

We're due to rendezvous with a transport ship in a few hours.

(apologetic)

I need to return you to your cell.

A difficult moment. Overcome with emotion, Seven looks away. Iko doesn't want things to end this way.

IKO

You were the first person who wasn't afraid to look me in the eye.

(beat)

That's how I'd like to remember you.

VOYAGER: "Repentance" - 1/17/01 ACT FIVE 62.

86 CONTINUED:

86

A long beat. Seven takes a steadying breath, turns to face Iko. A beat as he looks at Seven's face for the last time. It's filled with emotion. Finally, Iko nods to Yediq. As he's led away by the Nygeans, OFF a devastated Seven...

87 EXT. SPACE - VOYAGER (OPTICAL)

87

at warp.

88 OMITTED

88

88A INT. ASTROMETRICS LAB

A88

A tired looking Seven works intently at a console. Janeway ENTERS from outside, holding a PADD. Seven turns. A beat as they eye each other.

JANEWAY

I just finished looking over your warp core analysis.

SEVEN OF NINE

And?

JANEWAY

(re: PADD)

B'Elanna tells me you did it in twenty-two hours.

Seven explains, a little uncomfortable:

SEVEN OF NINE

I haven't felt the need to regenerate.

Janeway nods, understanding.

JANEWAY

Everyone grieves in their own way.

A beat. Seven doesn't want to acknowledge that that's what she's been doing. She moves past Janeway, starts working at another console. A beat, and then the Captain moves to Seven's side, rests a comforting hand on her shoulder.

JANEWAY

If you want to talk... you know where to find me.

88A CONTINUED:

888

A beat, and then the Captain heads for the door. Seven finally speaks up:

SEVEN OF NINE

It's unfair.

The Captain stops, looks back at Seven, addresses her gently.

JANEWAY

I think so too. But we have to try not to judge their system --

SEVEN OF NINE

That's not what I meant.

A beat. Then Seven elaborates.

SEVEN OF NINE

Iko was executed for taking a single life.

(beat)

As a Drone, I took <u>thousands</u>... (beat)

...but I was never punished.

A long beat as Janeway considers this, realizing how much pain Seven is in. Finally...

JANEWAY

You lost twenty years of your life to the Borg.
(beat)

I'd say that's punishment enough.

A beat, and then the Captain EXITS. OFF Seven considering her mentor's words, perhaps a little closer to forgiving herself...

FADE OUT.
