61 FORTUNE

What's up? When is this over? I got practice.

BACK TO:

INT. FORTUNE AND GINGER'S LIVING ROOM - PRESENT DAY GINGER SITS DOWN AND COVERS HER FACE, EMOTIONAL.

62 GINGER

I can't believe you are --

63 FORTUNE

I know.

64 GINGER

-- ruining all the plans I had for
your wedding!

65 FORTUNE

(THROWN) What?

66 GINGER

I was going to look amazing! Everyone was going to mistake us for sisters.

The best man was going to try to kiss me in the cloak room!

67 FORTUNE

What are you talking about?! And I can still get married some day.

68 GINGER

But can I wear the gorgeous blue dress I bought? Do lesbians even like blue?

69 FORTUNE

I don't know! I've been one for fifteen minutes! Stop making this about you!

GINGER CROSSES OVER TO HER AND GIVES HER A HUG.

70 GINGER

You're right, darling. Listen, I love you. I just need to get my head around all this. (THEN, REALIZING) What about your daddy?

71 FORTUNE

Oh God. Dad. That's gonna be hard.

72 GINGER

Well, your father's not as sophisticated as I am. (EXTREMELY PROUD) I had sushi once in Atlanta.

73 FORTUNE

Dad is real small-minded. He won't watch basketball because he doesn't think men should wear shorts. (THEN) Maybe I just shouldn't tell him.

74 GINGER

Fortune, honey, keeping a secret will eat you up inside. Which I highly recommend. How do you think I'm so thin?

GINGER EXITS, LEAVING FORTUNE LOST IN THOUGHT.

INT. SCHOOL HALLWAY - NEXT MORNING (DAY 2)
(FORTUNE, MIKE, EXTRAS)

FORTUNE ENTERS AND SEES $\underline{\text{MIKE}}$, WHO'S STARING AT SOME KIDS' ART PROJECTS ON THE WALL. SHE STEELS HERSELF, HEADS TOWARDS HIM.

75 FORTUNE

(NERVOUSLY) Hey, Dad.

76 MIKE

(DERISION) "Art." For communists and serial killers. Look at this one.

Two mouths. If I were you I would stay away from "Missy S."

77 FORTUNE

Dad, you've got to start being more open-minded.

78 MIKE

Like a European? No, thank you.

Never cared much for kilometers.

(THEN) How was your party last night?

79 FORTUNE

Fine. Fun. Eventful. Not eventful! Why would I say that? Because here's why: everything's technically an event, so of course that makes sense! Ha ha. Ho ho. Hrmgh...

FORTUNE SCURRIES OFF INTO THE...

RESET TO:

17. II/D

INT. TEACHERS' LOUNGE - CONTINUOUS
(FORTUNE, STEVEN, MAUREEN, JOE, EXTRAS)

FORTUNE ENTERS LOOKING WORRIED. SHE SEES STEVEN AND MAUREEN.

80 FORTUNE

What about you, Maureen?

83 MAUREEN

We're not on the clock yet. I don't have to talk to you.

FORTUNE REACTS, FRUSTRATED. $\underline{\text{JOE ENTERS}}$. HE SEES FORTUNE AND PULLS UP, NERVOUS.

84 FORTUNE

Well, well. If it isn't Osama bin Satan-Cosby himself.

85 JOE

Now Fortune, don't overreact about the trip. We're a public school. We don't have any money. Look at the laptop they gave me!

JOE PULLS OUT AN ENORMOUS, OLD, BOX-LIKE PORTABLE COMPUTER.

86 FORTUNE

sexual experience! (DISAPPOINTED)
Tyler, that was the best part!

94 TYLER

I'm sorry. (TO FORTUNE) Man, I wish
I had a teleporter...

95 FORTUNE

You mean teleprompter?

96 TYLER

Yeah, a teleprompter... so I could go back in time and do that over again.

NICHOLE SIGHS AND RUBS HIS BACK.

97 TYLER (CONT'D)

What I'm trying to say is, you're my sister. And I will always be here for you.

98 FORTUNE

(TOUCHED) Little bro. That means so much to me. Come here.

FORTUNE OPENS HER ARMS UP FOR A HUG. TYLER COMES OVER... BUT THEN FORTUNE PUTS HIM INTO A VICIOUS HEADLOCK! HE SHRIEKS.

99 FORTUNE (CONT'D)

You think I care what you think? I

OWN YOU! You little turd!

THEY STRUGGLE. NICHOLE TRIES TO BREAK THEM UP.

100 NICHOLE

Alright, that's enough!

101 FORTUNE

I'm sorry. You're so headlockable!

TYLER CROSSES BACK TO THE COUCH, COMPOSING HIMSELF.

102 FORTUNE (CONT'D)

Listen, I tried to tell Dad, but I chickened out. I kept thinking about Gordon.

103 TYLER

Yeah. Gordon.

104 NICHOLE

What's your dad's dog have to do with this?

105 TYLER

Gordon was Dad's best friend, until he peed on his truck five years ago. Dad hasn't spoken to him since.

106 NICHOLE

Is that why he's so sad? I thought he was just upset about being in this family. Which I get.

107 FORTUNE

God. I don't want to get Gordon-ed.

I love Dad. He's my rock.

108 NICHOLE

You two are being silly. Fortune, Mike's not going to abandon you.

109 TYLER

I don't know, Nichole. I grew my hair long once, he moved into the forest until I cut it. (FRUSTRATED) And that was a really fun and funky look for me!

FORTUNE GETS UP AND STARTS PACING. SHE'S SPIRALLING.

110 FORTUNE

What do I do? I don't want to lose

Dad, but I would really really like to

hug a girl and roll down a hill

111 NICHOLE

(CONFUSED) Is that what lesbians...?

112 FORTUNE

I don't know! I hope so! (THEN,

FORTUNE IS THERE, WIPING OFF THE WHITEBOARD. STEVEN ENTERS.

115 STEVEN

Hey hey hey! It's stinkety-stinkety
Steven! (THEN, EXPLAINING) The kids
started calling me that. I'm trying
to embrace it. It's not working.

116 FORTUNE

You know what is working? My new pumps and pocketbook.

REVEAL: FORTUNE IS WEARING WHITE HIGH HEELS. SHE GRABS A POCKETBOOK AND CROSSES TO STEVEN, BARELY ABLE TO WALK.

117 STEVEN

What are you doing?

118 FORTUNE

Steven, take a seat.

STEVEN SITS BEHIND FORTUNE'S DESK. FORTUNE TAKES A DEEP BREATH, THEN LIES SEXILY ON THE DESK.

119 FORTUNE (CONT'D)

You're a sweet guy. Has anyone ever told you you have Brad Pitt's forehead?

120 STEVEN

That reminds me. Joe thinks you're going crazy --

121 FORTUNE

(FINGER ON HIS LIPS) Sssssshhhhhhh.

There's always been an energy between

us.

122 STEVEN

No there hasn't!

FORTUNE PULLS A CHIP OUT OF A BAG AND STARTS TO RUB IT AROUND STEVEN'S MOUTH. SHE TEASES HIM WITH IT.

123 FORTUNE

Mmm. You want it? Come and get it.

SHE LOUDLY EATS THE CHIP AND COMES TOWARDS HIM LIKE PAC-MAN.

124 STEVEN

(JUMPING UP) Fortune, stop! You're

gay!

125 FORTUNE

Pfft. What? Why would you say that?

OFF STEVEN'S LOOK:

FLASHBACK TO:

SCENE HH

INT. SCHOOL HALLWAY - SIX MONTHS AGO (FLASHBACK)
(FORTUNE, STEVEN, EXTRAS)

FORTUNE PACES ANGRILY. STEVEN TRIES TO TALK HER DOWN.

126 FORTUNE

Unbelievable!

127 STEVEN

Why are you so upset that Marissa has a boyfriend?

3rd Rev Shooting Draft YELLOW

ANGLE ON: MARISSA, A PRETTY TEACHER, LAUGHING WITH HER BOYFRIEND.

128 FORTUNE

(FURIOUS) Because she's my best

friend!

SHE PUSHES STEVEN INTO THE LOCKERS AND STOMPS OFF.

BACK TO:

INT. CLASSROOM - PRESENT DAY

FORTUNE AND STEVEN, AS THEY WERE.

129 FORTUNE

Yep. That was pretty gay. Sorry I hit on you. I was trying to be something I'm not.

130 STEVEN

Been there. I did this whole thing where I was trying not to wear undershirts for a while.

131 FORTUNE

(SIGHING) Okay. I've got no choice.

I've got to go talk to my dad.

FORTUNE FLINGS HER POCKETBOOK OVER HER SHOULDER AND STARTS OUT, TODDLING.

132 STEVEN

Girl, put more weight on your toes!

CUT TO:

SCENE J

INT. FORTUNE AND GINGER'S LIVING ROOM - LATER (DAY 3)
(FORTUNE, GINGER, MIKE, TYLER, NICHOLE)

FORTUNE ENTERS AND PULLS UP. THE LIVING ROOM IS COMPLETELY REDECORATED: SCULPTURES OF NUDE WOMEN ARE ON EVERY SURFACE. ENYA PLAYS. TYLER AND NICHOLE ARE HANGING UP THE LAST OF A COUPLE RAINBOW FLAGS. IT'S LESBIAN HEAVEN.

133 FORTUNE

What in the --

GINGER ENTERS FROM THE KITCHEN.

134 GINGER

There's my beautiful homosexual!

135 FORTUNE

What is happening here?

136 GINGER

I've been researching gay life online! What a vibrant culture. So many colors, and dancing, and oh the pornography! Welcome to your coming out party!

137 NICHOLE

Ginger wanted me to dance like Ellen for you, but I'm not going to do it.

138 GINGER

(FIRM) Nichole.

NICHOLE SADLY STARTS TO DANCE LIKE ELLEN.

139 FORTUNE

I appreciate the support, but this is a little much.

140 GINGER

Oh come on. You ruined your debutante coming-out, I deserve this!

141 FORTUNE

"I deserve this"? You're an egomaniac! Are you even listening to yourself?

142 GINGER

Of course I am! I'm very interesting.

(THEN) Now, come on. This is your
big gay day. So let's just embrace
this and all "lez out" together!

Tyler! Lez out for your sister!

143 TYLER

(PETULANT) I am, Mom!

THERE'S A KNOCK. GINGER OPENS THE DOOR. IT'S MIKE.

144 GINGER

What are you doing here?

145 FORTUNE

(WITH MEANING) I asked him over to talk about something important.

146 MIKE

What's going on here? You having a Hawaii party? That's dumb.

147 GINGER

Ugh, Mike, you are always so negative.

148 MIKE

I'm not negative. I'm honest. And I honestly believe that Hawaii is an inferior state. (DERISION)

Pineapple. A pineapple's just a pear in a whore's dress.

149 GINGER

Pineapple is my favorite fresh fruit!

I had it once. In Atlanta.

150 FORTUNE

Alright, enough! God. Look, Dad, I need to talk to you.

THE OTHERS TENSE UP. MIKE CLOCKS THIS.

151 MIKE

Why'd you all suddenly get so weird?

152 FORTUNE

Dad, I realized something recently.

And it's a subject that will make you uncomfortable.

153 MIKE

The fact that Tyler uses hair gel?

154 TYLER

It's not hair gel, Dad. It's foot cream. I just put it in my hair.

155 FORTUNE

What I'm talking about is more of a... sexual nature.

156 MIKE

Oh. I see. Fortune, you don't have to dance around this anymore. I know.

157 FORTUNE

You do?

158 MIKE

Yes. I know you... figured out your mom and I are secretly doing it.

159 FORTUNE

What?

160 TYLER

What? No, seriously. I'm really confused. Is this or is this not a Hawaii party?

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT TWO

ACT THREE

SCENE K

FADE IN:

INT. FORTUNE AND GINGER'S LIVING ROOM - MOMENTS LATER (DAY 3)
(FORTUNE, GINGER, MIKE, TYLER, NICHOLE)

FORTUNE JUMPS UP, SHOCKED AND ANGRY.

161 FORTUNE

You're sleeping together? This makes no sense! You two hate each other.

162 GINGER

And that's been making the sex pretty interesting.

163 FORTUNE

Uch! Explain how this happened.

164 GINGER

Well, Mike came over a while ago to fix the light in your room. And he looked pretty manly on that ladder, so I grabbed hold and... off we went.

165 FORTUNE

Oh, God! In my room?

166 MIKE

That's where we do it.

166A GINGER

(OFF HER LOOK) Honey, you have the newest mattress.

167 FORTUNE

No way. You two are oil and water and we will not have it. Right, Tyler?

168 TYLER

(LONG BEAT, EYES WELLING) Mommy and Daddy are getting married again?

Santa heard my prayers!

169 FORTUNE

No! You remember them together. All the yelling and fighting. That's why I started eating so much. I'm supposed to look like (RE: TYLER) him!

170 MIKE

Fortune, you're overreacting. This isn't serious. Your mother and I are just... having some fun.

171 GINGER

(OFFENDED) "Having some fun"?! Last night you told me you loved me!

172 MIKE

I was talking to the television.

Peyton Manning was in a soup

commercial. Football, acting. That

guy can do it all!

173 GINGER

Well I was doing some acting last night with you by the way. (LURID) "Oh, Michael. You have so many janitor keys."

174 TYLER

No no no! Be friends! (TO THE

HEAVENS) Santa, please!

175 FORTUNE

Tyler, grow up!

176 TYLER

Hey! Show some respect. You are talking to a Coast Guard Rope-coiler!

177 FORTUNE

Come over here and I'll apologize.

TYLER STARTS OVER.

178 NICHOLE

Tyler, no! Headlock!

FORTUNE GRABS TYLER, PUTS HIM IN A HEADLOCK.

179 GINGER

Let him go, Fortune!

180 MIKE

No. He needs to learn how to get out of it by himself.

181 NICHOLE

All of you stop it! You people are crazy!

182 GINGER

Don't you judge us, you Yankee!

182A TYLER

Mom, please!

183 NICHOLE

(MAD) I'm not a Yankee. I was born in North Carolina!

184 GINGER

But your parents are from (JUDGMENT) Massachusetts! All those colleges up there. It's disgusting!

185 FORTUNE

Enough! God. If we can't even be in the same room for five minutes how am I ever going to -- (CATCHING HERSELF) Everyone, get out.

> 186 MIKE

Fine.

MIKE, TYLER AND NICHOLE STOMP OUT.

187 GINGER

I'm going upstairs.

GINGER STARTS UPSTAIRS.

188 FORTUNE

Ucch! I need something to eat.

FORTUNE CROSSES TO THE TABLE, THEN REACTS, GROSSED OUT.

FORTUNE (CONT'D) 189

Eww! Mom, you got a vagina cake?

GINGER (O.C.) 190

It's red velvet!

CUT TO:

SCENE L

INT. FORTUNE AND GINGER'S KITCHEN - THAT NIGHT (NIGHT 3)
(FORTUNE, GINGER)

GINGER THINKS WHILE SHE DRINKS COFFEE. FORTUNE ENTERS AND GETS A BOTTLE OF WATER FROM THE FRIDGE. SHE STARTS BACK OUT.

191 GINGER

We should talk, darling.

192 FORTUNE

(SIGHING) Look, I'm sorry I said I wish you weren't my mom.

193 GINGER

You didn't say that.

194 FORTUNE

(BEAT, THEN) I guess that was to my diary. (THEN) Why are you doing this with Dad? It's a mistake.

195 GINGER

I know. Honey, we just want some companionship. Like everyone. But I am sorry I ruined your big moment by being so sexy and fun.

196 FORTUNE

It's okay. You can't help it. I don't want to tell Dad now anyways.

Our family's a mess when he thinks I'm straight. This will just make everything worse.

197 GINGER

I'm not so sure. Fortune, you ever seen your daddy cry?

> 198 FORTUNE

Dad? Never.

199 GINGER

I've only seen him cry three times in my life. When you were born. When your brother was born. And when I read him that movie I wrote. Now I know he's stubborn and set in his ways. But the thing he's most set on is loving his family. Just tell him, sugar. He'd never turn his back on you.

FORTUNE TAKES THIS IN.

200 FORTUNE

You are something, Mom. Ninety-nine percent nuts but then you go and say something like --

> 201 GINGER

Would you be willing to lend me money for a breast lift?

> 202 FORTUNE

There she is!

CUT TO:

SCENE M

INT. MIKE'S HOUSE - THE NEXT DAY (DAY 4)
(FORTUNE, GINGER, MIKE, GORDON)

MIKE IS ON THE COUCH WITH A PLATE OF MEAT AND CORN. HE SALTS THE FOOD, OPENS A BEER, SMILES, PICKS UP A REMOTE. HEAVEN. FORTUNE AND GINGER ENTER.

203 MIKE

Uch. Why are you bothering me? The game's almost on in two hours.

204 GINGER

Simmer down. Our daughter has something important she wants to tell

you. I'll be in the kitchen.

GINGER CROSSES INTO THE KITCHEN. MIKE TURNS TO FORTUNE.

205 MIKE

What now?

FORTUNE CROSSES TO THE COUCH. AS SHE DOES, SHE PASSES GORDON, WHO IS IN THE CORNER, LOOKING EXTREMELY SAD.

206 FORTUNE

Hey, Gordon. How's it going?

GORDON PUTS HIS HEAD DOWN, DEBILITATED BY HIS DEPRESSION. FORTUNE REACTS, WORRIED, BUT THEN STEELS HERSELF AND SITS DOWN NEXT TO MIKE.

207 MIKE

You want some --

208 FORTUNE

I'm gay, Dad. I am gay.

MIKE FREEZES.

209 FORTUNE (CONT'D)

I've been trying to tell you for a couple days, but there it is.

(POINTING TO SELF) Lesbian.

210 MIKE

(BEAT, THEN) Awwwwww hell.

211 FORTUNE

I know. And I know this is a shock.

What are you thinking?

MIKE STARES AT THE FLOOR FOR A BIT, WHEELS TURNING.

212 MIKE

You're my daughter. You're my daughter. You're my daughter -- GINGER BURSTS IN.

213 GINGER

For the love of God, Mike, she knows she's your daughter. She's telling you she's gay!

214 FORTUNE

Mom! This isn't your moment!

215 GINGER

But I have a song prepared!

OFF FORTUNE'S LOOK, GINGER SLINKS OUT.

216 MIKE

So... what do we do now? FORTUNE RAISES HER SHOULDERS, "I DON'T REALLY KNOW."

217 MIKE (CONT'D)

(THINKS, THEN) Want me to take you to Old Navy? Get you a new outfit?

218 FORTUNE

Old Navy?

219 MIKE

Yep. Nice fleece vest. Then we can swing by the batting cages. We still haven't gone. Birthday tradition.

220 FORTUNE

MIKE STANDS UP BRISKLY, STARTS TO EXIT.

Wait. Do you have any questions?
MIKE THINKS FOR A BEAT, THEN:

221 MIKE

Is this my fault? I wanted to name you "Fortune." Is that a gay name?

222 FORTUNE

No, Dad. It's a stripper name. MIKE NODS, TAKING THIS IN.

223 MIKE

Alright, let's go. (A LITTLE
TENTATIVE) I mean, if you even want
to go to the cages with me. Do
lesbians like hitting softballs?

224 FORTUNE

Dad. It's our superpower.

225 MIKE

That's good. (THIS IS TOUGH) Cause it'd break my heart if we couldn't do stuff like that together anymore.

You're my rock, Fortune.

FORTUNE REACTS, TOUCHED. SHE THUMPS HIM ON THE ARM.

226 FORTUNE

It's cool we're finally starting to communicate. (BEAT) There's this girl I have a crush on --

227 MIKE

(CUTTING HER OFF) Nah!

228 FORTUNE

Yeah, too soon.

FORTUNE NODS, "GOT IT", AS SHE AND MIKE EXIT AND WE...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT THREE

TAG

FADE IN:

INT. MIKE'S HOUSE - A COUPLE DAYS LATER (DAY 5)
(FORTUNE, GINGER, MIKE, TYLER, NICHOLE, GORDON)

FORTUNE, GINGER, TYLER, NICHOLE AND GORDON ARE THERE, WAITING. MIKE ENTERS IN HIS WORK CLOTHES. HE PULLS UP, SEEING THEM.

229 MIKE

Oh boy. Is someone else gay? Who is it this time? Nichole?

230 NICHOLE

No, no. One hundred percent straight.

Well, sometimes I feel a little tingle

when I see a Katy Perry video. Like

when she's in the rain or near an

explosion.

231 FORTUNE

Nice. Unity.

SHE AND NICHOLE BUMP FISTS.

232 GINGER

This is about Gordon, Mike. We need you to forgive him.

TYLER HOLDS UP A RAGGED, DISGUSTING CHEW DOLL.

233 TYLER

He's depressed, Dad. He doesn't want anything to do with his chew toy. So now I have to play with Mr. Squeaker alone.

MIKE THINKS FOR A BEAT, THEN STARES AT GORDON.

234 MIKE

Well. I think I've learned over the past few days that I'm going to need to be a little bit more accepting.

MIKE APPROACHES GORDON, KNEELS DOWN IN FRONT OF HIM.

235 MIKE (CONT'D)

Gordon, that lesson... does not apply to you! I will never forgive you!

236 FORTUNE

Oh for God's sakes.

EVERYONE EXITS AS GORDON STARTS BARKING AT MIKE, FURIOUS.

237 MIKE

Go ahead and yell. Because that's all you know how to do.

GORDON WALKS AWAY.

238 MIKE (CONT'D)

Sure, run away! You're so like your mother!

FADE OUT.

END OF SHOW
